Apríl 29, 2023 - Iyar 8, 5783 Levíticus 16:1-20:27; Amos 9:7-15; Ezekíel 20:2-20; Matthew 15:10-20

- *Psalm 18:28 You, LORD, keep my lamp burning; my God turns my darkness into light.
- *Isaiah 60:1-3 Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the LORD is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the LORD will arise over you, And His glory will be seen upon you. The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising.
- *Psalm 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- *Esther 8:16 The Jews had light and gladness and joy and honor.
- *John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.
- *Philippians 4:4,5 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.
- *Romans 5:3-5 And not only that but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.
- *Psalm 104:1,2a Bless the LORD, O my soul! O LORD my God, You are very great: You are clothed with honor and majesty Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment.

Isaiah 61:10 I will rejoice greatly in the Lord,

My soul will exult in my God;

For He has clothed me with garments of salvation,

He has wrapped me with a robe of righteousness,

*Leviticus 16:1 Now the LORD spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they offered profane fire before the LORD, and died.

*Leviticus 10:1-3 tells us what happened:

Then Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censer and put fire in it, put incense on it, and offered profane fire before the LORD, which He had not commanded them. So <u>fire went out from the LORD and devoured them</u>, and they died before the LORD. And Moses said to Aaron, "This is what the LORD spoke, saying: 'By those who come near Me I must be regarded as holy; And before all the people I must be glorified.' "So <u>Aaron held his peace</u>.

*Genesis 2:16-17 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.

*Revelation 22:19 Moreover, if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, <u>God will take away the share of his portion from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are described in this book</u>.

*Revelation 22:20 He who testifies to these matters says, Yes, I am coming <u>suddenly!</u> Amen. Come, Lord Yeshua.

*Leviticus 16:2-3 and the LORD said to Moses, Tell Aaron your brother <u>not to come at any time into the Holy Place inside the veil, before the mercy seat that is on the ark, so that he may not die.</u> For <u>I will appear in the cloud over the mercy seat</u>. But in this way Aaron shall come into the Holy Place: with a bull from the herd for a sin offering and a ram for a burnt offering.

*Leviticus 20:7-8 <u>Sanctify yourselves</u> בְּלְּחְקְדְּשְׁהֹּ therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the Lord your God. And ye shall <u>keep my statutes, and do them</u>: <u>I am</u> the Lord which sanctifies you.

*Philippians 2: 12-13 "Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is <u>God who works in you</u>, both to will and to work for his good pleasure."

- *Hebrews 4:16 Therefore we should come with boldness to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and may find grace for help in time of need.
- *Deuteronomy 16:20 <u>Righteousness! Righteousness</u>, you shall pursue, that you may live and possess the land which Yahweh your God is giving you.
- *Romans 12:9 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good. Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love. In honor giving preference to one another; not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer, distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.
- *Deuteronomy 28:1-2 "And if you faithfully obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. ² And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the Lord your God.
- *Deuteronomy 28:15&20 But it shall come to pass if you do not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today that all thee curses will come upon you and overtake you:.....The LORD will send on you cursing, confusion, ad rebuke in all that you set your hand to do, until you are destroyed and until you perish quickly, because of the wickedness of your doings in which you have forsaken Me.
- *Matthew 25:31 Whatsoever You do to the Least of My brothers you do unto Me.....
- *Leviticus 17:11 For the <u>life of the flesh is in the blood</u>, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your soul, for it is <u>the blood that makes</u> <u>atonement for the soul</u>.
- *Genesis 9:6 Whoever sheds man's blood, by man his blood shall be shed, for in the image of God, He made man.
- *Matthew 23:35-36 so that upon you may fall the guilt of all the <u>righteous blood</u> shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah, the son

- of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar. Truly I say to you, all these things will come upon this generation.
- *Deuteronomy 6:5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul (nephesh ALL OF WHO YOU ARE ALL YOUR ENERGY ALL YOUR DEEDS) and with all your might.
- *Matthew 23:27 Love the Lord your God with every passion of your heart, with <u>all</u> the energy of your being (soul), and with every thought that is within you.
- *Leviticus 17:11:14a For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul ... for it is the life of all flesh. Its blood sustains its life.
- *Genesis 22:18 Abraham answered, "God himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." And the two of them went on together. (NIV)
- *Genesis 22:18 And Abraham said, My son, <u>God will provide himself</u> a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. (KJV)
- *Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.
- *Ephesians 1:7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.
- *Hebrews 9:14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!
- *I John 1:7 7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.
- *Hebrews 13:12 And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood.
- *2 Chronicles 33:6 And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom; also, he observed omens, and used enchantments, and

<u>used witchcraft</u>, and <u>dealt with mediums and with wizards</u>. He wrought much evil in the sight of the Lord to provoke Him to anger.

*Ezekiel 20:6-8a On that day I raised My hand in an oath to them, to bring them out of the land of Egypt into a land that I had searched out for them, 'flowing with milk and honey,' the glory of all lands. Then I said to them, Each of you, throw away the abominations which are before his eyes, and do not defile yourselves with the idols of Egypt. I am the LORD your God.

But they rebelled against Me and would not obey Me. They did not all cast away the abominations which were before their eyes, nor did they forsake the idols of Egypt.

*Ezekiel 20:10-12a Therefore I made them go out of the land of Egypt and brought them into the wilderness. And I gave them My statutes and showed them My judgments, which if a man does, he shall live by them. Moreover I also gave them My Sabbaths to be a sign between the and Me, they might know that I am the LORD who sanctifies them.

*Ezekiel 20:16-17 because they rejected my laws and did not follow my decrees and desecrated my Sabbaths. For their hearts were devoted to their idols. Yet I looked on them with pity and did not destroy them or bring them to an end in the wilderness

*Amos 9:8-12 Surely the eyes of the Lord GOD are on the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from the face of the earth. Yet I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob," declares the LORD. For surely I will give the command, and I will shake the house of Israel among all the nations as grain is sifted in a sieve; but not a pebble will reach the ground. All the sinners among my people will die by the sword, all those who say, Disaster will not overtake or meet us.

In that day I will restore David's fallen tent. I will repair its broken places, restore its ruins, and build it as it used to be, so that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations that bear my name declares the LORD, who will do these things.
