

Torah Portíon Ha Azínu September 23, 2023 - Tíshreí 8, 5784 Deut. 32:1-52; Hos. 14:1-10; Míc.7:18-20; Joel 2:15-27; Matt. 18:21-35

*Exodus 15:2 God is my strength, God is my song, and, yes! God is my salvation. This is the kind of God I have and I'm telling the world! This is the God of my father - I'm spreading the news far and wide!

*Deuteronomy 32:47 For it (THE WORD OF GOD) is not an idle word for you; indeed it is your life. And by this word you will prolong your days in the land, which you are about to cross the Jordan to possess.

*Deuteronomy 32:1 <u>Listen, O heavens</u>, and I will speak; and <u>may the earth hear</u> the utterances of my mouth.

*Ephesians 2:6 and raised us up with Him, and <u>seated us with Him in the</u> <u>heavenly places in Christ Jesus</u>,....

*Matthew 6:10 Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

*2 Timothy 3:12-14 Indeed, all who desire to live godly lives in Yeshua HaMashiach will be persecuted, while evil men and imposters go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. But as for you, <u>continue</u> in the things you have learned and firmly believed, since <u>you know from whom you have</u> learned them....

*2 Timothy 3:1-2,5 But know this, that <u>in the last days perilous times will</u> <u>come</u>. For men will be <u>lovers of themselves</u>, <u>lovers of money</u>, <u>boasters</u>, <u>proud</u>, <u>blasphemers</u>, <u>disobedient to parents</u>, <u>unthankful</u>, <u>unholy</u>, <u>having a form of godliness</u> <u>but denying its power</u>. And from such people turn away!

*Acts 2:23 This man was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross.

*Isaiah 5:20 Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

*Romans 8:6 <u>The mind governed by the flesh is death</u>, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace. <u>The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God</u>; it <u>does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so</u>.

*Micah 7:3-4 They've all become experts in evil. <u>Corrupt leaders demand bribes.</u> <u>The powerful rich make sure they get what they want. The best and brightest</u> <u>are thistles</u>. The top of the line is crabgrass. But no longer: It's exam time. Look at them slinking away in disgrace!

*Colossians 4:2 <u>Continue steadfastly in prayer</u>, <u>being watchful</u> in it with thanksgiving.

*Luke 18:1 And he told them a parable to the effect that they ought <u>always to</u> pray and not lose heart.

*Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "<u>My God, My God, why have You</u> forsaken Me

*Psalm 22:1 <u>My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me</u>? Why are You so far from saving Me, so far from My words of groaning?

*Luke 23:46 Then <u>Yeshua</u>, calling out with a loud voice, said, Father, <u>into your</u> <u>hands I commit My Spirit</u>. And having said this He breathed His last. HE WAS QUOTING:

***Psalm 31:5** <u>Into Your hands I commit my spirit</u>; You have redeemed me, O LORD, God of truth.

*Acts 4:23-24 On their release, Peter and John returned to their own people and reported everything that the chief priests and elders had said to them. 24<u>When the believers heard this, they lifted up their voices to God with one accord.</u> Sovereign Lord, they said, You made the <u>heaven and the earth</u> and <u>the sea</u>

and everything in them. You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of Your servant, our father David: Why do the nations rage and the peoples plat in vain?

*Nehemiah 9:6 You alone are the LORD. You created the heavens, the <u>highest</u> <u>heavens with all their host, the earth and all that is on it</u>, the <u>seas and all that is in</u> <u>them</u>.

*Psalm 2:1 Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing?

*James 5:16b-17 The prayer of a righteous man has great power to prevail. Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years....

*2 Peter 3:11-12 But the Day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and its works will be laid bare. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to conduct yourselves

<u>in holiness and godliness</u> as you anticipate and hasten the coming of the day of <u>God</u>, when the heavens will be destroyed by fire and the elements will melt in the heat....

*Luke 18:1-7 One day Jesus told his disciples a story to show that they should always pray and never give up. There was a judge in a certain city, who neither feared God nor cared about people. A widow of that city came to him repeatedly, saying, Give me justice in this dispute with my enemy. The judge ignored her for a while, but finally he said to himself, I don't fear God or care about people, but this woman is driving me crazy. <u>I'm going to see that she gets justice</u>, because she is wearing me out with her constant requests! Then the Lord said, Learn a lesson from this unjust judge. Even he rendered a just decision in the end. <u>So don't you</u> think God will surely give justice to his chosen people who cry out to him day and night?

*Deuteronomy 32:39-42 Do you see it now? Do you see that I'm the One? Do you see that there's no other god beside me? I bring death and I give life, I wound and I heal— there is no getting away from or around Me! I raise My hand in solemn oath; I say, I live forever. By that very life I promise: When I sharpen My lightning sword and execute judgment, <u>I take vengeance on my enemies and pay</u> back those who hate me. I'll make My arrows drunk with blood, My sword will

gorge itself on flesh, Feasting on slain and captive alike, the proud and vain enemy corpses.

*Acts 9:4 As Saul drew near to Damascus on his journey, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him. He fell <u>1</u> to the ground and heard a voice say to him, Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me? Who are You, Lord? Saul asked. <u>I am</u> <u>Yeshua, whom you are persecuting</u>, He replied....

*Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but <u>against</u> <u>principalities</u>, <u>against powers</u>, <u>against the rulers of the darkness of this age</u>, <u>against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places</u>.

*Deuteronomy 10:14 refers to all three LEVELS OF HEAVEN in one verse: "Behold, to the Lord your God belong Heaven (#2) and the Heaven of Heavens (#3), the earth and all that is in it (#1).

*Isaiah 59:18-20 So He will repay according to their deeds: fury to His enemies, retribution to His foes, and recompense to the islands. <u>So shall they fear the</u> <u>name of the LORD where the sun sets, and His glory where it rises.</u> For <u>He will</u> <u>come like a raging flood, driven by the breath.</u> The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who turn from transgression, declares the LORD....

*Isaiah 59:19b When the enemy. **T** shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.

*Deuteronomy 32:43 <u>Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people</u>. <u>For He will avenge</u> the blood of His servants<u>, and render vengeance</u> to His adversaries; <u>He will</u> <u>provide atonement for His land and His people</u>.

*Deuteronomy 32:41 If (certainly, since,) I whet My glittering sword, and My hand takes hold on judgment<u>, I will render vengeance</u> to My enemies, and <u>repay</u> <u>those who hate Me</u>.

*Revelation 6:16 and they said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb;

*Ezekiel 25:17 I will execute great vengeance on them with wrathful rebukes. Then they will know that I am the Lord, when I lay my vengeance upon them.

*2 Thessalonians 1:6 Since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you.

*Isaiah 55:11 So shall <u>My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall</u> <u>not return to Me void</u>, But <u>it shall accomplish what I please</u>, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

*Deuteronomy 32:2-3 Let my teaching drop as the rain, My speech distill as the dew, As raindrops on the tender herb, And as showers on the grass. For I proclaim the name of the LORD: Ascribe greatness to our God.

*Deuteronomy 32:5-6 <u>They have corrupted themselves</u>; They are not His children, Because of their blemish: A perverse and crooked generation. Do you thus deal with the LORD, O foolish and unwise people? Is He not your Father, <u>who</u> <u>bought you</u>? Has He not made you and established you? 32:15b16a,17a 18b (Jeshurun) forsook God who made him and scornfully esteemed the Rock of his salvation. They provoked Him to jealousy with foreign gods. They sacrificed to demons....and forgot the God who fathered you.

*Deuteronomy 32:23-24,25a-26 I will <u>heap disasters on them</u>: I will spend <u>My</u> <u>arrows on them</u>. They shall be <u>wasted with hunger</u>, <u>devoured by pestilence and</u> <u>bitter destruction</u>; I will also send against them the <u>teeth of beasts</u> with the <u>poison of serpents of the dust</u>. The <u>sword shall destroy</u> outside; there shall be <u>terror within</u>....

32:35b For the day of their <u>calamity is at hand</u>, and the <u>things to come hasten</u> <u>upon them</u>.

*Deuteronomy 32:29 <u>Were they wise</u> they would comprehend <u>this</u>, <u>they would</u> <u>understand what their end would be</u>.

*Luke 2:36-38 There was also <u>a prophet</u>, <u>Anna</u> the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age, having lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, then <u>as a widow to the age of eighty-four</u>. She <u>never left</u> <u>the temple but worshiped there with fasting and prayer night and day</u>. At that

moment she came,and began to praise God and to speak about the child to all who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem.
