

TORAH PORTION VEZOT HA'BRACHA - AND THIS IS THE BLESING October 7, 2023 - Tíshreí 22, 5784 Deuteronomy 33:1-34:12; Joshua 1:1-18; Acts 1:1-14

\*Deuteronomy 33:1 Now this is the blessing with which Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death.

\*Genesis 49:33 And when <u>Jacob</u> had finished commanding his sons, he drew his feet up into the bed and <u>breathed his last</u>, and was gathered to his people.

\*Genesis 50:24,26 And <u>Joseph</u> said to his brethren, I am dying; but God will surely visit you, and bring you out of this land to the land of which He swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob......So <u>Joseph died</u>, being one hundred and ten years old; and they embalmed him, and he was put in a coffin in Egypt.

\*Deuteronomy 33:1a also says: Now this is the blessing with which Moses the man of God .....

\*Judges 13:3,6,8-22 And the Angel of the LORD appeared to the woman and said to her, Indeed now, you are barren and have born no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son......So the woman came and told her husband, saying, A Man of God came to me, and His countenance was like the countenance of the Angel of God, very awesome; but I did not ask Him where He was from, and He did not tell me His name. Then Manoah prayed to the Lord, and said, "O my Lord, please let the Man of God whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born." And God listened to the voice of Manoah, and the Angel of God came to the woman again as she was sitting in the field; but Manoah her husband was not with her. Then the woman ran in haste and told her husband, and said to him, "Look, the Man who came to me the other day has just now appeared to me!" So Manoah arose and followed his wife. When he came to the Man, he said to Him, "Are You the Man who spoke to this woman?" And He said, "I am." Manoah said, "Now let Your words come to pass! What will be the boy's rule of life, and his work?" So the Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, "Of all that I said to the woman let her be careful. She may not eat anything that comes from the

vine, nor may she drink wine or similar drink, nor eat anything unclean. All that I commanded her let her observe."

Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, "Please let us detain You, and we will prepare a young goat for You." And the <u>Angel of the LORD</u> said to Manoah, "Though you detain Me, I will not eat your food. But if you offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to the Lord." (For Manoah did not know He was the <u>Angel of the LORD</u>.) Then Manoah said to the <u>Angel of the LORD</u>, "What is Your name, that when Your words come to pass we may honor You?" And the <u>Angel of the LORD</u> said to him, "Why do you ask <u>My name</u>, <u>seeing it is wonderful</u>?" So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to the <u>LORD</u>. And He did a wondrous thing while Manoah and his wife looked on—it happened as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar—the <u>Angel of the LORD</u> ascended in the flame of the altar! When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell on their faces to the ground. When the <u>Angel of the LORD</u> appeared no more to Manoah and his wife, then Manoah knew that He was the <u>Angel of the LORD</u>. And Manoah said to his wife, "We shall surely die, because <u>we have seen GOD!</u>

\*Deuteronomy 18:15 Moses declares, The Lord your God will raise up for you <u>a</u> <u>prophet like me from among you</u>, from your brothers—it is to him you shall listen.

- \*Deuteronomy 33:1-3 Now this is the blessing with which <u>Moses the man of God</u> blessed the children of Israel <u>before his death</u>. And he said: The Lord came from Sinai, And dawned on them from Seir; He shone forth from Mount Paran, ...
- \*2 Corinthians 3:18 But <u>we all, with open face</u>, beholding as in a glass the <u>glory</u> <u>of the Lord</u>, are <u>changed</u> into the same image <u>from glory to glory</u>, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- \*Matthew 17:2 and He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.
- \*Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be <u>transformed by the</u> <u>renewing of your mind</u>, that you may prove <u>what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God</u>.
- \*1 Chronicles 16:27 Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his place.

- \*Psalm 5:11 But let all who <u>take refuge in You rejoice</u>; let them ever <u>sing for</u> <u>joy</u>, and spread Your protection over them, that those who love Your name <u>may</u> exult in You.
- \*Psalm 16:11 You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy. At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.
- \*1 Kings 8:66 On the eighth day he sent the people away, and they blessed the king and went to their homes joyful and glad of heart for all the goodness that the Lord had shown to David his servant and to Israel his people.
- \*Psalm 30:5 Weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.
- \*Deuteronomy 33:2a The Lord came from <u>Sinai</u> and <u>dawned from Seir</u>; He shone forth from <u>Mt. Paran.....</u>
- \*Judges 5:4-6 When you, Lord, <u>went out from Seir</u>, when you <u>marched from the land of Edom</u>, the earth shook, the heavens poured, the clouds poured down water. The mountains quaked before the Lord, the One of Sinai, before the Lord, the God of Israel.
- \*Isaiah 63:1 Who is this coming from Edom, from Bozrah, with his garments stained crimson? Who is this, robed in splendor, striding forward in the greatness of his strength? "It is I, speaking in righteousness, mighty to save.
- \*Zephaniah 3:17 The Lord your God is with you, <u>He is mighty to save</u>. He will take great delight in you, He will quiet you with his love, <u>He will rejoice over you</u> with singing.
- \*Deuteronomy 33:1-3 Now this is the blessing with which Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death, And he said: The <u>LORD came</u> from Sinai, And dawned on them from Seir; He shone forth from Mount Paran, <u>And He came with ten thousands of saints</u>; From His right hand <u>came a fiery law for them</u>. - \*Jude 1:14 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."
- \*Zechariah 14:5 Then you shall flee through My mountain valley, For the mountain valley shall reach to Azal. Yes, you shall flee As you fled from the earthquake In the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Thus the LORD my God will come, <u>And all the saints with You.</u>
- \*Deuteronomy 33:2b-3...and he came with ten thousands of saints: from his right hand went a fiery law for them. Yes, he loved the people; all his saints are in thy hand: and they sat down at thy feet; every one shall receive of thy words.
- \*1 Corinthians 1:2 To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who have been sanctified in Messiah Yeshua, saints by calling, with all who in every place call on the name of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, their Lord and ours:
- \*Romans 1:7 to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called as saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Yeshua the Messiah.
- \*Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
- \*Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Yeshua the Mashiach.
- \*Deuteronomy 33:4 Moses commanded a law for us, a heritage of the congregation of Jacob...
- \*Genesis 49:10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; and to Him shall be the obedience of the people.
- \*Isaiah 58:13-14 If you turn away your foot from the Sabbath, From doing your pleasure on My holy day, And call the Sabbath a delight, The holy day of the LORD honorable, And shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, Nor finding your own pleasure, Nor speaking your own words, Then you shall delight yourself in the

LORD; And I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, And <u>feed you</u> with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the LORD has spoken.
