Torah Portion Lech Lecha - November 5, 2022

Genesis 12:1-1727; Isaiah 40:27 - 41:16; Romans 4:1-25, Galatians 4:21-5:1, Hebrews 7

*Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD said to Abram, Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you.

*Genesis 11:31 Terah took his son Abram, his grandson Lot son of Haran, and his daughter-in-law Sarai, the wife of his son Abram, and together they set out from Ur of the Chaldeans to go to Canaan. But when they came to Harran, they settled there.

*Genesis 11:28 And <u>Haran died in the presence of his father Terah</u> in the land of his birth, in Ur of the Chaldeans.

*Genesis 11:28 And Haran died <u>before</u>. <u>JP</u> his father Terah in the land of his nativity, in Ur of the Chaldees.

*Isaiah 50:11 But watch out, you who live in your own אור (flame but translated light) and warm yourselves by your own fires. This is the reward you will receive from me: You will soon fall down in great torment.

*Ezekiel 5:2a A third part you shall burn in the fire with in the midst of the city, when the days of the siege are completed.

*Genesis 15:7 could be understood as saying, I am the Lord who rescued you from the midst of the fire of the Chaldeans.

*Genesis 15:7 Then He said to him, I am the LORD, who brought you out of Ur (flames or fire) of the Chadeans, to give you this land to inherit it.

***Isaiah 50:11** But watch out, you who live in your own light and warm yourselves by your own fires (BEUR #217 - FLAME). This is the reward you will receive from me: You will soon fall down in great torment.

Joshua 24:2 And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, even <u>Terah</u>, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and <u>they served other gods</u>.

*Genesis 11:31,32 Terah took his son Abram, his grandson Lot (Haran's son), and Sarai his daughter-in-law (his son Abram's wife) and set out with them from Ur of the Chaldees for the land of Canaan. But when they got as far as Haran, they settled down there. Terah lived 205 years. He died in Haran.

*Genesis 12: 1 Now the LORD said to Abram, Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you.

***II Corinthians 5:17** This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

*Lamentations 3:22-23 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end;

they are <u>new every morning</u>; great is your faithfulness.

*Isaiah 44:22 <u>I have swept away your offenses like a cloud</u>, your sins like the morning mist. Return to me, for I have redeemed you.

*Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, we are heirs – heirs of God and co-heirs with Messiah – if in fact we share in His sufferings in order that we may also share in His glory.

***John 6:38** For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but to do the will of Him who sent Me.

*Genesis 12:2,3 I will make you a great nation: I will bless you and make your name great, and you shall be a blessing. I will <u>bless</u> those who bless you and I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

*Romans 11:17 Some of these branches from Abraham's tree—some of the people of Israel—have been broken off. And you Gentiles, who were branches from a wild olive tree, have been grafted in. So now you also receive the blessing God has promised Abraham and His children, sharing in the rich nourishment from the root of God's special olive tree.

*Genesis 12:5 Then Abram took Sarai his wife and Lot his brother's son and all their possessions that they had gathered, <u>and the souls</u> (<u>nefesh</u>) whom they had acquired in Haran, and they departed to go to the land of Canaan. So they came to the land of Canaan.

*Matthew 28:19a Therefore, go and make people from all nations into talmidim – meaning students – <u>teaching them</u> to obey everything that I have commanded!

***Isaiah 40:29** He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

***Philippians 4:13** I can do all things through Him who give me strength.

*Genesis 12:7 And <u>HASHEM (יְהוָהֹ)</u> appeared to Abram</u> and He said, To your offspring I will give this land. So he built there an altar to HASHEM (לְיהוָה) who appeared to him.

*John 1:1,2,14 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

*John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, <u>and He saw</u> <u>it and was glad</u>.

Genesis 13:18 Then Abram moved *his* tent, and went and dwelt by the terebinth trees of Mamre, which *are* in Hebron, and built an altar there to the LORD.

*Psalm 226a But I am a worm and not a man,......

* Isaiah 1:18...though your <u>sins be as scarlet</u>, <u>they shall be as whit</u>e as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

*Matthew 26:28 For this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.
