

Congregation Notes Torah Portion Beshalach - Sent Out -Proclaiming the End at the Red Sea! January 27, 2024 - Shevat 17 5784 Exodus 13:17-17:16; Judges 4:4-5:31; Matthew 14:22-33

*Exodus 4:22 So you will say to Pharaoh, Thus says the LORD: <u>Israel is my son, my</u> <u>firstborn</u>. I said to you: Let my son go, that he may serve me. Since you refused to let him go, I will kill your son, your firstborn.

*Psalm 89:26-27 He shall cry to Me, You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation. <u>I also shall make him My firstborn</u>, The highest of the kings of the earth.

*Colossians 1:15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

***I Corinthians 10:3-4** They all ate the same spiritual food and <u>they drank from the</u> <u>same spiritual Rock</u> that accompanied them, <u>and the Rock was Christ</u>.

*Matthew 15:24 But He answered and said, I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

*Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Messiah, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the <u>Jew first and also for the Greek</u>.

*Revelation 21:7 The one who overcomes will inherit all things, and I will be his God, and <u>he will be My son</u>.

***Exodus 13:17** It was when Pharaoh sent out the people, that God (Eloheim) did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, because it was closer, but God (Eloheim)

said, Lest the people will reconsider when they see war and they will return to Egypt.

***Exodus 13:18** So God turned the people toward the way of the Wilderness of the Reed Sea. <u>Armed</u> did the children of Israel go up from the land of Egypt.

***Isaiah 40:31** But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.

***II Corinthians 9:8** And <u>God is able</u> to bless you abundantly, so that <u>in all things at all</u> <u>times</u>, <u>having all that you need</u>, you will abound in every good work.

*Exodus 14:4 I shall strengthen the heart of Pharaoh and he will chase after them and <u>I</u> will be glorified through Pharaoh and through his entire army, and <u>Egypt will know that</u> <u>I am HASHEM</u>.

***Exodus 14:10** Pharaoh approached; and the Children of Israel raised up their eyes, and there was Egypt coming after them, and <u>they were fearful to the extreme</u>; cry out did the Children of Israel to HASHEM.

***Psalm 20:8** Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of the LORD our God. They have bowed down and fallen; But we have risen and stand upright.

***Psalm 56:3** Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in You. In God I have put my trust; I will not fear. What can flesh do to me?

*Exodus 14:13 Moses said to the people, <u>Do not fear! Stand firm and see the salvation</u> of <u>HASHEM</u> that <u>He will perform for you today</u>; for as you have seen Egypt today, you shall not repeat seeing them again forever!

*Exodus 14:15 HASHEM said to Moses, Why do you cry out to Me? Speak to the Children of Israel and <u>tell them to go forward</u>.

*Exodus 14:19 And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. So it <u>came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel</u>. Thus it was a cloud and darkness to the one, and it gave light by night to the other, so that the one did not come near the other all that night.

*Exodus 14:21 Moses stretched out his arm over the sea, and HASHEM drove the sea with a wind from the east that was strong all the night <u>and He turned the sea to dry</u> <u>land and split did the water</u>.

***Exodus 14:24** It was at the watch of the morning that HASHEM looked down onto the camp of Egypt with a pillar of fire and cloud, and <u>He threw into disarray the camp of Egypt</u>.

*Exodus 14:25 He removed the wheels of their chariots, and they could drive them only with difficulty. Egypt said, I shall flee from before Israel, for <u>HASHEM is waging war</u> for them against Egypt.

*Deuteronomy 20:1-2 <u>Do not let your heart faint</u>, <u>do not be afraid</u>, <u>and do not tremble or</u> <u>be terrified because of them</u>; <u>for the LORD your God is He who goes with you</u>, <u>to</u> <u>fight for you against your enemies</u>, <u>to save you</u>.

*Exodus 15:3 The LORD (HASHEM) is a man of war; the LORD (HASHEM) is his name.

*Joshua 1:5 No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you or forsake you.

***Exodus 14:30-31** So HASHEM saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore. And <u>Israel saw the hand that is</u> <u>great that HASHEM inflicted upon Egypt</u>; and the people did fear HASHEM and <u>they</u> <u>believed in HASHEM</u> and in Moses, His servant.

***Exodus 15:1** Then Moses and the Children on Israel chose to sing this song to HASHEM, and they said: I shall sing to HASHEM, for He is exalted above the arrogant, the horse and the rider He hurled into the sea. My might and my praise is God, and He was for me a salvation.

*Exodus 15:3 HASHEM is a man of war; HASHEM is His name.

*John 6:35 Jesus answered, <u>I am the bread of life</u>. Whoever comes to Me will never hunger, and whoever believes in Me will never thirst.

***John 16:33** I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world, you will have tribulation. But take heart; **I have overcome the world**.

*Exodus 15:6 ... Your <u>right hand</u>, <u>HASHEM</u>, is adorned with strength; Your right <u>hand</u>, <u>HASHEM</u> smashes the enemy.

*Exodus 15:7 In Your <u>abundant grandeur</u> <u>You demolish Your opponents;</u> You <u>dispatch</u> <u>Your wrath</u>, <u>it consumes</u> them like straw.

*Exodus 15:8 At a <u>blast from your nostrils</u> and the waters were heaped up and the <u>running water stood up straight as a wall</u>; the <u>deep waters congealed in the heart of</u> <u>the sea</u>.

*Exodus 15:12-13 You stretched out Your right hand; and the earth did swallow them. You guided this people that You redeemed in Your kindness, and <u>You led them with Your</u> <u>might to the abode of your holiness</u>.

*Exodus 15:11 <u>Who is like You</u> among the heavenly powers, HASHEM! <u>Who is like You</u>, mighty in holiness, awesome beyond praise, doing wonders!

*Luke 5:26 And <u>amazement seized them</u> all, and they glorified God and were <u>filled with</u> <u>awe</u>, saying, We have seen extraordinary things today.

*Psalm 103:1-5 <u>Bless HASHEM</u>, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless HASHEM, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who <u>forgives all your</u> <u>iniquities</u>; who <u>heals all your diseases</u>; Who <u>redeems your life from destruction</u>; who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who <u>satisfies your mouth with good</u> <u>things</u>; so that your <u>youth is renewed</u> like the eagle's.

*Luke 16:29-31 Abraham said to him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. And he said, No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent. But he said to him, <u>If they do not hear Moses and the prophets</u>, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.

*Exodus 15:22 So Moses brought Israel from the Red Sea; then they went out into the Wilderness of Shur, and they went <u>three days</u> in the wilderness and <u>found no water</u>.

*Exodus 15:24-26 24 And the people complained against Moses, saying, What shall we drink? So he cried out to HASHEM, and the HASHEM <u>showed him a tree</u>. When he cast *it* into the waters, the waters were made sweet.

There He made a statute and an ordinance for them, and there He tested them, and said, <u>If you diligently heed</u> the voice of HASHEM your God and <u>do what is right in His</u> <u>sight</u>, <u>give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes</u>, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For <u>I am HASHEM who heals</u> <u>you</u>.

*Ephesians 5:26 That He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of <u>water by</u> <u>the Word</u>.

*Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price.

*Jeremiah 9:15 Therefore thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel: Behold, I will feed them, this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink.

***Isaiah 55:1** Ho, <u>all who are thirsty</u>, <u>Come for water</u></u>, Even if you have no money; Come, buy food and eat: Buy food without money, Wine and milk without cost.

*John 7:37-39 <u>Yeshua once again speaks of living water</u>, saying, Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. <u>Whoever believes in Me</u>, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them. By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were later to receive.

*Psalm 36:9 with God is the fountain of life......

***Exodus 15:14-16** The **nations will hear and tremble**; anguish will grip the people of Philistia. The chiefs of Edom will be terrified, the leaders of Moab will be seized with trembling, the people of Canaan will melt away; **terror and dread will fall on them**.

*Isaiah 59:15 <u>Yes, truth is lacking</u>; And he who turns aside from evil makes himself a prey. Now the LORD saw, and it was <u>displeasing in His sight that there was no justice</u>.

*Psalm 119:160a <u>All your words are true;....</u>

*John 17:17 Sanctify them by the truth. Your word is truth.

*Isaiah 59:15 Yes, <u>truth is lacking</u>; And he who turns aside from evil makes himself a prey מִשְׁתּוֹלֵל . Now the LORD saw, and it was displeasing in His sight that <u>there was no</u> justice.

***Isaiah 21:15** For they fled from the swords, from the drawn sword, from the bent bow and from the distress of war.

*Ezekiel 38:14-16 Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say to Gog, Thus says the Lord God: On that day when My people Israel dwell safely, will you not know *it*? Then you will come from your place out of the far north, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great company and a mighty army. You will come up against My people Israel like a cloud, to cover the land. It will be in the latter days that I will bring you against My land, so that the nations may know Me, when I am hallowed in you, O Gog, before their eyes.

*Psalm 2:1-2 <u>Why do the nations rage</u>, and the <u>people plot a vain thing</u>? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, <u>against the Lord and</u> <u>against His Anointed</u>,.....

*Psalm 83:1b,2-3 And do not be still, O God! For behold, Your enemies make a tumult; And <u>those who hate You have lifted up their head</u>. They have taken crafty counsel against Your people, and consulted together against Your sheltered ones. They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation. <u>That the name of Israel may be</u> <u>remembered no more</u>.

*Acts 17: 9-10 Now the Lord spoke to Paul in the night by a vision. <u>Do not be afraid</u>, <u>but speak and do not keep silent</u>; for <u>I am with you</u>,
