BARUCH A-TAH ADO-NAI E-LO-HE-NU ME-LECH HA-OLAM ASHER KID=E-SHA-NU BE-MITZ-VO-TAV VETZI-VA-NU AL SEFI-RAT HA-OMER. BLESSED ARE YOU, LORD OUR GOD, KING OF THE UNIVERSE, WHO HAS SANCTIFIED US WITH HIS COMMANDMENTS AND COMMANDED US CONCERNING THE COUNTING OF THE OMER.

PSALM 67 – BECAUSE PSALM 67 HAS EXACTLY 49 HEBREW WORDS, CORRESPONDING TO THE NUMBER OF DAYS WE COUNT THE OMER, WE READ IT DAILY.

*Psalm 67 May God be merciful to us, and bless us, and cause His face to shine on us. Selah. So that Your way may be known on earth, Your salvation among all nations. Let the nations praise You, O God; let all the nations thank You. O let the nations be glad and sing for joy; for You shall judge the people righteously and govern the nations on earth. Selah. Let the nations give thanks to You, O God; let all the nations praise You. The earth shall yield its increase; and God, our own God, shall bless us. God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him.
