

Torah Portíon Tazría - Part 3 Sprítíual Warfare Apríl 13, 2024; Nísan 5, 5784 Levítícus 12:1 - 13:59; II Kíngs 4:42-5:19; Matthew 17:9-15

- *Haggai 2:7 And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts.
- *Leviticus 12:1-2 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying: If a woman has conceived, and borne a male child, then she shall be unclean seven days; as in the days of her customary impurity she shall be unclean. And on the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.
- *Isaiah 4:1-2a Comfort, comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned, that she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins.
- *Luke 2:21-25: And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called Yeshua, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb. Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord (as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord"), and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons.
- *Revelation 12:1-6 Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars. Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth. And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads. His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born. She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne. Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days.

- *Matthew 2:16 Then Herod, having seen that he had been outwitted by the Magi, was intensely enraged. And having sent forth, he put to death all the boys in Bethlehem and in all its vicinity from two years old and under, according to the time he had ascertained from the Magi.
- *Matthew 2:19-21 But when Herod died, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, and said, "<u>Get up, take the Child and His mother, and go to the land of Israel; for those who sought the Child's life are dead</u>." So Joseph got up, took the Child and His mother, and came into the land of Israel.
- *Genesis 37:9-11 "Then he had another dream, and he told it to his brothers. "Listen," he said, "I had another dream, and this time the sun and moon and eleven stars were bowing down to me."

When he told his father as well as his brothers, his father rebuked him and said, "What is this dream you had? Will your mother and I and your brothers actually come and bow down to the ground before you?" His brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept the matter in mind.

- *Leviticus 12:8b So the priest shall make atonement for her, and she will be clean. THE SON SHE BORE WILL GROW UP TO BE HER ATONEMENT AND SHE WILL BE CLEAN.
- *Ezekiel 36:24-26 For I will take you from among the nations and gather you out of all the countries, and I will bring you back into your own land. I will also sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. I will cleanse you from all your impurities and all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will remove your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh....
- *Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given, and the government will be upon His shoulders. And He will be called <u>Wonderful Counselor</u>, <u>Mighty God</u>, <u>Everlasting</u> Father, Prince of Peace.
- *Matthew 4:23-25 (Amplified Bible) And He went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the good news (gospel) of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people [demonstrating and revealing that He was indeed the promised Messiah].
- *Revelation 19:11-16 Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war. His eyes are like a flame of fire, and on his head are many diadems, and he has a name written that no one knows but himself. He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by

- which he is called is The Word of God. And the armies of heaven, arrayed in fine linen, white and pure, were following him on white horses. From his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and he will rule them with a rod of iron. He will tread the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God the Almighty. On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.
- *Leviticus 12:1 Speak to the children of Israel, saying: If a woman has conceived and borne a male (ZACHAR) child....
- *Leviticus 13:2 When <u>a man אַלִּם</u> (ADAM) has on his skin of his body a swelling, a scab or a bright spot, and it becomes on the skin of his body like a leprous sore.
- *1 Corinthians 15:45-49 And so it is written, The first man Adam became a living being. The last Adam became a life giving spirit.
- *I Corinthians 15:21-22 For since by man came death, by <u>Man</u> also came the <u>resurrection of the dead</u>. For as in Adam all die, even so <u>in Christ all shall</u> be made alive.
- *Leviticus 13:2 When a man אָדָם has on his skin of his body a swelling, a scab or a bright spot, and it becomes on the skin of his body like a leprous soreSO THE MESSIAH WOULD BECOME THE ONE ASSOCIATED WITH LEPROSY. HE BECAME THE LEPER.
- *Isaiah 53:4 Surely He took on our infirmities and carried our sorrows; yet we considered Him stricken by God, struck down and afflicted. But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed....
- *Matthew 8:17 This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: He took on our infirmities and carried our diseases.
- *Leviticus 13:6bhe shall dwell alone; outside the camp shall his habitation be.
- *Leviticus 14:2 This is the law for the one afflicted with a skin disease on the day of his cleansing, when he is brought to the priest.
- *Matthew 8:4 After sternly warning him, He sent him away at once, saying to him, "See that you say nothing to anyone; but go, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, as a testimony to them."

- *Matthew 11:4-6 Yeshua answered and said to them, Go and report to John what you hear and see: the blind receive sight and the lame walk, the <u>lepers are cleansed</u> and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them. And blessed is he who does not take offense at Me.
- *I Peter 2:2 <u>He himself bore our sins in his body</u> on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. <u>By his wounds you have been healed</u>.
- *Hebrews 13:12 So Jesus also <u>suffered outside the</u> gate in order to sanctify the people through his own blood.
- *John 4:23-24 But a time is coming and has now come when the <u>true worshipers will</u> worship the Father in spirit and in truth, for the Father is <u>seeking such</u> as these to worship Him. God is Spirit, and His worshipers must worship Him in spirit and in truth.
- *Galatians 5:19 -21 Now the <u>works of the flesh</u> are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that <u>those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God</u>.
- *Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's handiwork, <u>created in Christ Jesus to do good works</u>, <u>which God prepared in advance for us to do</u>.
- *Romans 8:1-2&6 There is therefore now <u>no condemnation</u> for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but <u>those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.</u> For to be fleshly minded is death and to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
- *John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.
- *Luke 17:10 Then the seventy returned with joy saying, Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.
- *Luke 10:18-21 And He said to them, I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.

- *Jeremiah 23:29 <u>Is not my word like fire</u>? declares the Lord, <u>and like a hammer which shatters a rock</u>?
- *Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation and the <u>sword of the Spirit</u>, <u>which is</u> <u>the word of God</u>.
- *Psalm 119:1 Blessed are those who walk in the law of the Lord," who walk in God's word.
- *Ephesians 4:21-24 if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: that you <u>put off</u>, <u>concerning your former conduct</u>, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be <u>renewed in the spirit of your mind</u>, <u>and that you put on</u> the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
- *John 15:3 Now you are clean through the Word which I have spoken to you.
- *Psalm 119:9 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by <u>taking heed according</u> to Your Word.
- *Galatians 5:1-26 For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.
