Va'Etchanan - And He Pleaded

July 29,, 2023 - Av 11, 5783 Deuteronomy 3:23-7:11; Isaíah 40:1-26; Luke 3:2-15



*Deuteronomy 34:7 Moses was a hundred and twenty years old when he died, yet his eyes were not weak, and his vitality had not diminished.

*Joshua 14:10-11 And now, behold, the LORD has kept me alive, just as he said, these forty-five years since the time that the LORD spoke this word to Moses, while Israel walked in the wilderness. And now, behold, I am this day eighty-five years old. I am still as strong today as I was on the day Moses sent me; as my strength was then, so my strength is now, for war and for going out and coming in.

*Deuteronomy 7:7 The LORD did not set His affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than the other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples.

*Deuteronomy 4:6-8 See, I am teaching you the statutes and ordinances as the LORD, my God, has commanded me, that you may observe them in the land you are entering to possess.

Observe them carefully, for this is your wisdom and discernment in the sight of the peoples, who will hear of all these statutes and say, This great nation is truly a wise and discerning people.

For what great nation is there that has gods so close to it as the LORD, our God, is to us whenever we call upon him?

Or what great nation has statutes and ordinances that are <u>as just as this whole</u> law which I am setting before you today?

*Deuteronomy 31:8 It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed.

*John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,

and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

- *Exodus 32:32 But now, if you will forgive their sin—but if not, <u>please blot me</u> out of your book that you have written
- *Romans 9:3 For I could wish that I myself were cursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my own flesh and blood,
- *Deuteronomy 3:23-25 At that time I pleaded with the LORD and said, O Sovereign LORD, you have only begun to show Your greatness and the strength of Your hand to me, Your servant. Is there any god in heaven or on earth who can perform such great and mighty deeds as You do? I pray thee, let me go over, and see the good land beyond Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon.
- *Isaiah 2:3 Many peoples will come and say, Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the god of Jacob.
- *Jeremiah 22:7-8 Against you I will send destroyers, each with their tools: They shall cut down your choice cedars, and cast them into the fire. Many nations will pass by this city and ask one another: Why has the LORD done this to so great a city?
- *Luke 18:28-30 Then Peter said, See, we have left all and followed You. So He said to them, Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or parents or brothers or wife or children, for the sake of the kingdom of God, who shall not receive many times more in this present time, and in the age to come eternal life.
- *Revelation 22:12 Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done.
- *Deuteronomy 23:26 But HASHEM became angry with me <u>because of you</u>, and He did not listen to me; HASHEM said to me, It is enough for you! Do not again speak to Me any more about this matter.

- *Deuteronomy 18:15 (Moses tells us,) The Lord your God will raise up for you a <u>prophet like me from among you</u>, from your brothers it is to him you shall listen.
- *Numbers 20:8,11-12 Take the staff, and you and your brother Aaron gather the assembly together. Speak to that rock before their eyes and it will pour out its water. You will bring water out of the rock for the community so they and their livestock can drink. Then Moses raised his arm and struck the rock twice with his staff. Water gushed out, and the community and their livestock drank. But the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, Because you did not trust in me enough to honor me as holy in the sight of the Israelites, you will not bring this community into the land I give them.
- *2 Corinthians 5:21 For our sake He <u>made Him to be sin</u> who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.
- *Matthew 26:38-39 Then He said to them, My soul is <u>consumed with sorrow</u> to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with Me. And going a little farther <u>He fell on his face and prayed</u>, saying, My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will.
- *Genesis 14:14-16 When Abram heard that his kinsman had been taken captive, he led forth his trained men, born in his house, 318 of them, and went in pursuit as far as Dan. And he divided his forces against them by night, he and his servants, and defeated them and <u>pursued them to Hobah</u>, north of Damascus. Then he brought back all the possessions, and also brought back his kinsman Lot with his possessions, and the women and the people.
- *Luke 23:32-33 Two others, both criminals, were led out to be executed with Him. When they came to a place called The Skull they nailed Him to the cross. And the criminals were also crucified—one on His right and one on His left.
- *Hebrews 7:22 Because of this oath, <u>Yeshua has become the</u> guarantor of a better covenant.
- *Galatians 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

- *Acts 15:17 So that the rest of mankind may seek the Lord, and all the Gentiles who are called by My name,
- *Genesis 17:5 No longer will you be called Abram, but your name will be Abraham, for I have made you a father of many nations.
- *Genesis 17:15 And God said to Abraham, As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall be her name.
- *Revelation 3:12 The one who overcomes I will make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will never again leave it. <u>Upon him I will write the name of My God</u>, and the name of the city of My God (the new Jerusalem that comes down out of heaven from My God), and My new name.
- *Romans 2:28-29 A man is not a Jew because he is one outwardly, nor is circumcision only outward and physical.
- No, a <u>man is a Jew because he is one inwardly</u>, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a man's praise does not come from men, but from God.
- *Revelation 22:4 And they shall see His face; and <u>His name</u> <u>shall be</u> <u>in their foreheads</u>.
- *Deuteronomy 4:25-27 ב When you have children and children's children, and you will have been long in the land, וְנוֹשֵׁנְתֵּם should you then act corruptly by fashioning an idol in the form of anything, and by this evil done in his sight provoke the LORD, your God, I call heaven and earth this day to witness against you, that you shall all quickly perish from the land which you are crossing the Jordan to possess. You shall not live in it for any length of time but shall be utterly wiped out. The LORD will scatter you among the peoples, and there shall remain but a handful of you among the nations to which the LORD will drive you.
- *Psalm 147:19 says: He has revealed His word to Jacob, His laws and decrees to Israel.

- *Deuteronomy 27:9 Then Moses and the priests, the Levites, spoke to all Israel, saying, <u>take heed and listen</u>, O Israel: This day you have become the people of the LORD your God.
- *Genesis 3:10 I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid.
- *Genesis 11:7 Come, let us go down and confuse their language so they will <u>not understand</u> each other.
- *Genesis 17:20 I have taken into account what you have said; I will bear it in mind; it is a consideration that weighs with Me.
- *Genesis 21:12 Whatever Sarah says to you, do as she tells you.
- *1 Kings 19:11-12, Then a very strong wind blew... But the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind, there was an earthquake. But the Lord was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake, there was a fire. But the Lord was not in the fire. After the fire, there was a quiet, gentle voice.
- *Proverbs 3:6 <u>Listen for God's voice in everything you do</u>, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track.
- *Deuteronomy 30:20, Love the Lord your God, listen to His voice, and hold fast to Him.
- *Isaiah 30:21, Whether you turn to the right or to the left, <u>your ears will hear</u> <u>a voice behind you</u>, saying, This is the way; walk in it.
- *1 Samuel 3:9 So Eli told Samuel, Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.
