*Isaiah 43:4a "you are precious and honored in my sight"

*Leviticus 8:5 And Moses said to the congregation, This is the thing הַדָּבָּר the LORD commanded to be done.

*Ecclesiastes 1:9 The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.

*Acts 3:20-21 and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began.

*John 19:30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "<u>It is finished</u>!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

*John 14:6 "I am the way, <u>the truth</u> and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

***Isaiah 46:10a** I declare the end from the beginning, and ancient times from what is still to come.

*Deuteronomy 34:11,12 in all the signs and wonders which the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt, before Pharaoh, before all his servants, and in all his land, and by all that <u>mighty power and all the great terror</u> which Moses performed in the sight of all <u>Israel</u>.

*Luke 21:25-28 "There will be signs in the sun, moon and stars. On the earth, nations will be in anguish and perplexity at the roaring and tossing of the sea. <u>Men</u> will faint from terror, apprehensive of what is coming on the world, for the heavenly bodies will be shaken. <u>At that time they will see the Son of Man coming</u> in a cloud with power and great glory. When these things begin to take place, <u>stand</u> <u>up and lift up your heads, because your r</u>edemption is drawing near."

*Leviticus 8:14-15 And he brought the <u>bull for the sin offering</u>. Then Aaron and his sons laid their hands on the head of the bull for the sin offering; and Moses killed it. Then he took the blood and put some on the horns of the altar all around with his finger and purified the altar. And he poured the blood at the base of the altar, and consecrated it, to make atonement for it.

*Revealtion 13:8b of the Lamb that was slain [in sacrifice] from the foundation of the world.

*Hebrews 7:26 For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless; undefined, separate from sinners, and has become higher that the heavens: who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for his own sins and then for the peoples', for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

*Leviticus 6:8 Then the LORD spoke "??? to Moses, saying <u>Command Aaron and</u> <u>his sons</u>, saying, This is the law of the burnt offering: The burnt offering shall be on the hearth upon the altar all night until morning, and the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it.

*Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us <u>continually offer the sacrifice of</u> <u>praise to God</u>, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to His name.

*1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always, <u>pray without ceasing</u>, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

***I Peter 2:5** you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, <u>to offer up spiritual sacrifices</u> acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

*Leviticus 4:3 If the anointed priest π π π is sins, bringing guilt on the people, he must bring to the LORD a young bull without blemish as a sin offering for the sin he has committed.

* Hebrews 7:11 Now <u>if perfection was through the Levitical priesthood</u> (for on the basis of it the people received the Law), <u>what further need was there for</u> <u>another priest to arise according to the order of Melchizedek</u>, and <u>not be</u> <u>designated according to the order of Aaron</u>?

*Psalm 110:4 The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind, "<u>You are a priest</u> forever, according to the order of Melchizedek."

*Hebrews 6:20 where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us, <u>having become a</u> <u>high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek</u>.

*Leviticus 8:1 Then the LORD said to Moses, Take Aaron and his sons, their garments, <u>the anointing oil</u>, the bull of the sin offering, the two rams, and the basket of unleavened bread,...

*Exodus 28:41 Put these on your brother Aaron and his sons; then <u>anoint</u>, <u>ordain</u>, <u>and consecrate them</u>, so that they may <u>serve Me as priests</u>.

*2 Kings 9:6 So Jehu left the others and went into the house. Then the young prophet <u>poured the oil over Jehu's head</u> and said, This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: <u>I anoint you king over the Lord's people</u>, <u>Israel</u>.

*Luke 4:17-19&21 And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written, The <u>Spirit of the Lord is upon Me</u>, Because <u>He hath anointed Me to</u> <u>preach the gospel to the poor</u>; He hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD......And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

*2 Corinthians 1:21-22 And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and <u>has anointed us</u>, and who has also put his seal on us and given us His Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

*Leviticus 8:6 Then Moses brought Aaron and his sons and washed them with water.

***Exodus 29:4** And Aaron and his sons you shall bring to the door of the tabernacle of meeting, and <u>you shall wash them with water</u>.

*Matthew 28:19-20 Go therefore and <u>make disciples of all nations</u>, <u>baptizing</u> <u>them</u> in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <u>teaching</u> <u>them to observe all that I have commanded you</u>. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

*Matthew 3:13-15 Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness." Then John consented.

*Peter 2:9....for <u>you</u> are a chosen people. <u>You are royal priests</u>, <u>a holy nation</u>, <u>God's very own possession</u>. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.

*Leviticus 8:14-15 And he brought the bull for the sin offering. Then Aaron and his sons laid their hands on the head of the bull for the sin offering, and Moses killed *it*. *Hebrews 9:22 Indeed, under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins...

*Ephesians 1:7 In him <u>we have redemption through his blood</u>, <u>the forgiveness of</u> <u>sins</u>, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

*John19:34 Instead, one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water flowed out.

*Hebrews 7:26-28 For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens <u>Unlike</u> <u>the other high priests</u>, <u>he does not need to offer sacrifices day after day</u>, first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people. <u>He sacrificed for their sins</u> <u>once for all when he offered himself</u>. For the law appoints as high priests men who are weak; but the oath, which came after the law, appointed the Son, who has been made perfect forever. *Malachi 3:1 Behold, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And <u>the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple</u>, even the Messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight. <u>Behold, He is coming, says</u> <u>the LORD of hosts.</u>

*Matthew 5:10-12 And His disciples asked Him saying, Why then do the scribes say that Elijah must come first? Jesus answered and said to them, Indeed, <u>Elijah</u> is coming first and will restore all things. But I say to you that <u>Elijah has come</u> <u>already</u>, and <u>they did not know him but did to him whatever they wished</u>. Likewise, the Son of Man is also about to suffer at their hands.

*Matthew 11:14 For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. And if you are willing to receive *it*, he is Elijah who is to come.

*Malachi 3:4-11 "Then <u>the offering</u> of Judah and Jerusalem will be pleasant to the Lord, As in the days of old, As in former years. ⁵ And <u>I will come near you for</u> <u>judgment</u>; I will be a swift witness against sorcerers, against adulterers, against perjurers, against those who exploit wage earners and widows and orphans, and against those who turn away an alien—

Because they do not fear Me, "Says the Lord of hosts. ⁶ "For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore, you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob. ⁷ Yet from the days of your fathers you have gone away from My ordinances And have not kept *them*.

Return to Me, and I will return to you, "Says the Lord of hosts. "But you said, 'In what way shall we return?'

⁸ "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings. ⁹ You are cursed with a curse, for you have robbed Me, this whole nation. ¹⁰ Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you *such* blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. ¹¹ "And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes,

*Malachi 4:1-6 1 "For behold, the day is coming, Burning like an oven, And all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the day which is coming shall burn them up," Says the Lord of hosts, "That will leave them neither root nor branch.

2 But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves.

3 You shall trample the wicked, For they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet On the day that I do this," Says the Lord of hosts.

<u>4</u>"Remember the Law of Moses, My servant, Which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, With the statutes and judgments.

<u>5</u> Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord.

6 And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, And the hearts of the children to their fathers, Lest I come and strike the earth with a curse."
