\*2 Timothy 2:12 If we endure hardship, we will reign with him.

\*Revelation 5:10 And have made us kings and priests to our <u>God</u>; <u>And we</u> <u>shall reign on the earth</u>.

\*<u>Daniel 7:27</u> Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, <u>Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most</u> <u>High</u>.

\*Romans 1:7...to <u>all who are beloved of God in Rome, called as saints</u>: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

**\*I Corinthians 1:2** To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, <u>saints by calling</u>, with all who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, their Lord and ours:

\*Philippians 4:21-22 Greet every saint in Christ Jesus. The brethren who are with me greet you. All the saints greet you, especially <u>those of Caesar's household</u>.

\*Ephesians 2:11-14 Therefore remember that at one time you <u>Gentiles in the</u> <u>flesh</u>, called "the uncircumcision" by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands—remember that you were <u>at that time separated from</u> <u>Christ</u>, <u>alienated from the commonwealth of Israel</u> and <u>strangers to the</u> <u>covenants of promise</u>, <u>having no hope</u> and <u>without God in the world</u>. <u>But now in</u> <u>Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood</u> <u>of Christ</u>. For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility...... \*Genesis 12:2-3 I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a <u>blessing.</u> I will <u>bless</u> those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be <u>blessed</u>.

\*Deuteronomy 7:6 For <u>you</u> are a people holy to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen <u>you</u> to be a people for his own possession, out of all the peoples that are on the face of the earth.

\*Deuteronomy 7:13 <u>He will love you</u>, and He will <u>bless you</u> and He will <u>multiply</u> <u>you</u>; and He will bless the fruit of <u>your womb</u> and the fruit of <u>your Land</u>; <u>your</u> <u>grain</u>, <u>your wine</u>, and <u>your oil</u>; the offspring of <u>your cattle</u> and the herds of <u>your</u> <u>flock</u>; upon the Land that He swore to your forefathers to <u>give to you</u>.

\*Mark 12:30-31 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these.

\*Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, <u>Christ died for us</u>.

**\*I John 3:1** See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!

\* **I John 4:9-10** This is how <u>God showed his love among us</u>: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. <u>This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins</u>.

\*Deuteronomy 7:11 Because (ekev) you listen to these ordinances, and you observe and perform them that HASHEM, your God will guard for you the covenant and the kindness that He swore to your forefathers.

\*Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, and <u>you shall bruise him on</u> <u>the heel</u> (EKEV). \*Genesis 25:24-26a When her days to be delivered were fulfilled, behold, there were twins in her womb. Now the first came forth red, all over like a hairy garment; and they named him Esau. Afterward his brother came out with his hand holding Esau's heel בַּעָקַב (EKEV), so his name was called Jacob יַעָקָב (EKEV).

\*Deuteronomy 8:11,13b,14,19 Be careful for yourself lest you forget HASHEM your God, by not observing His commandments, His ordinances and His decrees....and everything that is your will increase and haughty will your heart be, and you will forget HASHEM....It shall be that if you should in any way forget HASHEM, your God, and you should go after the gods of others, and should you worship them and should you bow to them, I testify against you today you will certainly be destroyed.....

\*Revelation 2:4,5b (to the loveless church) Nevertheless I have this against you that you have left your first love. .... Repent and do the first works or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place unless you repent.

\*Revelation 2:22-23 Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation unless they repent of their deeds. I will kill her children with death, and all the churches shall know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your works.

\*Ecclesiastes 1:9 What has been is what will be, and what has been done is what will be done, and there is nothing new under the sun.

\*Deuteronomy 20:10 When you go near a city to fight against it, then proclaim an offer of peace to it.

\*Psalm 89:50-52 Remember, Lord, how your servant has been <u>mocked</u>, how I bear in my heart the <u>taunts of all the nations</u>, the taunts with which your enemies, LORD, <u>have mocked</u>, with which they have mocked every step of your anointed <u>one</u>.

\*Luke 18:32 For He will be handed over to <u>the Gentiles</u>, and will be mocked and <u>mistreated and spit upon</u>,....

\*Matthew 27:41 In the same way the chief priests also, along with the <u>scribes</u> and elders, were mocking Him and saying,.... **\*Psalm 72:10a** May the kings of Tarshish and of the coastlands render him tribute....

\*Matthew 28:18a,19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, ...... teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

\*Galatians 4:19 My little children, of whom <u>I am again in travail (chevely leda)</u> <u>until Christ is formed in you</u>.

\*Genesis 3:15 I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise you head, and you shall bruise his heel.(ekev עָקב)

\*Lamentations 5:15-22 The joy of our heart has ceased; Our dance has turned into mourning. The crown has fallen from our head. Woe to us, for we have sinned! Because of this our heart is faint; Because of these things our eyes grow dim; <u>Because of Mount Zion which is desolate</u>, <u>With foxes walking about on</u> <u>it</u>. You, O Lord, remain forever; Your throne from generation to generation. Why do You forget us forever, And forsake us for so long a time? Turn us back to You, O Lord, and we will be restored; Renew our days as of old, Unless You have utterly rejected us, And are very angry with us!

**\*I Kings 9:8** And this house will become a heap of ruins; everyone who passes by will be astonished and hiss and say, 'Why has the Lord done thus to this land and to this house?'

\*Luke 21:6 As for these things which you are looking at, the days will come in which there will not be left one stone upon another which will not be torn down.

**\*Isaiah 44:26** It is I who <u>says of Jerusalem</u>, She shall [again] be inhabited! And of the cities of Judah, They shall [again] be built. And <u>I will raise up and restore</u> <u>her ruins</u>.

\*Matthew 24:33-34 So also, when you see all these things, you will know that He is near, right at the door. Truly I tell you, this generation will not pass away until all these things have happened....LOOK UP! HIS FOOTSTEPS ARE EVERYWHERE.
