

## 4.8.23 --- Nísan 17, 5783

\*Exodus 20:19 "Speak to us yourself and we will listen," they said to Moses. "But do not let God speak to us, <u>or we will die</u>."

\*Exodus 31:18 And when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone, <u>written with the</u> <u>finger of God</u>.

\*Psalm 8:3-4 When I look at Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars that You have established; what are human beings that You are mindful of them, mortals that You care for them?

\*Exodus 8:19 This is the finger of God. But Pharaoh's heart was hard, and he would not listen.

\*Deuteronomy 9:10 The Lord gave me two stone tablets <u>written by the finger of</u> <u>God</u>.

\*Exodus 31:18 When the LORD had finished speaking with Moses on Mount Sinai, He gave him the two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone <u>inscribed by the</u> <u>finger of God</u>.

\*Daniel 5:5-6 Suddenly the <u>fingers of a man's hand emerged and began</u> <u>writing</u> opposite the lampstand on the plaster of the wall of the king's palace, and the king saw the back of the hand that did the writing. Then the king's face grew pale and his thoughts alarmed him, and his hip joints went slack and his knees began knocking together.

\*Daniel 5:12 He did this because Daniel, whom the king called Belteshazzar, was found to have a keen mind and knowledge and understanding, and also the ability to interpret dreams, explain riddles and solve difficult problems. <u>Call for Daniel</u>, <u>and he will tell you what the writing means</u>."

MENE: "God has numbered the days of your kingdom and brought it to an end."

TEKEL: "you have been weighed ... and found wanting."

PERES: "your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians."

\*John 8:6 This they said testing Him, that they might have something of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and <u>wrote on the ground with</u> <u>His finger</u>, as though He did not hear.

\*John 8:6b ....But Jesus stooped down and <u>wrote on the ground with His finger</u>, as though He did not hear.

\*John 8:7-8 So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first. And <u>again</u>, <u>He stooped down and wrote on the ground</u>. Then those who heard it, being <u>convicted by their conscience</u>, went out one by one.....

**\*John 16:8a** And when He (the Holy Spirit) has come, <u>He will convict the world of sin,....</u>

\*Romans 11:22 Note then the severity and the kindness of God: severity toward those who have fallen, but God's kindness to you, provided you continue in His kindness.

**\*I Peter 1:3b** .....(He has) caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Messiah Yeshua from the dead."

\*Luke 11:19-20 "You say that I cast out the demons by Beelzebul. Now if I cast out the demons by Beelzebul, by whom do your exorcists cast them out? But if it is by the <u>finger of God that I cast out the demons</u>, <u>then the kingdom of God</u> <u>has come to you</u>."

\*Matthew 12:28 If it is by the Spirit of God that I drive out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

**\*John 14:12** Very truly, I tell you, the one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father.

\*Exodus 32:8-10a They have been quick to turn away from what I commanded them and have made themselves an idol cast in the shape of a calf. They have bowed down to it and sacrificed to it and have said, 'These are your gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt. I have seen these people, the LORD said to Moses, <u>and they are a stiff-necked people</u>. Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them.

**\*Daniel 5:16a** So the king gave the command, and they brought Daniel and cast him into the den of lions.

\*Daniel 3:16-18 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. If this be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king. But <u>if not</u>, <u>be it known to you</u>, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the golden image that you have set up.

\*2 Corinthians 6:4-9 Rather, as servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: <u>in great endurance</u>; <u>in troubles</u>, <u>hardships and distresses</u>; <u>in beatings</u>, <u>imprisonments and riots</u>; <u>in hard work</u>, <u>sleepless nights and hunger</u>; in <u>purity</u>, understanding, <u>patience and kindness</u>; in the Holy Spirit and in <u>sincere love</u>; in <u>truthful speech and in the power of God</u>; with weapons of righteousness in the right hand and in the left; through glory and dishonor, bad report and good report; genuine, yet regarded as impostors; known, yet regarded as unknown; <u>dying</u>, and yet we live on; beaten, and yet not killed; sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; poor, yet making many rich; having nothing, and yet possessing everything</u>.

**\*Exodus 32:11** Then Moses pleased with the LORD his God, and said; LORD, why does your wrath burn hot against Your people whom You have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand?

\*Exodus 32:14 <u>So the LORD releated</u> from the harm which He said He would do to His people.

\*I Timothy 6:9-11 But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful <u>desires that plunge people into ruin and</u> <u>destruction</u>. For the <u>love of money is a root of all kinds of evils</u>. It is through this craving that <u>some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves</u> <u>with many pangs</u>. But as for you, O man of God, <u>flee these things</u>. <u>Pursue</u> <u>righteousness</u>, <u>godliness</u>, <u>faith</u>, <u>love</u>, <u>steadfastness</u>, <u>gentleness</u>.

\*Exodus 32:26-28 So he stood at the entrance to the camp and said, Whoever is for the Lord, come to me. And all the Levites rallied to him. Then he said to them, "This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'Each man strap a sword to his side. Go back and forth through the camp from one end to the other, each killing his brother and friend and neighbor. The Levites did as Moses commanded, and that day about three thousand of the people died.

\*Exodus 32:11 LORD, he said, why should your anger burn against your people, whom you brought out of Egypt with great power and a mighty hand?

\*Jeremiah 9:12-13 The LORD replied: Because they forsook the Torah I had set before them. <u>They did not obey Me</u>, and they did not follow it, but <u>followed</u> <u>their own willful heart</u> and <u>followed the Ba'alim (idols)</u>, as their fathers had <u>taught them</u>.

\*Lamentations 1:5... The LORD has afflicted her for her many transgressions...

\*Lamentations 1:8 Jerusalem has sinned...

\*Lamentations 4:6 The guilt of my poor people exceeded the iniquity of Sodom...

\*Exodus 32:13-14 Now if indeed I have found favor in Your sight, please let me know Your ways, that I may know You and find favor in Your sight. Remember that this nation is Your people. And the LORD answered, My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.

\*Ezekiel 37:1-14 The hand of the Lord was on me, and He brought me out by the Spirit of the Lord and set me in the middle of a valley; <u>it was full of bones</u>. He led me back and forth among them, and I saw a great many bones on the floor of the valley, bones that were very dry. He asked me, "Son of man, <u>can these bones live</u>?"

I said, "Sovereign Lord, you alone know."

Then he said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! This is what the <u>Sovereign Lord says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life</u>. I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; <u>I will put breath in you, and you will come to life</u>. Then you will know that I am the Lord."

So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but <u>there was no breath in</u> <u>them</u>.

Then he said to me, "<u>Prophesy to the breath</u>: prophesy, son of man, and say to it, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: <u>Come, breath reads from the four winds and</u> <u>breathe into these slain, that they may live</u>." So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; <u>they came to life and stood up on their</u> <u>feet—a vast army</u>.

Then he said to me: "Son of man, <u>these bones are the people of Israel</u>. They say, 'Our bones are dried up and our hope is gone; we are cut off. Therefore prophesy and say to them: 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: My people, I am going to open your graves and bring you up from them; <u>I will bring you back to the land of</u> <u>Israel</u>. Then you, my people, will know that I am the Lord, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. <u>I will put my Spirit in you and you will live</u>, and <u>I will</u> <u>settle you in your own land</u>. Then you will know that I the Lord have spoken, and I have done it, declares the Lord."

\*Jeremiah 24:5 This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: <u>Like these good</u> <u>figs</u>, I regard as good the exiles from Judah, whom I sent away from this place to the land of the Babylonians.

\*Hosea 9:10b.... I saw your fathers as the first ripe in the fig tree at her first time: but they went to Baalpeor and separated themselves unto that shame; and their abominations were according as they loved.

\*Matthew 24:32-35 Now learn <u>this parable from the fig tree</u>: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer *is* near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near; at the doors!

Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

\*Luke 21:28 <u>When these things begin to take place</u>, <u>stand up and lift up your</u> heads, because your redemption is drawing near.

\*Luke 21:14-15 But make up your mind not to worry beforehand how you will defend yourselves. For I will give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist or contradict.
