Shalom! Noach: Genesis 6:9-11:32 - Isaiah 54:1-55:5 -Matthew 24:36-46 October 29, 2022

*Genesis 6:5,6 Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great upon the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was altogether evil all the time. The LORD regretted that He had made mankind on the earth, and <u>He was [deeply] grieved in His</u>

<u>heart</u>. <u>אַצַר</u>

***Isaiah 63:9a** In all their affliction, <u>He was afflicted</u>. When we suffer, He suffers

***Isaiah 63:10a** But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit. When we rebel, He knows it will be costly to us and it grieves His Spirit.

*Romans 1:28 Furthermore, since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, He gave them up to a depraved mind, to do what ought not to be done.

*Genesis 6:9 This is the account of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation; Noah walked הָהָכּלָה with God.

*Genesis 5:29 Out of the ground that the LORD has cursed, this one shall bring us relief from our work and from the painful toil of our hands.

*Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

*Genesis 6:13 God said to Noah, I have decided to put an end to all flesh, for the earth is filled with lawlessness because of them: I am about to destroy them with the earth.

*Genesis 6:14 Make for yourself an ark of gopher wood; make it an ark <u>n ⊇ n</u> with compartments, and cover ¬⊇⊇ it inside out with pitch.
*Exodus 2:3 And when she could no longer hide him, she took for him an ark <u>n ⊇ n</u> and covered it with tar and pitch.

*Matthew 24:42-44 We are told? Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore, you also <u>be ready</u>, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

How do we prepare ourselves for His coming?

***II Peter 3:10,11** But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to <u>live holy and godly lives</u>.

*Luke 17:26-30 And as it was in the days of Noah, <u>so it will be also in</u> <u>the days of the Son of Man</u>: They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, <u>until the day that Noah entered the ark</u>, <u>and the flood came and destroyed them all</u>. Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built; but on the day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed *them* all. Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed. *Genesis 7:1 The LORD said to Noah, Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you are righteous before me in this generation.

***II Corinthians 4:7-10** But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the <u>power may be of God</u> and not of us. We are <u>hard pressed</u> on every side, yet <u>not crushed</u>; we are <u>perplexed</u>, but <u>not</u> in <u>despair</u>, <u>persecuted</u>, but <u>not forsaken</u>; <u>struck down</u>, <u>but not</u> <u>destroyed</u>, always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the <u>life of Jesus may also be manifested in our body</u>.

***II Corinthians 5:21** For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

***John 10:28-30** I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; <u>no one will snatch them out of my hand.</u>

My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; <u>no one can</u> <u>snatch them out of my Father's hand.</u>

I and the Father are one. Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, <u>I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the</u> whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth.

*Revelation 3:10 Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, <u>I will keep you from the hour of trial</u> that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth.

***Psalm 85:2** You forgave the iniquity of your people; you <u>covered all</u> <u>their sin.</u>

*Genesis 7:1 The Lord said to Noah, Go into the ark, with all your household, for you alone have I found righteous before Me in this generation.

*Genesis 15:6 Abram believed the LORD, and it was credited to him as righteousness.

***Isaiah 61:10** I will rejoice greatly in the Lord, My soul will exult in my God; For He has clothed me with garments of salvation, <u>He has</u> <u>wrapped me with a robe of righteousness</u>,

*1 Corinthians 1:30 But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us <u>wisdom</u> from God, and <u>righteousness</u> and <u>sanctification</u>, <u>and redemption</u>.

*2 Corinthians 5:21 He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Genesis 6:9 (Amplified) These are the records of the generations (family history) of Noah. Noah was a righteous man [<u>one who was just</u> <u>and had right standing with God]</u>, <u>blameless</u> in <u>his [evil] generation</u>; Noah <u>walked (lived) [in habitual fellowship] with God</u>.

*Matthew 24:37-39 But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be. For as in the days that were before the flood <u>they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage</u>, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, and knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.

*Matthew 24;11-13 Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

***II Corinthians 11:13,14** For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ.

And no wonder, for Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light.

*2 Timothy 4:3-4 For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths.

***I Peter 1:5** But those who endure and stand firm in the faith, despite incitements to do otherwise, are showing that they are genuine children of God "who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

*Revelation 3:21 To the one who overcomes, I will grant the right to sit with Me on My throne, just as I overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

*Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

*2 Corinthians 1:22 placed His seal on us, and put His Spirit in our hearts as a pledge of what is to come.

*Genesis 7:16 Thus they entered comprised of male and female of all flesh as God had commanded him. <u>And the Lord shut him in</u>.

*John 10:7-9 All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them. <u>I am the door</u>. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

For the mountains shall depart And the hills be removed, But My kindness shall not depart from you, Nor shall My covenant of peace be removed, Says the LORD, who has mercy on you.

*Zephaniah 3:12,13 I will leave in your midst A meek and humble people, And they shall trust in the name of the LORD. The <u>remnant of</u> <u>Israel</u> shall do no unrighteousness And speak no lies, Nor shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth; For they shall feed their flocks and lie down, And no one shall make them afraid.

*II Peter 2:5 and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, <u>bringing in the</u> <u>flood on the world of the ungodly;</u>
