*Deuteronomy 29:10-13 <u>All of you stand today before the Lord your God</u>: your leaders and your tribes and your elders and your officers, all the men of Israel, your little ones and your wives—also the stranger who *is* in your camp, from the one who cuts your wood to the one who draws your water— <u>that you may</u> <u>enter into covenant with the Lord your God</u>, and into His oath, which the Lord your God makes with you today, that <u>He may establish you today as a</u> <u>people for Himself, and that He may be God to you</u>, just as He has spoken to you, and just as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

*Deuteronomy 5:5 At that time <u>I was standing between the LORD and you to</u> <u>declare to you the word of the LORD</u>, because <u>you were afraid of the fire</u> and <u>would not go up the mountain</u>.

*Matthew 15:14-19 For God said, 'Honor your father and mother' and 'Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death. But you say that if anyone declares that what might have been used to help their father or mother is 'devoted to God,' they are not to 'honor their father or mother' with it. Thus, you nullify the word of God for the sake of your tradition. You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules.

*Deuteronomy 5:7,16-22 You shall have no other gods before Me. Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the Lord your God is giving you. ¹⁷ You shall not murder.

¹⁸ You shall not commit adultery.¹⁹ You shall not steal.²⁰ You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.²¹ You shall not covet your neighbor's wife. You shall not set your desire on your neighbor's house or land, his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."²² <u>These are</u> <u>the commandments the Lord proclaimed in a loud voice to your whole assembly</u> there on the mountain from out of the fire, the cloud and the deep <u>darkness</u>; and he added nothing more. Then he wrote them on two stone tablets and gave them to me.

*Luke 18:20 You know the commandments: You shall not commit adultery; You shall not murder; You shall not steal; You shall not bear false witness; Honor your father and mother.

*Deuteronomy 6:4-6 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children.

*Matthew22:36-40 Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law and He said to him, <u>You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and</u> <u>with all your soul and with all you mind</u>. This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: <u>You shall love your neighbor as yourself</u>. <u>On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets</u>.

*Galatians 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

*Galatians 6:2 By helping each other with your troubles, you truly obey the law of

Christ.

*Matthew 7:15-20 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but underneath are ravenous wolves. By their fruits you will know them.

*Deuteronomy 29:13-14 that <u>He may establish you today as a people for</u> <u>Himself</u>, and <u>that He may be God to you</u>, just as He has spoken to you, and <u>just</u> <u>as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob</u>. I make this covenant and this oath, <u>not with you alone</u>, but with him who stands here with us today before the Lord our God, <u>as well as with him who is not here with us</u> <u>today</u>.

*Romans 10:12 For there is <u>no distinction</u> between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; *Romans 3:29 Or is God the God of Jews only? Is He not the God of Gentiles also? Yes, of Gentiles also,

*Colossians 3:11 a renewal in which there is no distinction between Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.

*Acts 28:28 Therefore let it be known to you that this salvation of God has been sent to the Gentiles; they will also listen.

*Genesis 15:6 Abram believed the Lord, and <u>He credited it to him as</u> righteousness.

*Romans 4:2-3 If, in fact, Abraham was justified by works, he had something to boast about—but not before God. What does Scripture say? <u>Abraham believed</u> <u>God</u>, and <u>it was credited to him as righteousness</u>.

*Jeremiah 31:31-33 Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when <u>I will</u> <u>make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah</u>. It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt - a covenant they broke, though I was a husband to them, declares the LORD. But this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD. I will put My law in their minds and inscribe it on their hearts.

*Hebrews 8:4-13 Now if He were on earth, He would not be a priest at all, since there are those who offer the gifts according to the Law; <u>who serve a copy and</u> <u>shadow of the heavenly things</u>, just as Moses was warned by God when he was about to erect the tabernacle; for, See, He says, that you make all things according to the pattern which was shown you on the mountain. <u>But now He</u> <u>has obtained a more excellent ministry, by as much as He is also the mediator</u> <u>of a better covenant, which has been enacted on better promises</u>.

*Hebrews 13:20 Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep <u>through the blood of the eternal covenant</u>, even Yeshua <u>our Lord</u>. *Hebrews 8:6 But now the work Yeshua has been given to do is far superior to theirs, just as the covenant he mediates is better. For this covenant has been given as Torah on the basis of better promises.

*Deuteronomy 29:11a,12a &14 for you enter into covenant with your God<u>in</u> order to establish you today for Him as a people, and He will be God to you....with the one who is here standing with us today in front of the LORD our God, and with the one who isn't here with us today.

*Deuteronomy 29:17-19 And you have seen their detestable things, their idols of wood and stone, of silver and gold, which were among them. <u>Beware lest there be</u> <u>among you a man or woman or clan or tribe whose heart is turning away today from</u> <u>the Lord our God to go and serve the gods of those nations</u>. Beware lest there be among you <u>a root</u> <u>w</u>r<u>w</u> bearing poisonous and bitter fruit, one who, when he hears the words of this sworn covenant, <u>blesses himself in his heart, saying, I shall be</u> <u>safe, though I walk in the stubbornness of my heart</u>. This will lead to <u>sweeping</u> <u>away the drunk and thirsty alike</u>.

*Revelation 18:7 In the measure that she glorified herself and lived luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow ; for she says in her heart, I sit as queen and am no widow, and will not see sorrow. Therefore, her plagues will come in one day - death and mourning and famine......

*Genesis 3:6 So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired <u>to make one wise</u> <u>wey</u>, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate.

*Acts 10:43 To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.

***Isaiah 61:1-3** The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord,....

*Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because <u>He</u> h<u>as anointed Me</u> To preach the gospel to the poor; He has <u>sent Me</u> to heal the brokenhearted, To

proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.

*Isaiah 11:1 A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from <u>his roots</u> a Branch will bear fruit. but with righteousness He will judge the needy, with justice He will give decisions for the poor of the earth. He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth; with the breath of His lips he will slay the wicked.

*Revelation 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the <u>Root of David</u> has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.

*Isaiah 61:10 -11 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, <u>My soul shall be joyful in</u> <u>my God</u>; For <u>He has clothed me with the garments of salvation</u>, <u>He has covered</u> <u>me with the robe of righteousness</u>, As a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, And as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

*Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's handiwork, <u>created in Yeshua Ha Mashciach to</u> <u>do good works</u>, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

*Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was enraged at the woman, and went to make war with <u>the rest of her children</u>, who <u>keep the commandments of God and hold</u> to the testimony of Yeshua. And the dragon stood on the shore of the sea.

*Revelation 14:12 Here is a call for the endurance of the saints, those who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.

2 Peter 3:14 And so, dear friends, <u>while you are waiting for these things to</u> <u>happen</u>, make every effort to be found living peaceful lives that are pure and blameless in his sight.

*Isaiah 62:1-5 For Zion's sake I will not hold My peace, And for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, Until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, And her salvation as a lamp that burns. The Gentiles shall see your righteousness, And all kings your glory. You shall be called by a new name, Which the mouth of the LORD will name. You shall also be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD, And a royal diadem in the hand of your God. You shall <u>no longer be termed Forsaken</u>, <u>nor shall your land</u> any more be termed Desolate; But you shall be called <u>Hephzibah</u>, and your land <u>Beulah</u>: For <u>the LORD delights in you</u>, and your land shall be married. For as a young man marries a virgin, So shall your sons marry you; and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

*Isaiah 62:6 On your walls, Jerusalem, <u>I have appointed watchmen</u>; All day and all night <u>they will never keep silent</u>. You who profess the LORD, <u>take no rest for yourselves</u>;

*Jeremiah 6:16-19 This is what the LORD says: <u>Stand</u> at the crossroads and look; <u>ask for the ancient paths</u>, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls. But you said, We will not walk in it. <u>I appointed watchmen</u> <u>over you and said</u>, <u>'Listen to the sound of the trumpet</u>!

***Isaiah 62:10** <u>Go through</u>, יַבְרָד go through the gates! Prepare the way for the people, build up, build up the highway! Take out the stones, <u>lift up a banner</u> for the peoples!

*Genesis 15:17 When the sun had set and it was dark, there appeared a <u>smoking</u> <u>firepot and a flaming torch passing</u> between the animals' pieces.

*Isaiah 63:1-2 Who is this coming from Edom. מָאָלוֹם, from Bozrah with crimson-stained garments? Who is this robed in splendor, marching in the greatness of His strength? It is I, proclaiming vindication, mighty to save. להוֹשִׁיע:

*Genesis 25:30 And Esau said to Jacob, Please feed me with the same red stuff , for I am weary. Therefore his name was called Edom.

*Numbers 24:20 Amalek was the first of the nations; but his latter end shall be that he perish for ever.

*Genesis 36:9 Here are the names of Esau's descendants, the Edomites, born to him in Mount Seir:

*Genesis 36:12 Esau's son Eliphaz also had a concubine named Timna, who bore him Amalek. These were grandsons of Esau's wife Adah.

*Revelation 14:14&19 And I looked and saw a white cloud, and seated on the cloud was <u>One like the Son of Man, with a golden crown on His head and a sharp</u>

<u>sickle in His hand</u>..... So the angel swung his sickle over the earth and gathered the grapes of the earth, and <u>he threw them into the great winepress of God's</u> <u>wrath</u>.
