Genesis 28:5 Then Isaac sent Jacob off, and he went to Paddan-aram, to Laban the son of Bethuel the Aramean, the brother of Rebecca, mother of Jacob and Esau.

***Genesis 28:10** Jacob departed from Beer-sheba and he went toward Haran.

***Genesis 28:11** He came upon a certain place בְּמָקוֹם and stopped there for the night, for the sun had set, taking one of the stones of that place, בְּמָקוֹם he put it under his head and lay down in that place. בְּמָקוֹם

***Ephesians 2:20-22** ...having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

***Genesis 29:3** It was the custom there to wait for all the flocks to arrive before removing the stone and watering the animals. Afterward the stone would be placed back over the mouth of the well.

***John 4:14** ...but whoever drinks of the water that I (YESHUUA) will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

***Genesis 28:12** And he dreamed and there appeared a ladder that was set earthward and its top was reaching heavenward; and there appeared angels of God ascending and descending on it.

***Colossians 3:1-2** Therefore, if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth

***Isaiah 43:18,19** Do not remember the former things, Or ponder the things of the past. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.

***Philippians 3:13** Brothers and sisters, I know that I have not yet reached that goal, but there is one thing I always do. Forgetting the past and straining toward what is ahead.

***Genesis 32:21** Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel, for you have commanded angels and men, and you have won.

JACOB WAS ASCENDING!

***Genesis 28:13-14** I am HASHEM, God of Abraham your father and God of Isaac; the ground which you are lying upon, to you will I give it and to your descendants. Your offspring shall be as the dust of the earth, and you shall burst forth westward, and eastward, and northward, and southward; and will be blessed will be all the families of the earth and through your offspring.

***Genesis 28:15-18** Indeed, I am with you; (Anochi) I will guard you in all places that you go, and I will return you to this soil; for I will not leave you until then when I will have done that which I have spoken concerning you. Jacob awoke from his sleep and said,, Surely HASHEM is present in this place and I did not know.

***John 1:14a** And the Word become flesh and dwelt among us.....

NOW UNDERSTANDING THE LAW AS GOD WRITING DOWN HIS VERY SOUL AND GIVING IT TO US MAKES THE FOLLOWING VERSE SO EASY TO UNDERSTAND WHEN YEHSUA SAYS:

***Matthew 5:17,18** Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.

***Genesis 28:17,18** And he became frightened and said, How awesome is this place! **This is none other than the house of God and this is the gate of the heavens!** Jacob arose early in the morning and he took the stone that he placed under his head and set it up as a monument; and he poured oil on its top.

***Genesis 28:19-22** And he called the name of that place Beth-el; however, Luz was the name of the city originally. Then Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and He will guard me on this way that I am going; and He will give me bread to eat and clothes to wear; and I will return in peace to the house of my father and HASHEM will be to me my God. Then this stone which I have set up as a monument shall become a house of God, and all that You will give me I shall repeatedly tithe it to You.

***Genesis 29:1** So Jacob lifted his feet and went toward the land of the people of the east.

***Genesis 29:3** It was the custom there to wait for all the flocks to arrive before removing the stone (AVEN) and watering the animals. Afterward the stone would be placed back over the mouth of the well.

***Isaiah 48:21** They did not thirst when He led them through the deserts; He made water flow for them from the rock (tzur); He split the rock and the water gushed out.

***Luke 6:48** He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock.

***I Corinthians 10:4** And all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ.

***Isaiah 51:1-2** Listen to Me, you who follow after righteousness, You who seek the LORD: Look to the rock from which you were hewn, And to the hole of the pit from which you were dug. Look to Abraham your father, And to Sarah who bore you; For I called him alone, And blessed him and increased him.

***Genesis 29:3** It was the custom there to wait for all the flocks to arrive before removing the stone (AVEN) and watering the animals. Afterward the stone would be placed back over the mouth of the well.

***Genesis 29:4-8** And Jacob said to them, My brethren, where are you from? And they said, We are from Haran. Then he said to them, Do you know Laban the son of Nahor? And they said, We know him. So he said to them, Is he well? And they said, He is well. And look, his daughter Rachel is coming with the sheep. Then he said, Look, it is still high day; it is not time for the cattle to be gathered together. Water the sheep, and go and feed them. But they said, We cannot until all the flocks are gathered together, and they have rolled the stone from the well's mouth; then we water the sheep.

***Genesis 29:10** And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother.

***Jeremiah 2:13** For My people have committed two evils: They have forsaken Me, the fountain of living water, and they have dug their own cisterns—broken cisterns that cannot hold water.

***Jeremiah 2:12** **Be appalled** at this, you heavens, and **shudder with great horror**, declares the LORD.

***John 4:10,11,14** Jesus answered, **If you knew the gift of God and who is asking you for a drink**, you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.

Sir, the woman replied, You have nothing to draw with and the well is deep. Where then will You get this living water?

But whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a fount of water springing up to eternal life.

***Mark 16:4-6** But when they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away, even though it was extremely large. When they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed. But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen!

***Revelation 22:6** Then He said to me, "It is done. **I am the Alpha and the Omega**, the beginning and the end. **I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life without cost.** He who overcomes will inherit these things, and I will be his God and he will be My son.

***Revelation 22:17** **The Spirit and the bride say, "Come."** And let everyone who hears say, "Come." **And let everyone who is thirsty come.** Let anyone who wishes **take the water of life as a gift. ,Come Lord, Jesus.** The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all the saints. Amen.
