



*Torah Portion - Beshalach - When He Sent*

*February 4, 2023 - 5783*

*Exodus 13:16-17:16; Judges 4:4-5:31; Matthew 14:22-33*

**\*Exodus 13:17** Now when Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although it was nearer; for God said, The people may have a change of heart when they see war, and return to Egypt.

**\*Exodus 13:18** God led the people roundabout, by way of the wilderness at the Sea of Reeds. Now the Israelites went up armed out of the land of Egypt.

**\*Ezekiel 16:7** I made you numerous as the plants of the field.

**\*Exodus 1:7** And the children of Israel were fruitful, and teemed, and multiplied, and became exceedingly strong, and the land was filled with them.

**\*Exodus 14:1-4** Now the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: "Speak to the children of Israel, that they turn and camp before Pi Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, opposite Baal Zephon; you shall camp before it by the sea. For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, 'They are bewildered by the land; the wilderness has closed them in.' Then I will harden Pharaoh's heart, so that he will pursue them; and I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army, that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD." And they did so.

**\*2 Samuel 30:b** But I will honor those who honor me, and I will despise those who think lightly of me.

**\*Exodus 14:5-10** And it was told the king of Egypt that the people fled: and the heart of Pharaoh and of his servants was turned against the people, and they said, Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us? And he made ready his chariot, and took his people with him: And he took six hundred chosen chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt, and captains over every one of them. And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the

children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with a high hand. But the Egyptians pursued after them, all the horses and chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen, and his army, and overtook them encamping by the sea, beside Pihahiroth, before Baalzephon. And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD.

**\*Exodus 14:11** And they said to Moses, Was it for want of graves in Egypt that you brought us to die in the wilderness? What have you done to us, taking us out of Egypt?

**\*Exodus 14:12** Is this not the very thing we told you in Egypt, saying, Let us be, and we will serve the Egyptians, for it is better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness.

**\*Matthew 14:22,24-27** Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away. But the boat was now in the middle of the sea, tossed by the waves, for the wind was contrary. Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out for fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid."

**\*Matthew 14:28-31** And Peter answered Him and said, "Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." So He said, "Come." And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!" And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"

**\*Exodus 14:12** Is this not the very thing we told you in Egypt, saying, Let us be, and we will serve the Egyptians, for it is better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness?

**\*Exodus 14:13-14** Moses said to the people, Do not fear! Stand firm and see the salvation of HASHEM that he will perform for you today, for as you have seen Egypt today, you shall not see them again until eternity.

**\*Ecclesiastes 7:19a** Wisdom strengthens the wise.....

**\*Amos 9:1** I saw the Lord standing by the altar, and he said: "Strike the tops of the pillars so that the thresholds shake. Bring them down on the heads of all the people; those who are left I will kill with the sword. Not one will get away, none will escape.

**\*I Samuel 3:10** And the Lord came and stood and He called as before Samuel, Samuel .....

**\*Mark 13:11** Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit.  
HE IS GOING TO HAVE TO STAND AND SPEAK - BUT THE H.S. WILL SPEAK THROUGH HIM.

**\*Deuteronomy 31:14** The Lord said to Moses, "Now the day of your death is near. Call Joshua and present yourselves at the tent of meeting, where I will commission him." So Moses and Joshua came and presented themselves at the tent of meeting.

**\*Exodus 14:15-20** then the Lord said to Moses, Why do you cry out to Me? Tell the Israelites to go forward. And you lift up your rod and hold out your arm over the sea and split it, so that the Israelites may march into the sea on dry ground. And I will stiffen the hearts of the Egyptians so that they go in after them; and I will gain glory through Pharaoh and all his warriors, his chariots and horsemen. Let the Egyptians know that I am Lord, when I gain glory through Pharaoh his chariots and his horsemen. The angel of God, who had been going ahead of the Israelite army, now moved and followed behind them; and the pillar of cloud shifted from in front of them and took up a place behind them and it came between the army of the Egyptians and the army of Israel.

**\*Exodus 14:21** Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the LORD drove the sea back by a strong east wind all night and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

**\*Isaiah 27:8** You contended with them by banishing them, by driving them away. With His fierce wind He has expelled them on the day of the east wind.

**\*Hosea 13:15** Though he flourishes among the reeds,  
An east wind will come,  
The wind. רוּחַ **of the Lord** יהוָה coming up from the wilderness;

**\*Exodus 14:24-27** Now it came to pass, in the morning watch, that the Lord looked down upon the army of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and cloud, and He troubled the army of the Egyptians. And He took off their chariot wheels, so that they drove them with difficulty; and the Egyptians said, "Let us flee from the face of Israel, for the Lord fights for them against the Egyptians." Then the Lord said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand over the sea, that the waters may come back upon the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen." And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and when the morning appeared, the sea returned to its full depth, while the Egyptians were fleeing into it. So the Lord overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea.

**\*Exodus 14:31** And when Israel saw the wondrous power which the Lord had wielded against the Egyptians, **the people feared the Lord;** they had faith in the Lord and His servant Moses.

**\*Exodus 15:1** Then Moses and the children of Israel sang his song to the LORD, and spoke saying: **I will sing** to the LORD, for He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and rider He has thrown into the sea!

**\*Revelation 15:-2-4** And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast over the image and over his mark and over the number of his name standing on the sea of glass having harps of God. **They sing the song of Moses,** the servant of God, and **the song of the Lamb,** saying: Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints! Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested.

**\*Exodus 15:22-26** So Moses brought Israel from the Red Sea; then they went out into the Wilderness of Shur. And they went three days in the wilderness and found no water. Now when they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for they were bitter. Therefore the name of it was called Marah. And the people complained against Moses, saying, "What shall we drink?" So he cried out to

the Lord, and the Lord showed him a tree. When he cast *it* into the waters, the waters were made sweet.

**\*Acts 5:30** The God of our fathers raised Jesus, whom you killed by hanging him on a tree.

**\*John 3:16** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

**\*1 Peter 2:24** tell us that Jesus, on the Cross, bore our sicknesses and carried our pains, in order to remove them from us and by His stripes we have been healed.

**\*Exodus 16:1B-6&8**

....on the fifteenth day of the second month after they departed from the land of Egypt. Then (AT THAT TIME) the whole congregation of the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness. And the children of Israel said to them, "Oh, that we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the pots of meat and when we ate bread to the full! For you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger."

**\*Leviticus 25:10** "Proclaim Liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof."

**\*Exodus 16:4** Then the Lord said to Moses, "Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you. And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in My law or not.

**\*Exodus 17:7** And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, Is the LORD among us, or not?

**\*Exodus 17:8** After this, the Amalekites came and attacked the Israelites at Rephidim.

**\*Exodus 16:33** And Moses said to Aaron, Take a jar, put one omer of manna in it and place it before the Lord, to be kept throughout the ages.

**\*Jeremiah 32:14** "This is what the LORD of Hosts, the God of Israel, says: Take these deeds—both the sealed copy and the open copy of the deed of purchase—and put them in a clay jar to preserve them for a long time.

**\*2 Corinthians 4:7** But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, so that the surpassing greatness of the power will be of God and not from ourselves;

**\*Isaiah 64:8** But now, O Lord, You are our Father, We are the clay, and You our potter;  
And all of us are the work of Your hand.

**\*Lamentations 4:2** The precious sons of Zion, Weighed against fine gold, How they are regarded as earthen jars, The work of a potter's hands!
