JULY 15, 2023....26 TAMMUZ 5783 Numbers 30:2-36:13; Jeremíah 2:4-28,3:4; Mark 11:12-25



- \*Matthew 5:18 Yeshua said: For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will be no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.
- \*II Peter 3:10a,11 tell us: But the Day of the Lord will come like a thief. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to conduct yourselves in holiness and godliness.
- \*Lamentations 1:3 Judah has gone into captivity, under affliction and hard servitude; She dwells among the nations, she finds no rest; <u>All her persecutors</u> overtake her in dire straits.
- \*Genesis 50:20 As for you, what you intended against me for evil, but God intended for good, in order to accomplish a day like this—to preserve the lives of many people.
- \*Genesis 47:28 <u>Jacob lived in Egypt seventeen years</u>, and the years of his life were a hundred and forty-seven.
- \*Ruth 3:13 Stay here tonight, and in the morning, if he wants to redeem you, good. Let him redeem you. But if he does not want to <u>redeem you</u>, as surely as the LORD lives, <u>I will</u>. Now lie here until morning.
- \*Zechariah 8:19 This is what the LORD of Hosts says: The fasts of the fourth, the fifth, the seventh, and the tenth months will become times of joy and gladness, cheerful feasts for the house of Judah. Therefore, you are to love both truth and peace.
- \*Jeremiah 41:1-3 In the seventh month, Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, son of Elishama, of the royal family, one of the chief officers of the king, <u>came with ten men to Gedaliah</u> the son of Ahikam, at Mizpah. <u>As they ate bread together</u> there at Mizpah, Ishmael the son of Nethaniah and the ten men with him <u>rose up and struck down Gedaliah the son of Ahikam</u>, son of Shaphan, with the sword, and

killed him, whom the king of Babylon had appointed governor in the land. <u>Ishmael</u> also struck down all the <u>Judeans who were with Gedaliah at Mizpah</u>, and the <u>Chaldean soldiers who happened to be there</u>.

- \*Romans 5:3-5 Not only so, but <u>we also glory in our sufferings</u>, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.
- \*Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.
- \*Psalm 130:5 I wait for the LORD, my whole being waits, and in His Word I put my hope.
- \*I Peter 5:10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
- \*Lamentations 3:21-23 This I recall to my heart— therefore I have hope: Because of the mercies of Adonai we will not be consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning! <u>Great is Your faithfulness</u>. Adonai is my portion, says my soul, therefore I will hope in Him.
- \*Numbers 30:2-3 Then Moses spoke to the heads of the tribes concerning the children of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD has commanded: If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.
- \*Matthew 5:37 Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' Anything more than this comes from the evil one.
- \*Act 21:20-24 And when they heard it, they glorified God. And they said to him, "You see, brother, how many thousands there are among the Jews of those who have believed. They are all zealous for the law, and they have been told about

- you that you teach all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, telling them not to circumcise their children or walk according to our customs. What then is to be done? They will certainly hear that you have come. Do therefore what we tell you. We have four men who are under a vow; take these men and purify yourself along with them and pay their expenses, so that they may shave their heads. Thus all will know that there is nothing in what they have been told about you, but that you yourself also live in observance of the law.
- \*Numbers 31:2-3 Take vengeance יהֹם on the Midianites for the children of Israel. Afterward you shall be gathered to your people. So Moses spoke to the people, saying, Arm men from among you for the war, that they may go against Midian to execute the Lord's vengeance סחום on Midian.
- \*Numbers 31:4-6 A thousand from each tribe of all the tribes of Israel you shall send to the war. So there were recruited from the divisions of Israel one thousand from each tribe, twelve thousand armed for war. Then Moses sent them to the war, one thousand from each tribe; he sent them to the war with Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, with the holy articles and the signal trumpets in his hand.
- \*Numbers 31:7-8 And they warred against the Midianites, just as the Lord commanded Moses, and they killed all the males. They killed the kings of Midian with the rest of those who were killed--Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur, and Reba, the five kings of Midian. Balaam the son of Beor they also killed with the sword.
- \*Ephesians 6:12 We are not fighting against humans. We are fighting against forces and authorities and against rulers of darkness and powers in the spiritual world.
- \*I Peter 5:8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.
- \*Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- \*2 Corinthians 2:11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

- \*2 Corinthians 10:4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the <u>pulling down of strong holds</u>; <u>casting down imaginations</u>, and <u>every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God</u>, and <u>bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ</u>.
- \*Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power; who went about doing good, and <u>healing all that were oppressed of the devil</u>; for God was with him.

- \*Isaiah 54:17a ....no weapon formed against you will succeed. You will silence every voice raised up to accuse you.
- \*Luke 21:1 for <u>I will give you utterance</u> and wisdom which none of your opponents will be able to resist or refute.
- \*Acts 10:38 ... God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy. Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and <u>healing</u> all that were <u>oppressed of the</u> devil;
- \*Matthew 4:4 But He answered and said, <u>It is written</u>, Man shall not live by bread alone, <u>but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.</u>
- \*Psalm 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
- \*Zephaniah 3:17 The <u>Lord your God is in your midst</u>, a mighty one who will save; <u>He will rejoice over you with gladness</u>; He <u>will quiet you by his love</u>; <u>He will exult over you with loud singing</u>.
- \*Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are <u>true</u>, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are <u>just</u>, whatsoever

things are  $\underline{lovely}$ , whatsoever things are of  $\underline{good\ report}$ ; if there be any  $\underline{virtue}$ , and if there be any  $\underline{praise}$ ,  $\underline{think\ on\ these\ things}$ .
