

Torah Portíon Emor - Sayíng - The LORD Is Speakíng to Us! May 18, 2024; Iyyar 10, 5784 Levítícus 21:1-26:2; Ezekíel 44:1 5-31; Matthew 26:59-26:64

***Exodus 15:26** He said, If you will listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his sight, obeying his commands and keeping all his decrees, then I will not make you suffer any of the diseases I sent on the Egyptians; <u>for I am the LORD who heals you</u>.

*Psalm 107:20 He sent out his word and healed them; He rescued them from the grave.

*Numbers 24:9 Blessed are those who bless you, and cursed are those who curse you.

*Jeremiah 31:3 I have loved you (Israel) with an everlasting love; therefore, I have drawn you with lovingkindness.

*Leviticus 21:1 <u>HASHEM said</u> to Moses<u>, Say</u> to the Kohanim, the sons of Aaron, <u>and you</u> <u>shall say to them</u>; To a dead person a Kohen should not contaminate himself among his people; except to a relative who is close to him.....

***I Peter 2:9a-10** But you are a chosen generation, **a royal priesthood**<u>who once were</u> <u>not a people but are now the people of God</u> who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

*2 Timothy 2:2 And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses <u>entrust</u> to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

*Romans 15:14 I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, <u>filled with all knowledge and able to instruct one another</u>.

*2 Timothy 2:24And the Lord's servant <u>must not be guarrelsome but kind to everyone</u>, <u>able to teach</u>, <u>patiently enduring evil</u>, <u>correcting his opponents with gentleness</u>.

*Psalm 34:11 <u>Come, you children</u>, listen to me; <u>I will teach you the fear of the Lord</u>. *Deuteronomy 6:7 <u>You shall teach them diligently to your children</u>, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

*John 17:17 Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

*Psalm 119:160 The sum of your word is truth,

and every one of your righteous judgments rules endures forever.

*James 1:15 Then <u>the evil desire</u>, when it has conceived, <u>gives birth to sin</u>, <u>and sin</u>, when it is fully matured, <u>brings forth death</u>.

*Matthew 4:4 But he answered, It is written, Man shall not <u>live</u> by bread alone, but <u>by every</u> word that comes from the mouth of God.

*Leviticus 21:1&4 And the LORD said to Moses, Speak to the priests the sons of Aaron, and say to them; None shall defile himself for the dead among his people,.....he shall not defile himself being a chief man among his people, to profane himself.

*Leviticus 23:1-3 And the LORD <u>spoke</u> to Moses, <u>saying</u>, <u>Speak</u> to the children of Israel, <u>and</u> <u>say</u> to them, The feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts. Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a <u>Sabbath of solemn rest</u>, a holy convocation. You shall do no work on it; <u>it is the Sabbath of the LORD in all your</u> <u>dwellings</u>.

*James 4:8 Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.

*Exodus 20:8-10 <u>Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy</u>. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God.

*Genesis 2:1-3 By the seventh day God had finished the work He had been doing; so <u>on the</u> <u>seventh day He rested from all His work</u>. Then <u>God blessed the seventh day and made it holy</u>, because on it He rested from all the work of creating that He had done.

*2 Peter 3:8 But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

*Hebrews 4:11 Let us, therefore, make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall by following the same pattern of disobedience.

*Exodus 20:8 <u>Remember</u> the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

*Revelation 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come!

*Revelation 20:1-3a And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key to the Abyss and holding in his hand a great chain. He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is

the devil, or Satan, and bound him for a thousand years. He threw him into the Abyss, and locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations any more until the thousand years were ended....

*Acts 3:21 whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.

*Revelation 22:13a I am the <u>Alpha and the Omega</u>, the <u>Beginning and the End</u>, the <u>First</u> <u>and the Last</u>.

*Proverbs 31:10a Who can find a virtuous wife.....

*Jeremiah 2:2 Go and cry in the hearing of Jerusalem, saying, Thus says the LORD: I remember you, the kindness of your youth, <u>the love of your betrothal</u>, when you went after Me in the wilderness, in a land not sown.

*Jeremiah 3:14 Return, O backsliding children, says the LORD; for I am married to you. I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion.

*Romans 9:27-28 Isaiah also cries out concerning Israel: Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, <u>the remnant will be saved</u>. For He will finish the work and cut *it* short in righteousness, because <u>the Lord will make a short work upon the earth</u>.

*Revelation 21:9 Come. I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife.

***Isaiah 54:5 For your Maker is your husband**—the LORD Almighty is his name—the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer; he is called the God of all the earth.

*Leviticus 23:34–35b On the fifteenth day of the seventh month is the Festival of Tabernacles (booths or huts), <u>for a seven day period for HASHEM</u>.....On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.

*Leviticus 23:40 And you shall rejoice before the Lord you God for seven days.

*Leviticus 23:42-43 You shall live in booths for seven days; all citizens in Israel shall live in booths, so that future generations may know that I made the Israelites live in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt, I am the Lord your God.

***I Peter 5:6-10** Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that <u>the family of believers</u> <u>throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings</u>. And the God of all grace,

who called you to his eternal glory in Messiah, <u>after you have suffered a little while, will</u> <u>Himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast</u>.

*Exodus 13:21-22 And the <u>LORD went before them in a pillar of cloud to guide their way</u> by day, and in a pillar of fire to give them light by night, so that they could travel by day or night. He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the fire by night from before the people.

***I Chronicles 29:15** For we are strangers before you and sojourners, as all our fathers were. Our days on the earth are like a shadow, and there is no abiding.

*Matthew 6:19-21 Yeshua says, Lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

*2 Corinthians 13:5 Or do you not realize about yourselves that <u>Yeshua the Messiah is in</u> you?

*Galatians 1:15 But when it pleased God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called by His grace, to reveal His Son in me.

***I Peter 1:5-7** who are <u>kept by the power of God</u> through faith for salvation <u>ready to be</u> <u>revealed in the last time</u>. In this you <u>greatly rejoice</u>, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, <u>though it is tested by fire</u>, may be found to praise, honor, and glory <u>at the revelation of Yeshua the Messiah</u>...

*Deuteronomy 30:3-5 Then He will restore you from captivity and have compassion on you and gather you from all the nations to which the LORD your God has scattered you. Even if you have been banished to the farthest horizon, He will gather you and return you from there.... Then the LORD your <u>God will bring you to the land which your fathers</u> possessed, and you shall possess it. He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers.

*Matthew 24:32-34 Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, (BACK IN THE LAND AND PROSPERING) you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.

*Isaiah 62:6-7 <u>I have set watchmen on your walls</u>. O <u>Jerusalem</u>: They shall never hold their peace day or night. <u>You who make mention of the LORD</u>, <u>do not keep silent</u>, And give Him no rest till He establishes And till He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth.
