

Torah Portion Sh'míní with Spíritual Warfare Pt. 2 Apríl 6, 2024; Nísan 12, 5784 Levítícus 9:1-11:47; 2 Samuel 6:1-7:17; Luke 22:1-13

*Leviticus 9:1-2 It was on the <u>eighth day</u>, Moses called to Aaron, and to his sons, and to the elders of Israel. He said to Aaron: Take for yourself a calf, a young one of the cattle, for a sin-offering and a ram for a burnt offering unblemished; and offer them before HASHEM.

*Genesis 2:1-2 Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done and He rested (shabbat ישׁבָּת) on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested (shabbat ישׁבַּת) from all His work which God had created and made.

*Leviticus 1:6 Moses said: This is the thing that HASHEM has commanded that you do, so that the glory of HASHEM will be revealed to you.

*Leviticus 9:7-8&16 And Moses said to Aaron, Go to the altar, offer your sin offering and your burnt offering, and <u>make atonement for yourself and for the people</u>. Offer the offering of the people, and make atonement for them, as the Lord commanded.

⁸ Aaron therefore went to the altar and killed the calf of the sin offering, which was for himself. ¹⁵ Then he brought the people's offering, and took the goat, which was the sin offering for the people, and killed it and offered it for sin, like the first one. ¹⁶ And he brought the burnt offering and offered it according to the prescribed manner.

*Leviticus 9:22 Then Aaron lifted his hand toward the people, blessed them, and came down from offering the sin offering, the burnt offering, and peace offerings.

*Leviticus 9:23-24 And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of meeting, and came out and blessed the people. Then the glory of the Lord appeared to all

<u>the people</u>, and fire came out from before the Lord and consumed the burnt offering and the fat on the altar. When all the people saw *it*, they shouted and fell on their faces.

*Leviticus 10:1 Aaron's sons Nadav and Avihu took their censers, put fire in them, and added incense; and they offered unauthorized fire before the Lord, which He had not instructed them to offer.

*Leviticus 10:2 And fire went forth from before HASHEM and consumed them, and they died before HASHEM.

*Leviticus 10:3 Moses said to Aaron, This is what HASHEM spoke, saying:
Through those who are nearest Me I will be sanctified, and thus, before the entire people I will be honored; and <u>Aaron was silent</u>.

*Genesis 4:3-8 The Lord looked with favor on Abel and his offering, but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favor. So Cain was very angry, and his face was downcast. Then the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast? If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it. Now Cain said to his brother Abel, "Let's go out to the field. While they were in the field, Cain attacked his brother Abel and killed him.

*Numbers 4:15a And when Aaron and his sons have finished covering the sanctuary and all the furnishings of the sanctuary, as the camp sets out, after that the sons of Kohath shall come to carry these, but they must not touch the holy things, lest they die.....

*Numbers 7:9 But Moses did not give any (wagons for transporting) to the Kohathites, because they were to carry on their shoulders the holy things, for which they were responsible.

*2 Samuel 6:6-7 And when they came to Nachon's threshing floor, Uzzah put forth his hand to the ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook it. And the <u>anger of the Lord was kindled against Uzzah</u>; and God smote him there for his error, and there he died by the ark of God.

- *Deuteronomy 4:2 You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the Lord your God that I command you.
- *Revelation 22:18-19 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book. And if anyone takes away from the words of this book of prophecy, God will take away his share in the tree of life and the holy city, which are described in this book....
- *Matthew 24:33 So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.
- *Romans 8:22 We know that <u>the whole creation has been grouning together in</u> <u>the pains of childbirth</u> until the present time.
- *Matthew 27:51 Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth guaked, and the rocks were split,.....
- *Genesis 4:10 The LORD said, "What have you done? Listen! Your brother's blood cries out to me from the ground.
- *Leviticus 18:25-27 And the land is defiled; therefore, I do visit the iniquity therefore upon it, and the <u>land itself vomits out her inhabitants</u>. You shall therefore keep my statutes and my judgments, and shall not commit any of these abominations; neither any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourns among you;
- *Leviticus 18:28 That <u>the land</u> spue not you out also when you defile it, as it spued out the nations that were before you.
- *Jeremiah 16:18 I will repay them double for their wickedness and their sin, because they have defined my land with the lifeless forms of their vile images and have filled my inheritance with their detestable idols.

- *2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
- *Leviticus 25:2-5 Speak to the Israelites and say to them: When you enter the land I am going to give you, the land itself must observe a sabbath to the Lord. For six years sow your fields, and for six years prune your vineyards and gather their crops. But in the seventh year the land is to have a year of sabbath rest, a sabbath to the Lord. Do not sow your fields or prune your vineyards. Do not reap what grows of itself or harvest the grapes of your untended vines. The land is to have a year of rest.
- *Jeremiah 25:11 This whole country will become a desolate wasteland, and these nations will serve the king of Babylon seventy years.
- *Romans 8:19-23 For the <u>creation waits</u> with eager longing for the revealing of the children of God; for the creation was subjected to futility, not of its own will but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope that <u>the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to decay and will obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.</u> We know that the whole <u>creation has been groaning in labor pains</u> until now; and <u>not only the creation</u>, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, <u>groan inwardly while we wait for adoption</u>, the redemption of our bodies.
- *2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore <u>if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation</u>. The old has passed away. Behold, the new has come! All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:...
- *Ephesians 4:32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, <u>forgiving each other</u>, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.
- *2 Corinthians 5:19-20 that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And He has committed to us the <u>message</u> of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us.
- *Ephesians 2:12-13.... that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise,

having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

*Hosea 2:21-23 It shall come to pass in that day That I will answer, says the Lord; I will answer the heavens, And they shall answer the earth. The earth shall answer With grain, With new wine, And with oil; They shall answer Jezreel (G-d will sow). Then I will sow her for Myself in the earth, And I will have mercy on her who had not obtained mercy; Then I will say to those who were not My people, You are My people! And they shall say, 'You are my God!

*Ephesians 2:6 (NOW He has) raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

*Revelation 2:29 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
