## Phíneas/Pínchas

July 8, 2023 – 12 Tammuz 5783 Numbers 25:10-30:1; Jeremiah 1:1-2:3; John 2:13-22

\*Exodus 1:9,12 Here, the Children of Israel is <u>more numerous and powerful</u> than we...And (the Egyptians) <u>felt a disgust</u> at the Children of Israel.

\*Numbers 22:3,4 And Moab was very fearful because of the people because it was <u>numerous</u>, and Moab felt a <u>disgust</u> at the Children of Israel. <u>Moab said to the</u> <u>elders of Midian</u>, Now as an ox licks up of the grasses, all the congregation will lick up the greenery of the field.

**\*Psalm 60:11-12** Oh give us help against the adversary, for deliverance by man is in vain. <u>Through God we shall do valiantly, and it is He who will tread down our adversaries</u>.

**\*Psalm 5:11a** But let all those rejoice <u>who put their trust in You</u>; Let them ever shout for joy, <u>because You defend them</u>;

\*2 Corinthians 2:14a But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in <u>Christ</u>,

\*Numbers 22:12 But God said to Balaam, <u>do not go with them</u>. <u>You must not put a</u> <u>curse on those people, because they are blessed</u>.

\*Numbers 22:18 Even if Balak were to give me his palace filled with silver and gold, I could not do anything great or small to go beyond the command of the Lord my God.

\*Numbers 22:19 Now stay here tonight as the others did, and I will find out what else the Lord will tell me.

\*Numbers 22:20 That night God came to Balaam and said, Since these men have come to summon you, go with them, but do only what I tell you.

\*Proverbs 13:3 The one who guards his mouth preserves his life; the one who opens wide his lips comes to ruin.

\*Genesis 1:1-2 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the <u>Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters</u>.

\*Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the <u>worlds were framed by the</u> <u>word of God</u>, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

\***Proverbs 18:21** The <u>tongue has the power of life and death</u>, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

\*Matthew 12:36 But I tell you that <u>every careless word</u> that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.

\*Proverbs 15:4 The soothing tongue is a tree of life, but a perverse tongue crushes the spirit.

\*Proverbs 21:23 Those who guard their mouths and their tongues keep themselves from calamity.

\*Numbers 24:5-7a How <u>beautiful are your tents</u>, Jacob, your dwelling places, Israel! Like valleys they spread out, like <u>gardens beside a river</u>, like aloes planted by the LORD, like <u>cedars beside the waters</u>. <u>Water will flow from their buckets</u>; <u>their seed will have abundant water</u>.

\*Numbers 25:1-3 Israel camped in the Shittim and <u>the people began to stray</u> <u>immorally with the daughters of Moab</u>. They invited the people to the feasts of their gods; the people ate and prostrated themselves to their gods. Israel became attached to Baal Peor, and <u>flare up did the</u> <u>anger of HASHEM</u> against Israel.

\*Revelation 2:12-14 To the angel of the church in Pergamum write the following: This is the solemn pronouncement of the One who has the sharp double-edged sword: I know where you reside, where Satan's throne is. Yet you continue to cling to my name and you have not denied your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas, my faithful witness, who was killed in your city where Satan dwells. But I have a few things against you: you have some people there who follow **the teaching of** <u>Balaam, who instructed Balak to put a stumbling block before the people of</u> <u>Israel so they would eat food sacrificed to idols and commit sexual immorality</u>.

\*Numbers 25:6 And suddenly a man of the Children of Israel came ad brought near to his brothers a Midianite woman before the eyes of Moses and <u>before the</u> <u>eyes of the entire assembly of the Children of Israel</u>; and they were weeping at the entrance of the Tent of Meeting.

\*Numbers 25:1-3 Now Israel remained in the Acacia Grove, and the <u>people began</u> to commit harlotry with the women of Moab. They invited the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people ate and bowed down to their gods. So Israel was joined to Baal of Peor, and the anger of the Lord was aroused against Israel.

\*Numbers 25:7-9 And he (Moses) saw <u>Phineas - son of Elazar, son of Aaron the</u> <u>Kohen</u>, and he got up from the midst of the assembly and <u>he took a spear in his</u> <u>hand. He came after the man of Israel into the tent and impaled them both</u> the man of Israel and the woman into her stomach - and <u>halted was the plague</u> <u>from upon the Children of Isarel</u>. And there were those who died in the plague four and twenty thousand.

\*Numbers 25:11-13 Phinehas son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, <u>has</u> <u>turned My wrath away from the Israelites</u>; for <u>he was zealous for My sake</u> among them, so that I did not consume the Israelites in My zeal. Declare therefore, that <u>I am granting him My covenant of peace It will be a covenant of permanent</u> <u>priesthood for him and his descendants</u>, because he was zealous for his God and made atonement for the Israelites.

\*I Corinthians 10:8, 11-14: We <u>should not commit sexual immorality</u>, as some of them did—and in one day twenty-three thousand of them died. 11-14), These things happened to them as examples and were <u>written down as warnings for us</u>, <u>on whom the culmination of the ages has come</u>. So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. Therefore, my dear friends, <u>flee from idolatry</u>. **\*I Kings 16:30** <u>Ahab</u> son of Omri <u>did more evil in the eyes of the Lord than any of</u> <u>those before him</u>.

**\*I Kings 21:25** Surely there was no one like Ahab who sold himself to do evil in the sight of the Lord, <u>because Jezebel his wife incited him</u>.

**\*I Kings 18:4** for when Jezebel destroyed the prophets of the Lord, Obadiah took a hundred prophets and hid them by fifties in a cave, and provided them with bread and water.

**\*I Kings 18:30** Then Elijah said to all the people, Come near to me. So all the people came near to him. And he repaired the altar of the Lord that was broken down. And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, to whom the word of the Lord had come, saying, Israel shall be your name. Then with the stones he built an altar in the name of the Lord; and he made a trench around the altar large enough to hold two seahs of seed. And he put the wood in order, cut the bull in pieces, and laid *it* on the wood, and said, Fill four waterpots with water, and pour it on the burnt sacrifice and on the wood.

\*I Kings 18:37 Hear me, O Lord, hear me, that this people may know that You are the Lord God, and that <u>You have turned their hearts back to You again</u>. Then the fire of the Lord fell and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood and the stones and the dust, and it licked up the water that was in the trench. Now when all the people saw it, <u>they fell on their faces</u>; and they said, <u>The Lord</u>, <u>He is God! The Lord</u>, <u>He is God</u>! And Elijah said to them, Seize the prophets of Baal! Do not let one of them escape! So they seized them; and <u>Elijah brought them</u> <u>down to the Brook Kishon and</u> <u>executed them there</u>.

\*Malachi 4:4-6 Remember [with thoughtful concern] the Law of Moses My servant, the statutes and the ordinances which I commanded him on [Mount] Horeb [to give] to all Israel. Behold, <u>I am going to send you Elijah the prophet before</u> the coming of the great and terrible day of the LORD. He will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers [a reconciliation produced by repentance], so that I will not come and strike the land with a curse [of complete destruction].

\*Behold, I send you. Eliyahu Ha Navi, before the coming of the great and awesome day of Hashem...and He will turn back (to God) the hearts of the father <u>with</u> (their) sons.

\*John 5:46-47 For <u>if you believed Moses</u>, you would believe Me; for he wrote <u>about Me</u>. But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe My words?

\*Exodus 10:13 So Moses stretched out his staff over the land of Egypt, and throughout that day and night the LORD sent an east <u>wind</u> across the land. By morning the east <u>wind</u> <u>infinite</u> had brought the locusts.

\*Job 12:10 The life of every living thing is in His hand, as well as the breath וְׁרוּחַ of all mankind.

\*Numbers 28:1,2 Now the LORD spoke to Moses saying, Command the children of Israel, and say to them, <u>My offering My food</u> for My offerings made by fire <u>as a</u> <u>sweet aroma</u> to Me, you shall be careful to offer to me at their <u>appointed time</u>.

\*2 Corinthians 2:14 But <u>thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in</u> <u>Christ</u>, and <u>manifests through us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in</u> <u>every place</u>.

\*Numbers 28:3-4 And you shall say to them, This is the offering made by fire which you shall offer to the LORD; <u>two male lambs in their first year without</u> <u>blemish day by day</u> as a regular burnt offering. <u>One you shall offer in the</u> <u>morning</u>, the <u>other lamb you shall offer in the evening</u>.

\*Numbers 28:2 tells us Command the children of Israel, and say to them, My offering, <u>My food</u> קרָת for My offerings made by fire as a sweet aroma to Me, you shall be careful to offer to Me at their appointed time.

\*Matthew 26:26 While they were eating, Jesus took some bread and thanked God for it and broke it. Then he gave it to his followers and said, <u>Take this bread and</u> <u>eat it; this is my body</u>.

\*John 6:35a Then Jesus declared, <u>I am the bread of life</u>.

\*Hebrews 9:22 Without the Shedding of Blood, there is no forgiveness of sins.
