Levíticus 9:1-11:47; 2 Samuel 6:1-7:17; Matthew 3:11-17

- *Matthew 24:34 Truly I say to you that this generation will not have passed away until all these things shall have taken place.
- *Exodus 40:2 On the first day of the first month you shall erect the tabernacle of the tent of meeting.
- *Exodus 40:33 And you shall not go outside the door of the tabernacle of meeting for <u>seven days</u>, until the days of your consecration are ended. For <u>seven days</u> he shall consecrate you.
- *Leviticus 9:1 It came to pass on the <u>eighth day</u> that Moses called Aaron and his sons and the elders of Israel.
- *Leviticus 9:6-7 Then Moses said, This is the thing which the Lord commanded you to do, and the glory of the Lord will appear to you. And Moses said to Aaron, Go to the altar, offer your sin offering and your burnt offering, and make atonement for yourself and for the people. Offer the offering of the people, and make atonement for them, as the Lord commanded.
- *Hebrews 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.
- *Matthew 27:20-23a But the <u>chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowd to</u> ask for Barabbas and to have Jesus executed. Which of the two do you want me to

release to you asked the governor. Barabbas, they answered. What shall I do, then, with Jesus who is called the Messiah, Pilate asked. They all answered, Crucify him!

*Leviticus 9:1&4c It came to pass on the <u>eighth day</u> the Moses called Aaron and his sons and elders of Israel.....for today the LORD will appear to you.

*Habakkuk 2:14 For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

*2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

*Ephesians 4:23-24 to be <u>made new in the attitude of your minds</u>; and to <u>put</u> on the new self, <u>created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness</u>.

*Leviticus 23:36 "For <u>seven days</u> you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. <u>On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation</u>, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it."

*John 7:37-38 On the <u>last and greatest day of the Feast</u>, Yeshua stood up and cried out loudly, If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. Whoever believes in Me, as the Scripture says, <u>out of his innermost being will flow rivers of living water</u>.

*John 3:5-12 Jesus answered, Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God <u>unless they are born of water and the Spirit</u>. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, You must be born again. The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.

¹⁰ "You are Israel's teacher," said Jesus, "and do you not understand these things? ¹¹ Very truly I tell you, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. ¹² I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things?

- **Philippians 4:8** Finally brothers and sisters, whatever is <u>true</u>, whatever is <u>noble</u>, whatever is <u>right</u>, whatever is <u>pure</u>, whatever is <u>lovely</u>, whatever is <u>admirable</u>—if anything is <u>excellent</u> or <u>praiseworthy</u>—think about such things.
- *John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- *Leviticus 9:6 Then Moses said, This is the thing which the <u>LORD</u> commanded you to do and the glory of the <u>LORD</u> will appear to you.
- *Leviticus 9:22-23 Then Aaron lifted his hand toward the people, <u>blessed them</u>, and came down from offering the sin offering, the burnt offering, and peace offerings. And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of meeting and came out and <u>blessed the people</u>. Then the glory of the Lord appeared to all the people,
- *Philippians 1:9-11 And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
- *II Peter 3:11-13 Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.
- *Habakkuk 2:3-4&14 For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay. See, the enemy is puffed up; his desires are not upright— but the righteous person will live by his faithfulness—
- 14) For the <u>earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord</u>, as the waters cover the sea.
- *Leviticus 10:1-2 Then Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censer and put fire in it, put <u>incense on it</u>, and <u>offered profane fire</u> before the Lord, <u>which He had not commanded them</u>. So <u>fire went out from the Lord</u> and devoured them, and <u>they died before the Lord</u>.

*Acts 5:3-6 Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land? Didn't it belong to you before it was sold? And after it was sold, wasn't the money at your disposal? What made you think of doing such a thing? You have not lied just to human beings but to God."

When Ananias heard this, he fell down and died. And great fear seized all who heard what had happened. Then some young men came forward, wrapped up his body, and carried him out and buried him.

*Leviticus 10:3 And Moses said to Aaron, this is what the LORD spoke, saying: By those who come near Me Times I must be regarded as holy; and before all the people I must be glorified. Aaron held his peace.

*James 1:22-25 Obey God's message! Don't fool yourselves by just listening to it. If you hear the message and don't obey it, you are like people who stare at themselves in a mirror and forget what they look like as soon as they leave. But you must never stop looking at the perfect law that sets you free. God will bless you in everything you do, if you listen and obey, and don't just hear and forget.

*Ephesians 3:16 That according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being,

*Psalm 146:9 The LORD watches over the strangers בּרִים He relieves the orphan בּוֹלֵין and widow בְּלֵלְנָה

*Isaiah 54:4 For you will forget the shame of your youth and <u>remember no more</u> the reproach of your widowhood.

*Mark 2:10_Have you not even read this Scripture: 'The <u>stone which the builders</u> rejected, this became the chief corner stone;

- *John 1:11 He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him.
- *James 1:27 Religion that is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.
- *Acts 3:22 For Moses said, The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own people; you must listen to everything he tells you. Anyone who does not listen to him will be completely cut off from among his people.
- *Acts 3:21 For he must remain in heaven until the time for the <u>final restoration</u> <u>of all things</u>, as God promised long ago through his holy prophets.
