

Torah Portion Shemot- And These Are the Names – January 6, 2024 - Tevet 25, 5784 Exodus 1:1-6:1; Isaíah 27:6-28:13;29:22-23; Luke 11:14-22

*Micah 7:15 <u>As in the days when you came out of the land of Egypt</u>, I will show them wonders. The nations shall see and be ashamed of all their might; they shall put their hand over their mouth;

*Genesis 15:12-14 Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and behold, horror and great darkness fell upon him. Then He said to Abram: Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land *that is* not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years. And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward they shall come out with great possessions.

*Philippians 3:20 For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better. Nevertheless, to remain in the flesh is more needful for you...<u>For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ</u>.

*Hebrews 13:14 For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come.

*Colossians 3:2 <u>Set your minds</u> on things that are <u>above</u>, <u>not on things that are on</u> <u>earth</u>.

*Genesis 50:7-8aThen Joseph went to bury his father, and all the servants of Pharaoh accompanied him—the elders of Pharaoh's household and all the elders of the land of Egypt - ...<u>Only their children and flocks and herds were left in Goshen</u> - ...Only their children and flocks and herds were left in Goshen.

*Exodus 1:5 And it was that all the <u>souls يون</u> that issued from the loins of Jacob were <u>seventy souls</u> and Joseph was in Egypt.

*Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is One.

*Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear O Israel, the LORD our God, <u>the Lord is One</u>, and <u>you shall</u> <u>love the LORD your God</u> with <u>all</u> your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength....

*Mark 12:29 Yeshua answered, The first of all commandments is, 'Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God, the LORD is one.

*1 Corinthians 8:6 Yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom are all things and <u>we exist for Him</u>; and one Lord, Yeshua HaMashiach, by whom are all things, and <u>we exist through Him</u>.

***John 14:7** If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him.

*John 14:20 In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

*John 17:23 <u>I in them</u> and <u>You in Me</u>, that they may be <u>perfected in unity</u>, <u>so that the</u> <u>world may know</u> that You sent Me, <u>and loved them</u>, <u>even as You have loved Me</u>.

*Proverbs 23:7 As he thinks in his heart, so he is......

*James 1:4 And let endurance have *its* perfect work, so that <u>you may be perfect and</u> <u>complete</u>, lacking in nothing.

***I Corinthians 6:19** Or do you not know that <u>your body is the temple of the Holy</u> <u>Spirit who is in you</u>, whom you have from God, and <u>you are not your own</u>?

*John 17:21 that <u>all of them may be one</u>, as You, Father, are in Me, and I am in You. May they also be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me.

*Psalm 107:8 Oh, that <u>men would give thanks to the</u> LORD <u>for His goodness</u>, and for <u>His wonderful works to the children of men</u>! For <u>He satisfies</u> the longing soul <u>and fills</u> the hungry soul with goodness.

*Ephesians 3:17-19 so that <u>Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith</u>; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is

the breadth and length and height and depth, and <u>to know the love of Christ which</u> <u>surpasses knowledge</u>, that <u>you may be filled up to all the fullness of God</u>.

*I Corinthians 15:45 So also it is written, <u>The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING</u> SOUL. The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

***I Corinthians 15:45** So it is written [in Scripture], "The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING SOUL (an individual);" the last Adam (Messiah) became a life-giving spirit [restoring the dead to life].

*Galatians 2:20 <u>I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but</u> <u>Christ lives in me</u>; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

*Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you to make atonement for your souls upon the altar; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.

*John 12:49-50 For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. And <u>I know that His</u> <u>command is everlasting life</u>. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak.

*I John 3:24 <u>The one who keeps His commanments abides in Him, and He in him</u>. We know by this that <u>He abides in us</u>, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

*Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, <u>I will come into him and will dine with him, and he with Me</u>.

***John 12:48** He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him – the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.

*Exodus 1:5 And it was that all the <u>souls (nefesh - one soul)</u> that issued from the loins of Jacob were <u>seventy souls</u> (nefesh - one soul) and Joseph was in Egypt.

*Romans 11:13-15&17-20 Now I am speaking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch then as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry in order somehow to make my fellow Jews jealous, and thus save some of them. For if their rejection means the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance mean but life from the dead? But if some of the branches were broken off, <u>and you</u>, although a wild olive shoot, <u>were grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing root of the olive tree</u>, do not be arrogant toward the branches. If you are, remember it is not you who support the root, but <u>the</u>

<u>root that supports you</u>. Then you will say, Branches were broken off so that <u>I might be</u> <u>grafted in</u>. That is true. They were broken off because of their unbelief, but you stand fast through faith. So do not become proud, but fear.

*Genesis 46:3-4 So He said, I am God, the God of your father; <u>do not fear to go down</u> <u>to Egypt</u>, for I will make you a great nation there. <u>I will go down with you to Egypt</u>, and <u>I</u> <u>will also surely bring you up again</u>; and Joseph will put his hand on your eyes.

***Isaiah 63:10** But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit. So He turned and became their enemy, and He Himself fought against them.

*Genesis 46:8 Now these are the names of the children of Israel who were coming to Egypt - Jacob.....

*Exodus 1:1 And these are the names of the Children of Israel who were coming to Egypt; אָת Jacob.

*Revelation 22:13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.

*John 10:30 <u>I and the Father are one</u>.

*Genesis 46:3 So He said, I am God, the God of your father; do not fear to go down to Egypt, מִצְרָׂיָמָה for I will make of you a great nation there.

***II Timothy 3:1-5** But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, <u>having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn</u> <u>away!</u>
