

Torah Portion VaYetze - In a Time of War the Bride is Called November 25, 2023 - Kislev 12, 5784 Genesis 28:10-32:3; Hosea 12:13-14:10; John 1:41-51

- *Genesis 28:10 Now Jacob went out from Beersheba and went toward Haran.
- *Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
- *I Peter 1:6-7 In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith-of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire-may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.
- *I Peter 5:10 And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
- *Romans 5:3 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- *Genesis 28:11 So he came to a certain place and stayed there all night because the sun had set. And he took one of the stones of that place and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place to sleep.
- *Genesis 28:11 So <u>he came (vayifgah)</u> to a <u>certain place</u> and he stayed there all night, because the <u>sun had set</u>. And he took one of the stones of <u>that place</u> and put it at his head, and he lay down in <u>that place</u> to sleep.
- *Genesis 19:27 Now Abraham <u>arose early in the morning</u> and went to the place where <u>he had stood before the Lord</u>;

- *Genesis 24:63 And Isaac went out to meditate in the field toward evening. And he lifted up his eyes and saw, and behold, there were camels coming.
- *Genesis 7:9 The days of the years of my sojourning are 130 years. Few and evil have been the days of the years of my life, and they have not attained to the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their sojourning.
- *I Thessalonians 5:16-17 Rejoice always, <u>pray without ceasing</u>, <u>give thanks in all circumstances</u>; for this is the will of God in Yeshau HaMashiach for you.
- *Luke 21:34-36 But be on your guard. Don't let the sharp edge of your expectation get dulled by parties and drinking and shopping. Otherwise, that Day is going to take you by complete surprise, spring on you suddenly like a trap, for it's going to come on everyone, everywhere, at once. So, whatever you do, don't fall asleep at the wheel. Pray constantly that you will have the strength and wits to make it through everything that's coming and end up on your feet before the Son of Man.
- *Genesis 28:22 And this stone which I have set as a pillar shall be God's house, and of all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You.
- *Genesis 28:12-13 And he dreamed and there appeared a <u>ladder that was set up</u> on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. And behold the <u>LORD stood above it</u> and said: I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants.
- *Isaiah 29:16 They turn everything upside down. How silly they are to think that potters are like the clay...
- *Hebrews 13:20 Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Yeshua, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Yeshua HaMashiach, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
- *Luke 9:23 Then he said to them all: Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.

- *James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.
- *John 1:51 Amen, amen I tell you, you will see heaven opened and the angels of God going up and coming down on the Son of Man!
- *Hebrews 1:2 In these last days He has spoken to us through a Son.
- *Genesis 28:18-19a Jacob arose early in the morning and he took the stone that he had put at his head, set it up as a pillar, and poured oil on top of it. And he called the name of that place Bethel.....
- *Hosea 13:9-10a Oh, Israel, you are destroyed, but your help is from Me. I will be your King; Where is any other, that he may save you in all your cities?
- *Isaiah 42:1 Here is My Servant, whom I uphold, My Chosen One, in whom My soul delights. I will put My Spirit on Him, and He will bring justice to the nations.
- *Isaiah 41:8 But you, <u>Israel</u>, <u>are My servant</u>, Jacob whom I have chosen, The descendants of Abraham My friend.
- *Hosea 13:12 The iniquity of Ephraim is bound up: His sin is stored up. The sorrows of a woman in childbirth shall come upon him.
- *Joel 3:16 The <u>Lord will roar like a lion from Jerusalem</u>; his loud voice will thunder from that city, and the sky and the earth will shake. But the <u>Lord will be</u> a safe place for his people, a strong place of safety for the people of Israel.
- *Hosea 13:1b,6b,7 But when he offended through Baal worship, he died. Now they sin more and more, and have made for themselves molded images, idols of their silver.....They were filled and <u>their heart was exalted</u>; therefore <u>they forgot Me</u>.....So <u>I will be to them like a lion</u>, like a leopard by the road I will lurk.....
- *Revelation 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

- *Ezekiel 38:1a Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying Son of man, set your face against Gog of the land of Magog —
- *Ezekiel 38:5-6 Persia, Ethiopia and Libya are with them,
- *Isaiah 17:1&12-14 A prophecy against Damascus: See, Damascus will no longer be a city but will become a heap of ruins. Woe to the many nations that rage—In the evening, sudden terror! Before the morning, they are gone! This is the portion of those who loot us, the lot of those who plunder us.
- *Isaiah 17:1 The burden against Damascus. <u>Behold, Damascus will cease</u> from being a city, and it will be a ruinous heap.
- *Hosea 13:16 They shall fall by the sword. Their infants shall be dashed in pieces, and their women with child ripped open.
- *Hosea 14:1-2a;4&7 O Israel return to the LORD your God, for you have stumbled because of your iniquity; take words with you and return to the LORD. Say to Him, Take away all iniquity; receive us graciously.......AND THE LORD WILL SAY: I will heal their backsliding. I will love them freely, for My anger has turned away from him..... Those who dwell under this shadow shall return; they shall be revived like grain, and grow like a vine. Their scent shall be like the wine of Lebanon.
- *Joel 3:9&2b Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare for war! Wake up the mighty men. Let all the men of war draw near.... On account of My people, My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations; they have also divided up My land.....
- *Joel 2:15-16 Blow the trumpet in Zion, Consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; gather the people, sanctify the congregation assemble the elders, gather the children and nursing babes: Let the bridegroom go out from his chamber, and the bride from her dressing room.
- *Matthew 25:6a And at midnight a cry was heard: Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!
