

Torah Portion Terumah -"Are We Experiencing God?" Exodus 25:1-27:19;I kings 5:26(12)-6:13; Mark 12:35-44 Feb. 17, 2024 - Adar I 8, 578

- *Exodus 25:1-2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto <u>the children of Israel</u>, and <u>let them take for Me</u> a <u>raised up portion</u>, from <u>every man</u> that <u>gives it willingly with his heart</u> you shall <u>take My offering</u>.
- *I Corinthians 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Yeshua HaMashiach, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought.
- *John 13:35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.
- *Ephesians 1:9-10 And He has made known to us the mystery of His will according to His good pleasure, which He purposed in Christ as a plan for the fullness of time, to bring all things in heaven and on earth together in Messiah.
- *Matthew 22:32-34 Yeshua said to him, You shalt <u>love the Lord your God with all your heart</u>, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it, You shalt love your neighbor as yourself.
- *Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.
- *Philippians 2:3-6 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Messiah Yeshua: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.
- *Acts 20:35 In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how He Himself said, <u>It is more blessed to give than to receive.</u>

- *Exodus 25:1-2 Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring Me an offering, from everyone who gives it willingly with his heart you shall take My offering.
- *Corinthians 9:7 <u>Each one must give as he has decided in his heart</u>, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
- *Proverbs 3:9 Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.
- *Exodus 25:8 They shall make for Me a (Mishkan), and I will dwell in their midst.
- *Revelation 15:5 After these things I looked, and behold, the temple of the <u>tabernacle</u> of the <u>testimony</u>, in heaven was opened.
- *I Corinthians 3:16 Don't you know that <u>you are a temple of God</u>, and that <u>God's Spirit</u> <u>lives in you</u>?
- *I Corinthians 3:17 ... for the temple of God is holy, which temple you are..
- *II Peter 1:4 ...by which He has granted to us His precious and very great promises, so that through them you may become <u>partakers of the divine nature</u>, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire.
- *Romans 8:16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.
- *Exodus 25;3,4-5a And this is the offering which you shall take from them: gold, silver, and bronze; blue, purple, and scarlet thread, fine linen, and goats' hair; ram skins dyed red, badger skins, and acacia wood;
- *Matthew 23:17 You blind fools! For which is greater, the gold or the temple that has made the gold sacred?
- *Job 23:10 But He knows the way I take; when He has tried me, I shall come forth as gold.
- *Exodus 12:34-36 Now the children of <u>Israel had done according to the word of</u>
 <u>Moses</u>, and they had asked from the Egyptians <u>articles of silver</u>, <u>articles of gold</u>, <u>and</u>

<u>clothing.</u> And the Lord had given the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they granted them what they requested. Thus, they plundered the Egyptians.

*Exodus 21:32 If the ox shall push a manservant or a maidservant; he shall give unto their master thirty shekels of silver, and the ox shall be stoned.

*Leviticus 17:11 For the <u>life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.</u>

*Matthew 26:14-16, 27:3-9 Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, "What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him (Jesus) to you?" And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver...

Then Judas, His betrayer, seeing that He had been condemned, was remorseful and brought back the <u>thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders</u>, saying, "I have <u>sinned by betraying innocent blood</u>." And they said, "What is that to us? You see to it!"

Then he threw down the pieces of silver in the temple and departed, and went and hanged himself.

But the chief priests took the silver pieces and said, "<u>It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, because they are the price of blood</u>." And they consulted together and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. Therefore, that field has been called the Field of Blood to this day.

*Exodus 26:32 You shall hang it upon the four pillars of acacia wood overlaid with gold. Their hooks shall be gold, <u>upon four sockets of silver</u>.

*Exodus 25:4blue, purple, and scarlet thread, fine linen, and goats' hair;

*Hebrews 11:37 They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins <u>and goatskins</u>, <u>being destitute</u>, <u>afflicted</u>, <u>tormented</u>.

- *Luke 9:58 And Jesus said to him, Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the <u>Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head</u>.
- *Revelation 6:12 "The sun became black as sackcloth of hair."
- *Psalm 114:1-4a When Israel went out of Egypt, The house of Jacob from a people of strange language Judah became His sanctuary, And Israel His dominion. The sea saw it and fled; Jordan turned back. The mountains skipped like rams,.....
- *Micah 5:4 And He shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord his God.
- *II Peter 1:17 For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty.
- *Romans 8:34 Who is the one who condemns us? Christ Jesus is the One who died [to pay our penalty], and more than that, who was raised [from the dead], and who is at the right hand of God interceding [with the Father] for us.
- *Numbers 15:38-39a Put a blue thread in each one of these tassels. Wear them from now on. You will have these tassels to look at to <u>remind you of all the LORD's commands</u>. Then you will obey them and not be disloyal by following what your bodies and eyes want.
- *Matthew 21:11 And the crowds were saying, This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth in Galilee.
- *John 6:14 Therefore when the people saw the sign which He had performed, they said, This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world.
- *Revelation 19:13,16 <u>He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood</u>, and the name by which <u>He is called is The Word of God</u>... On his robe and on his thigh <u>He has a name written</u>, King of kings and Lord of lords.

*Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and <u>let them be for signs</u>, and for seasons, and for days, and years:

*Psalm 68:34 Tell everyone about God's power. His majesty shines down on Israel; his power is mighty in the skies.
