May 6, 2023 - Iyar 15, 5783 Levítícus 21:1-24:23; Ezekíel 44:15-31; Matthew 26:59-66

*Genesis 1:31 And God saw all that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

*Genesis 3:8 And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

*Genesis 3:9 But the Lord God called to the man, "Where are you?"

*Genesis 3:10-12 ... "I heard Your voice in the garden," he replied, "and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid myself." "Who told you that you were naked?" asked the LORD God. "Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?" And the man answered, "The woman whom You gave me, she gave me fruit from the tree, and I ate it."...

*Leviticus 19:2 "You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy."

*Leviticus 21:1-8 And the Lord said to Moses, "Speak to the priests, the sons of Aaron, and say to them, No one shall make himself unclean for the dead among his people, 2 except for his closest relatives, his mother, his father, his son, his daughter, his brother, 3 or his virgin sister (who is near to him because she has had no husband; for her he may make himself unclean). 4 He shall not make himself unclean as a husband among his people and so profane himself. 5 They shall not make bald patches on their heads, nor shave off the edges of their beards, nor make any cuts on their body. 6 They shall be holy to their God and not profane the name of their God. For they offer the Lord's food offerings, the bread of their God; therefore, they shall be holy. 7 They shall not marry a prostitute or a woman who has been defiled, neither shall they marry a woman divorced from her husband, for the priest is holy to his God. 8 You shall sanctify him, for he offers

- the bread of your God. He shall be holy to you, for I, the Lord, who sanctify you, am holy.
- *Numbers 12:3 Now Moses was a very humble man, more so than any man on the face of the earth.
- *Exodus 33:11 And the Lord spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.
- *Joshua 1:10-11 Joshua instructed the leaders of the people: Go through the camp and command the people, Prepare your supplies, for within three days you will cross the Jordan River and begin the conquest of the land the Lord your God is ready to hand over to you.
- *I Timothy 5:17 The elders who <u>direct the affairs</u> of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching.
- *2 Kings 17:13 Yet through all His prophets and seers, the LORD warned Israel and Judah, saying, "Turn from your wicked ways and keep My commandments and statutes, according to the entire Law that I commanded your fathers and delivered to you through My servants the prophets."
- *2 Chronicles 34:23-25 She said to them, "Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, 'Tell the man who sent you to Me, thus says the Lord, "Behold, I am bringing evil on this place and on its inhabitants, even all the curses written in the book which they have read in the presence of the king of Judah. Because they have forsaken Me therefore My wrath will be poured out on this place and it shall not be quenched.
- *Lamentations 5:2a Our inheritance has been turned over to strangers,
- *Lamentations 1:10 The adversary has stretched out his hand over all her precious things, For she has seen the nations enter her sanctuary, the ones whom You commanded that they should not enter into Your congregation.

- *Daniel 9:4 I prayed to the Lord my God and confessed: <u>Lord</u>, the <u>great and</u> <u>awesome God</u>, who keeps his covenant of love with those who love him and keep his commandments,...
- *John 1-5-14&18 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it..... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth...No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known...
- *Acts 3:14 But you disowned and denied the Holy and Righteous One and asked for [the pardon of] a murderer to be granted to you.
- *2 Samuel 7:23 And who is like your people Israel the one nation on earth that God went out to redeem as a people for himself....
- *Psalm 87:2 The Lord loves the gates of Zion more than all the other dwelling places of Jacob.
- *Isaiah 56:7 These I will bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.
- *I Corinthians 16:19-20 Or do you not know that <u>your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you</u>, whom you have from God? <u>You are not your own</u>, for you were bought with a price. So <u>glorify God in your body</u>.
- *Revelation 18:4 Then I heard another voice from heaven saying, <u>Come out of her</u>, my people, <u>lest you take part in her sins</u>, <u>lest you share in her plagues</u>;
- *Leviticus 19:2 Speak to the <u>entire assembly of Israel</u> and say to them: 'Be holy because <u>I</u>, the LORD your God, am holy.
- *1 Peter 1:15 But as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct.

- *Psalm 96:9 Worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness; tremble before Him, all the earth!
- *Isaiah 33:6 And He will be the <u>stability of your times</u>, A <u>wealth of salvation</u>, <u>wisdom and knowledge</u>; <u>The fear of the Lord is his treasure</u>.
- *Acts 2:38 And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."
- *Romans 4:18 <u>Against all hope</u>, <u>Abraham in hope believed</u> and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been said to him, So shall your offspring be.
- *Leviticus 22:32 <u>You must not profane My holy name</u>. I must be acknowledged as holy among the Israelites. I am the LORD who sanctifies you,...
- *Leviticus 24:10-16 Now the <u>son of an Israelite woman</u>, whose <u>father was an Egyptian</u>, went out among the children of Israel; and this Israelite woman's son and a man of Israel fought each other in the camp. And the <u>Israelite woman's son blasphemed the name of the Lord and cursed</u>; and so they brought him to Moses. (His mother's name was Shelomith the daughter of Dibri, of the tribe of Dan.) Then they put him in custody, that the mind of the Lord might be shown to them.

And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Take outside the camp him who has cursed; then let all who heard him lay their hands on his head, and let all the congregation stone him. "Then you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'Whoever curses his God shall bear his sin. And whoever blasphemes the name of the Lord shall surely be put to death. All the congregation shall certainly stone him, the stranger as well as him who is born in the land. When he blasphemes the name of the Lord, he shall be put to death.

- *Isaiah 43;12 You are My witnesses, declares the Lord, that I am God.
- *Leviticus 21:6 They shall be holy to their God and <u>not profane the name of their God</u>. For they offer the Lord's food offerings, the bread of their God; therefore, they shall be holy.

- *Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to <u>offer your bodies as a living sacrifice</u>, <u>holy and pleasing to God</u>—this is your true and proper worship.
- *Hebrews 13:15-16 Through Jesus, therefore, let us <u>continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise</u>—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name. And do not forget to <u>do good and to share with others</u>, for <u>with such sacrifices God is pleased</u>.
- *Philippians 4:18 I have received full payment and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus <u>the gifts you sent</u>. They are a <u>fragrant offering</u>, an <u>acceptable sacrifice</u>, <u>pleasing to God</u>.
- *John 12:3 Then Mary took about a pint of expensive perfume, made of pure nard, and she anointed Jesus' feet and wiped them with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume.
- *Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to <u>offer your bodies as a living sacrifice</u>, <u>holy and pleasing to God</u>—this is your true and proper worship.
