



Bamidbar - In the Wilderness

May 20, 2023 - Iyar 29, 5783

Numbers 1:1-4:20; I Samuel 20:18-42; Matthew 24:29-36

***Isaiah 43:7** Everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made.

***Psalm 115:1** Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to your name give glory, for the sake of your steadfast love and your faithfulness!

***I Corinthians 10:31** Whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

***Matthew 5:16** Let your light so shine among men that they may see your good deeds and give glory to your Father in heaven.

***Numbers 1:1-3** The Lord spoke to Moses in the tent of meeting in the Desert of Sinai on the first day of the second month of the second year after the Israelites came out of Egypt. He said: Take **שָׂאוּ** a census of the whole Israelite community by their clans and families, listing every man by name, one by one. You and Aaron are to count according to their divisions all the men in Israel who are twenty years old or more and able to serve in the army.

***2 Thessalonians 1:10-12a** on the day He comes to be glorified in His saints and regarded with wonder by all who have believed, including you who have believed our testimony.

To this end, we always pray for you, that our God will count you worthy of His calling, and that He will powerfully fulfill your every good desire and work of faith, so that the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you, and you in Him

***Genesis 40:19** In three days Pharaoh will lift **ישא** up your head—from you—and hang you on a tree. And the birds will eat the flesh from you.

***Numbers 6:26** The LORD lift up His countenance upon thee;

***Romans 11:17-20** And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you. You will say then, "Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in." Well said. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear. For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either. Therefore, consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise, you also will be cut off. And they also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.

***Isaiah 43:4** I will give up whole nations to save your life, because you are precious to me and because I love you and give you honor.

***Exodus 12:37** The people of Isra'el traveled from Ra'amses to Sukkot, some six hundred thousand men on foot, not counting children. (CJB)

***Exodus 32:27-28** Then he said to them, "This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'Each man strap a sword to his side. Go back and forth through the camp from one end to the other, each killing his brother and friend and neighbor.'" The Levites did as Moses commanded, and that day about three thousand of the people died.

***Acts 2:40-42** With many other words he testified, and he urged them, "Be saved from this corrupt generation. Those who embraced his message were baptized and about three thousand were added to the believers that day.

***Numbers 1:3-4** You and Aaron are to number those who are twenty years of age or older by their divisions—everyone who can serve in Israel's army. And one man from each tribe, the head of each family, must be there with you.

***Exodus 1:5** All the descendants of Jacob were seventy persons; Joseph was already in Egypt.

***Exodus 12:41** At the end of the 430 years, to the very day, **all the LORD's divisions** left Egypt.

***Numbers 2:1-2** "The Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: 'Everyone of the children of Israel shall camp by his own banner, beside the emblems of his father's house; they shall camp some distance from the tabernacle of meeting'."

Numbers 2:34** "The children of Israel did according to all that the Lord commanded Moses; so they camped by their banners and so they broke camp, each one by his family, according to their fathers' houses."Numbers 2:34** The children of Israel did according to all that the LORD. Commanded Moses.

***Revelation 5:5a** behold, the Lion that is from the tribe of Judah,

***Revelation 5:9b** for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation,

***Philippians 2:9a** For this reason God highly exalted Him....

***Matthew 1:21** "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son,

***Luke 7:22** And He answered and said to them, Go and report to John what you have seen and heard....

***Luke 22:20b** This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.

***John 15:5a** I am the vine, and you are the branches. If you stay joined to me, and I to you, you will produce plenty of fruit.

***Hebrews 8:12** For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.

***Acts 2:33a** Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God,

***2 Timothy 4:1** Jesus will "judge the living and the dead at his appearing."

I Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God.

***Acts 16:31** "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

***I Corinthians 12:26-28** If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and each of you is a member of it. And in the church God has appointed first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, and those with gifts of healing, helping, administration, and various tongues....

***Exodus 19:10-11** Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their garments and be ready for the third day. For on the third day the LORD will come down on Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.

***Hosea 6:1-2** Come, let us return to the Lord. He has torn us to pieces but he will heal us; he has injured us but he will bind up our wounds. After two days he will revive us; on the third day he will restore us, that we may live in his presence.

***Acts 1:4** And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me;

***Acts 2:1-4** When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

***Deuteronomy 33:18-19** Rejoice, Zebulun, in your expeditions, exult, Issachar, in your tents! They invite peoples to the mountain where they offer right sacrifices, Because they suck up the abundance of the seas and the hidden treasures of the sand.

***Ephesians 4:24** Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.

***John 11:25-26** Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.

***Matthew 24:29-40** Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

30 Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

31 And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

32 "Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near.

33 So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near--at the doors! **34** Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.

35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. **36** "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only. **37** But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

38 For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, **39** and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

40 Then two men will be in the field: one will be taken and the other left.
