

Torah Portíon Pesach VII Apríl 30, 2024; Nísan 22, 5784 Deuteronomy 15:19-16:17; Isaíah 10:32-12:6 John 20:15-20

- *Romans 3:24-26 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Yeshua the Messiah, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Yeshua.
- *Ephesians 1:3-4 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with <u>every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ</u>, just as <u>He chose us</u> in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be <u>holy and without blame before Him in love</u>.
- *Hebrews 13:14-16 For this world is not our home; we are looking forward to our everlasting home in heaven. With Yeshua's help we will continually offer our sacrifice of praise to God by telling others of the glory of his name. Don't forget to do good and to share what you have with those in need, for such sacrifices are very pleasing to him.
- *Ephesians 1:4 He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world.....
- *Revelation 3:18 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
- *John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life....
- *I Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that <u>your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit</u>, who is in you, whom you have received from God? <u>You are not your own</u>; you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your bodies.
- *Psalm 100:3 Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

- *Psalm 114:1 When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language, Judah became His sanctuary and Israel His dominion. The mountains were jumping like goats, and the little hills like lambs.
- *Psalm 114:7 Tremble, O earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob.....
- *Isaiah 60:1-4 Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. (WHEN WILL THIS HAPPEN?) For behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will be seen upon you. And nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising. Lift up your eyes all around, and see; they all gather together, they come to you; your sons shall come from afar, and your daughters shall be carried on the hip.
- *Daniel 2:12-13 For this reason the king was angry and very furious; and gave the command to destroy all the wise men of Babylon. So the decree went out, and they began killing the wise men; and they sought Daniel and his companions, to kill them.
- *Daniel 2:17-19; 22-23 Then <u>Daniel went to his house</u>, and made the decision known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, <u>his companions</u>, that <u>they might seek mercies from the God of heaven concerning this secret</u>, so that Daniel and his companions might not perish with the rest of the wise men of Babylon. <u>Then the secret was revealed to Daniel in a night vision</u>. So <u>Daniel blessed the God of heaven</u>......

He reveals deep and secret things; <u>He knows what is in the darkness</u>, <u>And light dwells with Him</u>. I thank You and praise You, O God of my fathers; You have given me wisdom and might, And have now made known to me what we asked of You, For You have made known to us the king's demand.

- *Daniel 2:41,43-44 Whereas you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; yet the strength of the iron shall be in it, just as you saw the iron mixed with ceramic clay. And as the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong and partly fragile...... As you saw iron mixed with ceramic clay, they will mingle with the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, just as iron does not mix with clay. And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.
- *Daniel 7:9-10 I watched till thrones were put in place, And the Ancient of Days was seated; His garment was white as snow, And the hair of His head was like pure wool.

His throne was a fiery flame, Its wheels a burning fire; A fiery stream issued And came forth from before Him. And a <u>thousand thousands ministered to Him</u>; Ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was seated, And the books were opened.

- *Revelation 1:14 His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;
- *Revelation 5:11-12Then I looked, and I heard the voices of many angels and living creatures and elders encircling the throne, and their number was myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands. In a loud voice they were saying: Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing!
- *Daniel 7:21-23 I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them, until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom. Thus he said: The fourth beast shall be a fourth kingdom on earth, Which shall be different from all other kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, trample it and break it in pieces.
- *Daniel 7:25 He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall persecute the saints of the Most High, and shall <u>intend to change times and law</u>. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time.
- *John 6:35 Then Jesus declared, <u>I am the bread of life</u>. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.
- Matthew 4:4 Jesus answered, It is written: Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.
- *John 6:51a I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone <u>eats of this</u> <u>bread</u>, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.
- *Isaiah 40:8 The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.

- *Romans 15:4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.
- *Isaiah 55:11 So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.
- *Psalm 104:15 And wine that makes glad the heart of man, oil to make his face shine, and bread which strengthens man's heart.
- *I John 5:4 For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.
- *Matthew 26:29 I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.
- *Isaiah 11:6-9 The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the young goat, the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. The cow and the bear shall graze; Their young ones shall lie down together; And the lion shall eat straw like the ox. The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord As the waters cover the sea.
- *Deuteronomy 28:2And all these blessings will come upon you and overtake you, if you will obey the voice of the LORD your God:
