

יַתְרו- Torah Portion Yitro

February 11, 2023 – Shevat 13

Exodus 18:1 - 20:23; Isaiah 6:1 - 7:6; 9:5-6/6:-7; Matthew 19:16-26

*Exodus 17:11-13 And so it was, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed, and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed. But Moses' hands became heavy; so they took a stone and put it under him, and he sat on it. And Aaron and Hur supported his hands one on one side and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun. So <u>Joshua</u> <u>defeated Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword</u>.

*Exodus 18:1a And Jethro, the priest is of Midian, Moses' father-in-law, heard of all that God had done for Moses and for Israel His people - that the LORD had brought Israel out of Egypt.

*Exodus 18:1b (Moses had) heard of all that God had done for Moses and for Israel His people - that the LORD had brought Israel out of Egypt.
*Exodus 18:2 So Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, took Zipporah, Moses' wife, after she had been sent home,.....

*Exodus 18:3-4 (he sent her back) with her two sons , of whom the name of one was Gershom for he said, "<u>I have been a stranger in a foreign land</u>", and the name of the other was Eliezer (for he said, "<u>The God of my father was my help</u>, and delivered me from the sword of Pharaoh."

*Exodus 18:7-12 So Moses went out to meet his father-in-law, bowed down, and kissed him. And they asked each other about their well-being, and they went into the tent. And <u>Moses told his father-in-law all that the Lord had</u> <u>done to Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel's sake, all the hardship that</u> <u>had come upon them on the way, and how the Lord had delivered them</u>. Then <u>Jethro rejoiced for all the good which the Lord had done for Israel</u>, whom He had delivered out of the hand of the Egyptians. <u>And Jethro said</u>, "<u>Blessed be</u> <u>the Lord</u>, who has delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians and out of the hand of Pharaoh, and who has delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians. <u>Now I know that the Lord is greater than all the gods</u>; for in <u>the very thing in which they conspired to do</u> <u>tri</u>. <u>He was above them</u>." Then <u>Jethro</u>, <u>Moses' father-in-law</u>, took a burnt offering and other sacrifices to <u>offer to God</u>. And <u>Aaron came with all the elders of Israel to eat bread with</u> <u>Moses' father-in-law before God</u>.

*Ezodus 14:21 <u>And you shall discern</u> from among the entire people men of accomplishment, men who fear God, men of truth, who despise unjust gain, and you shall appoint them over the people as leaders.....

*Exodus 19:1 In the <u>third month from the Exodus of the Children of Israel from</u> <u>the land of Egypt</u>, on this day, they arrived at the wilderness of Sinai.

*Exodus 19:2 They journeyed from Rephidim and arrived at the wilderness at Sinai and encamped in the wilderness and <u>encamp</u> <u>in there</u> did Israel, opposite the mountain.

*Exodus 19:3-4 Moses ascended to God and He called to him HASHEM did from the mountain, saying, Thus shall you say to the House of Jacob and relate to the Children of Israel. You have seen what I did to Egypt, and that <u>I have born you on</u> <u>the wings of eagles</u> and <u>brought you to Me</u>.

*Exodus 19:5-6 And <u>now if you listen well to My Voice and observe My covenant</u>, you shall be to Me the <u>most beloved treasure</u> of all peoples, for Mine is the entire world. You <u>shall</u> be to Me a kingdom of priests and a nation that is holy. These are the words that you shall speak to the people.

*Exodus 19:8 They responded - the entire people together - and they said, Everything that HASHEM has spoken we shall do!

*Exodus 19:10-11 HASHEM said to Moses, Go to the people and sanctify them today and tomorrow, and they shall wash their clothing. Let them <u>be prepared for</u> <u>the third day</u>, for <u>on the third day</u> HASHEM will descend before the eyes of the entire people on Mount Sinai.

*John 2:1-10 On the third day there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus also was invited to the wedding with his disciples. When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

*Genesis 22:4 On the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes and saw the place from afar.

*Luke 18:33 And after flogging him, they will kill him, and <u>on the third day he</u> will rise."

*Luke 13:32 And he said to them, "Go and tell that fox, 'Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and <u>the third day I finish my</u> <u>course.</u>

***Ezekiel 43:2** Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east: and, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and <u>his voice was like a noise of many waters:</u>

*Revelation 1:15 describes the One who stood before him, saying in part, "And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the <u>sound</u> <u>of many waters</u>."

***Job 37:40** After it a voice roars; <u>He thunders with His majestic voice</u>, And He does not restrain them when His voice is heard. <u>God thunders marvelously</u> <u>with His voice</u>;

*Job 40:9 Have you an arm like God? Or can you thunder with a voice like His?

*<u>Psalm 18:13</u>: The LORD <u>thundered from heaven</u>, And the Most High <u>uttered His</u> <u>voice</u>. . . .

*Exodus 19:16 On the third day, when morning came, there was <u>thunder</u> ightning. A thick cloud was upon the mountain, and a very loud blast of the ram's horn went out, so that all the people in the camp trembled.

*Genesis 2:4 These are the generations תוּלְדָוֹת of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

*Genesis 6:9 These are the generations הּוֹלְדָת of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.

*Ruth 4:18-20 Now these are <u>the generations</u> <u>הוּלְדוֹת</u> <u>of Perez</u>: <u>Perez</u> was the <u>father of Hezron</u>, Hezron was the father of Ram, Ram was the father of Amminadab. Amminadab was the father of Nahshon, Nahshon was the father of Salmon, <u>Salmonwas the father of Boaz</u>, <u>Boaz</u> was the father ofObed, Obed was the father of Jesse, and Jesse was the <u>father of David</u>....

*Luke 24:27 Amplified Then beginning with Moses and [throughout] all the [writings of the] prophets, He explained *and* interpreted for them the things referring to Himself [found] in all the Scriptures.

*John 20:22 After saying this, He <u>breathed on them and said</u>, <u>"Receive the</u> <u>Holy Spirit.</u>

*Ezekiel 37:9-14 Then He said to me, "Prophesy to the <u>breath</u>, prophesy, son of man, and <u>say to the breath</u>, 'Thus says the Lord God, "<u>Come from the four</u> <u>winds</u>, <u>O breath</u>, and breathe on these slain, that they come to life.""" So I prophesied as He commanded me, and the <u>breath came into them</u>, and they <u>came to life and stood on their feet</u>, an exceedingly great army.

*Proverbs 4:4 Then he taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; Keep my commandments and live;

*Matthew 19:17 And He said to him, "Why are you asking Me about what is good? There is only One who is good; but if you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments.

***Isaiah 55:1** Come, all you who are thirsty, <u>come to the waters</u>; and you without money, come, buy, and eat!

*<u>John 4:14</u> But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the <u>water I give him will become in him a fount of water springing up to eternal</u> <u>life</u>.

*John 5:39 You diligently search the Scriptures because you think to have eternal life in them, and these are they bearing witness concerning Me;

***Psalm 29:3-4**The voice of the LORD *is* over the waters; The <u>God</u> of glory thunders; The LORD *is* over many waters. The voice of the LORD *is* powerful; The voice of the LORD *is* full of majesty.
