

## Torah Portion Noach -Noah's Time is Our Time

Genesís 6:9-11:32; Isaíah 54:1-55:5; Luke 17:20-27 .. October 21, 2023 / 6 Cheshvan 5784

- \*Genesis 5:22-24 After he begot Methuselah, <u>Enoch walked with God</u> three hundred years and had sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. And <u>Enoch walked with God and he was not</u>, <u>for God took him</u>.
- \*Genesis 6:9 This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God.
- \*Deuteronomy 5:33 <u>You shall walk</u> in all the way that the Lord your God has commanded you, that you may live, and that it may go well with you, and that you may live long in the land that you shall possess.
- \*Genesis 6:5 And the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- \*Genesis 6:6 And the <u>LORD was sorry</u> that He had made man on the earth, and <u>He was grieved</u> עצַב in His heart.
- \*Genesis 6:7-8 So the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping things and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them. But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- \*Luke 17:27 They were eating and drinking and marrying and being given in marriage, until the day when Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.
- \*Genesis 6:9 This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God.

- \*Genesis 15:6 Abraham believed the Lord, and he counted it to him as righteousness.
- \*James 2:22-24 You see that his <u>faith was working with his actions</u>, and <u>his faith was perfected by what he did</u>. And the <u>Scripture was fulfilled that says</u>, <u>Abraham believed God</u>, and it was credited to him as righteousness, and he was called a friend of God.
- \*Amos 3:3b Do two walk together unless they have agreed to do so?
- \*Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness.
- \*Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lusts.
- \*Galatians 3:27 For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
- \*Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.
- \*Genesis 6:12-13 So God looked upon the earth and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth. And God said to Noah, The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth.
- \*Psalm 58:3 No, in your hearts you devise injustice; with your hands you mete out violence on the earth. The wicked are estranged from the womb; the liars go astray from birth. Their venom is like the venom of a snake, like a cobra that shuts its ears,...

- \*Psalm 11:5 God seeks out the righteous man but loathes the wicked one who loves hamas.
- \*Habakkuk 1:1-4 This is the burden that Habakkuk the prophet received in a vision: How long, O LORD, must I call for help but You do not hear, or cry out to You, "Violence!" but You do not save? Why do You make me see iniquity? Why do You tolerate wrongdoing? <u>Destruction and violence</u> are before me. Strife is ongoing, and conflict abounds. Therefore, the <u>law is paralyzed</u>, and <u>justice never goes forth</u>. For the <u>wicked hem in the righteous</u>, so that <u>justice is perverted</u>.
- \*Zephaniah 1:9 On that day I will punish all who <u>leap over the threshold</u>, who fill the house of their master with violence and deceit.
- \*Genesis 6:13 God said to Noah: The end of all flesh has come before Me, for <u>filled is the earth with violence (Hamas)</u> through them; and indeed, I am set to destroy them from the earth.
- \*Micah 6:12 For the rich men of the city are <u>full of violence</u> [of every kind]; Her inhabitants <u>speak lies</u> And their <u>tongue is</u> <u>deceitful in their mouth</u>.
- \*Ezekiel 7:11 Their violence has grown into a rod to punish their wickedness. None of them will remain: none of their multitude, none of their wealth, and nothing of value.
- \*2 Samuel 22:49 <u>He delivers me from my enemies</u>. You also lift me up above those who rise against me; You have delivered me from the violent man.
- \*Isaiah 60:17b-19 I will appoint peace as your governor and righteousness as your ruler. No longer will violence be heard in your land, nor ruin or destruction within your borders. But you will name your walls Salvation and your gates Praise. No longer will the sun be your light by day, nor the brightness of the moon shine on your night; for the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your splendor....
- \*Genesis 5:29 When Lamech was 182 years old, he had a son. And he named him Noah, saying, May this one comfort us in the labor and toil of our hands caused by the ground that the LORD has cursed.

- \*Genesis 6:14 Make yourself an <u>ark of gopherwood</u>: make <u>rooms</u> in the ark; and <u>cover it inside and outside with pitch</u>.
- \*Genesis 19:24 Then the LORD rained brimstone גַּפְרֵית and fire on Sodom and Gomorrah....
- \*Psalm 11:6 Upon the wicked <u>He will rain</u> coals; fire and <u>וגפּרִית brimstone</u> and a burning wind shall be the portion of their cup.
- \*Exodus 2:3-4 But when she [Jochebed] could no longer hide him, she took a papyrus basket תַּבַת , daubed it with bitumen and pitch, and putting the child in it, placed it among the reeds on the bank of the Nile.
- \*Genesis 6:14 Make for yourself an ark of gopher wood; you shall make the ark with compartments, and cover it inside and out with pitch.
- \*Leviticus 16:16 So he shall make <u>atonement for the Most Holy Place because of</u> the impurities and rebellious acts of the Israelites in regard to all their sins. He is to do the same for the Tent of Meeting which abides among them, because it is surrounded by their impurities.
- \*Genesis 6:16 You shall make a window for the ark, and you shall finish it to a cubit and set the door of the ark in its side.
- I Corinthians 10:4 They all ate the same spiritual food and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.
- \*Revelation 4:3 The one sitting on the throne was as <u>brilliant as gemstones</u>—like jasper and carnelian. And the <u>glow of an emerald circled his throne like a rainbow</u>.
- \*Revelation 4:3 The One seated there looked like jasper and carnelian, and a rainbow that gleamed like an emerald encircled the throne.
- \*Revelation 21:11 It shone with the glory of God, and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.

- \*Genesis 6:16 You shall make a window for the ark, and you shall finish it to a cubit and set the door of the ark in its side.
- \*Zephaniah 2:4-5 For Gaza will be abandoned, and Ashkelon left in ruins. Ashdod will be driven out at noon, and Ekron will be uprooted. Woe to the dwellers of the seacoast, O nation of the Cherethites! The word of the LORD is against you, O Canaan, land of the Philistines: I will destroy you, and no one will be left. ...
- \*Isaiah 16:3 Give us counsel; render a decision. Shelter us at noonday with shade as dark as night. Hide the refugees; do not betray the one who flees. Let my fugitives stay with you; be a refuge for Moab from the destroyer." When the oppressor has gone, destruction has ceased, and the oppressors have vanished from the land,...
- \*Jeremiah 6:4 Prepare for battle against her; rise up, let us attack at noon. Woe to us, for the daylight is fading; the evening shadows grow long. Rise up, let us attack by night and destroy her fortresses.
- \*Luke 23:44 It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three,
- \*Revelation 21:22-23...But I saw no temple in the city, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, because the glory of God illuminates the city, and the Lamb is its lamp.
- \*Isaiah 11:6-9 The wolf shall live with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the kid, the calf and the lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them. The cow and the bear shall graze, their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. The nursing child shall play over the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put its hand on the adder's den. They will not hurt or destroy on all my holy mountain; for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.
