

Congregation Notes Vayak'hel-Pikudei פְקוּדֵי וַיַּקְהֵל March 18, 2023 - Adar 25, 5783 Exodus 35:1-40:38; Ezekiel 45:16-18; Luke 22:1-13

- *I Corinthians 6:19,20 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore, glorify God with your body.
- *Genesis 11:1-4 Now the whole earth had <u>one language and one speech</u>. And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found <u>a plain in the land of Shinar</u>, and they dwelt there. Then they said to one another, "Come, let us make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They had brick for stone, and they had asphalt for mortar. And they said, "Come, <u>let us build ourselves a city</u>, and a tower whose top is in the heavens; <u>let us make a name for ourselves</u>, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth.
- *2 Chronicles 36:15-17 The Lord, the God of their fathers, sent persistently to them by his messengers, because He had compassion on his people and on his dwelling place. But they kept mocking the messengers of God, despising His words and scoffing at His prophets, until the wrath of the Lord rose against his people, until there was no remedy. Therefore He brought up against them the king of the Chaldeans (- THE CHALDEANS WERE THE BABYLONIANS), who killed their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary and had no compassion on young man or virgin, old man or aged. He gave them all into his hand.
- *Daniel 1:6-8 Among those young men were Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah from the tribe of Judah. <u>Ashpenaz gave them Babylonian names</u>. Daniel's new name was Belteshazzar, Hananiah's was Shadrach, Mishael's was Meshach, and Azariah's was Abednego. Daniel did not want to eat the king's rich food and wine because it would make him unclean.
- *Zechariah 2:6,7 "Get up! Get up! Flee from the land of the north," declares the LORD, "for I have scattered you like the four winds of heaven," declares the LORD. "Get up, O Zion! Escape, you who dwell with the Daughter of Babylon!"

*Zechariah 5:6-11 Then the angel who was speaking with me came forward and told me, "Now lift up your eyes and see what is approaching." "What is it?" I asked.

And he replied, "A measuring basket is going forth." Then he continued, "This is their iniquity in all the land. "And behold, the cover of lead was raised, and there was a woman sitting inside the basket. "This is Wickedness," he said. And he shoved her down into the basket, pushing down the lead cover over its opening. Then I lifted up my eyes and saw two women approaching, with the wind in their wings. Their wings were like those of a stork, and they lifted up the basket between heaven and earth. "Where are they taking the basket?" I asked the angel who was speaking with me. "To build a house for it in the land of Shinar," he told me. "And when it is ready, the basket will be set there on its pedestal."

*Revelation 17:3-5 Then the angel carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness. There I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was covered with blasphemous names and had seven heads and ten horns. The woman was dressed in purple and scarlet, and was glittering with gold, precious stones and pearls. She held a golden cup in her hand, filled with abominable things and the filth of her adulteries. The name written on her forehead was a mystery: BABYLON THE GREAT THE MOTHER OF PROSTITUTES AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

*Revelation 18:1-4 And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

*Genesis 11:6 (Amplified Bible) And the LORD said, "Behold, they are one [unified] people, and they all have the same language. This is only the beginning of what they will do [in rebellion against Me], and now no evil thing they imagine they can do will be impossible for them.

- *Exodus 35:1 Then Moses gathered all the congregation of the children of Israel together, and said to them, These are the words which the LORD has commanded you to do:
- *Exodus 35:2 Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh day shall be a holy day for you, a Sabbath of rest to the LORD. Whoever does any work on it shall be put to death.

- *Numbers 21:9 New King James Version So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived.
- *Exodus 35:5-6...Moses also told the whole congregation of Israel, "This is what the LORD has commanded: Take from among you an offering to the LORD. <u>Let everyone whose heart is willing bring an offering to the LORD</u>: gold, silver, and bronze:
- *Exodus 38:8-11 He made the <u>laver and its base of bronze</u> from the mirrors of the women who ministered at the door of the Tent of Meeting. And he made the court: for the south side the <u>hangings of the court were of fine twined linen</u>, a hundred cubits; Their <u>pillars and their bronze sockets or bases were twenty</u>; the <u>hooks</u> of the pillars and their <u>joinings</u> were silver.
- *Ecclesiastes12:14 For <u>God shall bring every work into judgment</u>, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.
- *Psalms 96:13 Let all creation rejoice before the LORD, for He comes, <u>He comes</u> to judge the earth.
- *Exodus 34:6,7a And the LORD passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet He does not leave the guilty unpunished;....."

- *James 5:3-4 Your gold and silver have corroded, and their corrosion will be evidence against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have laid up treasure in the last days. Behold, the wages of the laborers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, are crying out against you, and the cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord of hosts.
- *Matthew 25:14-16 Then one of the Twelve, the one called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and asked, "What are you willing to give me if I hand Him over to you?" And they set out for him thirty pieces of silver. So from then on Judas looked for an opportunity to betray Jesus....
- *Exodus 38:10 AMPC Their pillars and their bronze sockets or bases were twenty; the hooks of the pillars and their joinings were silver.
- *Exodus 38:26-27And of the <u>hundred talents of silver were cast the sockets of the sanctuary</u>, and the sockets of the vail; an hundred sockets of the hundred talents, a talent for a socket.
- *Exodus 30:16 Receive the <u>atonement money</u> from the Israelites and use it for the service of the tent of meeting. It will be a memorial for the Israelites before the LORD, making atonement for your lives."

- *Exodus 35:30,31,34 And Moses said to the children of Israel, See, the LORD has called by name <u>Bezalel</u> the son of <u>Uri</u>, the son of <u>Hur</u>, of <u>the tribe of Judah</u>; and has filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom and understanding, in knowledge and all manner of workmanship....And He has put in his heart the ability to teach, in him and Aholiab the son of Ahisamach, of the <u>tribe of Dan</u>.
- *Psalm 85:10 Mercy and truth are met together; Righteousness and peace have kissed each other.

*Romans 8:22-24 And this righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no distinction, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus....

*Exodus 38:21 These are the accountings of the Tabernacle, the Tabernacle of Testimony, which were conducted by the word of Moses.

*Exodus 40:36-38 And when the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the children of Israel went onward in all their journeys: But if the cloud were not taken up, then they journeyed not till the day that it was taken up. For the cloud of the Lord was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

*Numbers 19:1-9

"This is a requirement of the law that the LORD has commanded: Tell the Israelites to bring you a red heifer without defect or blemish and that has never been under a yoke.

- <u>3</u> Give it to Eleazar the priest; it is to be taken outside the camp and slaughtered in his presence.
- 4 Then Eleazar the priest is to take some of its blood on his finger and sprinkle it seven times toward the front of the tent of meeting.
- 5 While he watches, the heifer is to be burned—its hide, flesh, blood and intestines.
- <u>6</u> The priest is to take some cedar wood, hyssop and scarlet wool and throw them onto the burning heifer.
- 7 After that, the priest must wash his clothes and bathe himself with water. He may then come into the camp, but he will be ceremonially unclean till evening.
- 8 The man who burns it must also wash his clothes and bathe with water, and he too will be unclean till evening.
- <u>9</u> "A man who is clean shall gather up the ashes of the heifer and put them in a ceremonially clean place outside the camp. They are to be kept by the Israelite community for use in the water of cleansing; it is for purification from sin.
