

Congregation Notes Torah Portion Behar - The Jubilee and Revelation

May 25, 2024 - 17 Iyyar, 5784 Levítícus 25:1-26:2; Jeremíah 32:6-27; Luke 4:14-22

*Leviticus 25:1 HASHEM spoke to Moses on Mount Sinai, saying:

*Leviticus 25:2 Speak to the children of Israel, and you shall say to them: <u>When you come</u> into the land that I am giving you, rest shall the land, a Sabbath rest for HASHEM.

*Genesis 1:24 Then God said, <u>Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to</u> <u>its kind</u>: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind. And it was so.

*Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living being.

*2 Corinthians 9:10 Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.

*Matthew 9:38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.

***John 4:35** Do you not say, There are yet four months, then comes the harvest? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest.

*Revelation 14:14-20 Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat One like the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in <u>His hand a sharp sickle</u>. And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe. So He who sat on the cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth, and <u>the earth</u> was reaped.

Reaping the Grapes of Wrath

Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. And another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire, and he cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe. So <u>the angel thrust his sickle</u> into the earth and **gathered the vine** of the earth, and threw *it* into the great winepress of

the wrath of God. And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, up to the horses' bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs.

*Leviticus 25:4-6 but in the seventh year there shall be a sabbath of <u>solemn rest for the</u> <u>land</u>, a <u>sabbath to HASHEM</u>. You shall neither sow your field nor prune your vineyard. What grows of its own accord of your harvest you shall not reap, nor gather the grapes of your untended vine, for it is a year of rest for the land. And the <u>sabbath produce of the land shall</u> <u>be food for you</u>: for you, your male and female servants, your hired man, and the stranger who dwells with you, for your livestock and the beasts that are in your land—all its produce shall be for food.

*Hebrews 13:16 And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

*Luke 6:30 Give to everyone who asks from you, and from one who takes away your goods do not demand them back.

*Galatians 6:2 Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

*Leviticus 25:8-10 And you shall count seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you forty-nine years. Then you shall cause the <u>trumpet of the Jubilee to sound</u> on the tenth *day* of the seventh month; on the <u>Day of Atonement</u> you shall make the <u>trumpet to sound throughout all</u> <u>your land</u>. And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout *all* the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.

*Genesis 12:5-6 And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they have gained, and the persons that they have obtained in Charan; and they go out to go towards the land of Canaan; and they come into the land of Canaan. Abram <u>passed</u> <u>through</u> the country into the place of Shechem, as far as the noble vale: now the Chanaanite was at that time in the land.

*Luke 4:16-17 Then Yeshua came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. <u>As was His</u> <u>custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath.</u> And when He stood up to read, the <u>scroll of</u> <u>the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him</u>. Unrolling it, He found the place where it was written:...

*Luke 4:19 The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; <u>To</u> proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.

*Luke 4:20-21 Then He closed the book and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. And He began to say to them, Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.

*Matthew 13:48 which when it was <u>full</u>, they drew to shore; and they sat down and gathered the good into vessels but threw the bad away.

*Philippians 4:19 And my God <u>will fulfill</u> your every need according to his riches in glory in Messiah Yeshua

***Isaiah 13:6-7 & 13** Wail, for <u>the day of the LORD</u> is at hand! It will come as destruction from the Almighty, therefore all hands will be limp, every <u>man's heart will melt</u>, and <u>they will</u> <u>be afraid</u>. Therefore, I will shake the heavens, and <u>the earth will move out of her place</u>.

*Revelation 1:10a I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a voice

*Revelation 6:15 And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, <u>hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks</u> of the mountains,

***Joel 1:15** Alas, for the day! For the day of the LORD is at hand; it shall come as destruction from the Almighty.

*Revelation 9:7b,8b,9,10b,11b ...one third of the trees and all the grass is burned up....a third of the sea became blood and a third of the sea creatures died and a third of the ships were destroyed. A star falls from heaven onto rivers and springs; and the waters become wormwood and many men die.

*Revelation 9:21 And they (the rest of mankind) <u>did not repent</u> of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.

*Revelation 11:15,18,19 Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, <u>The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of</u> <u>His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!</u> The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, And the time of the dead, that they should be judged, And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints,

And those who fear Your name, small and great,

And should destroy those who destroy the earth. Then the <u>temple of God was opened in</u> <u>heaven</u>, and the <u>ark of His covenant was seen in His temple</u>. And there were lightnings, voices, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.

*Leviticus 25:9 Then you shall cause the <u>trumpet of the Jubilee to sound</u> on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the <u>Day of Atonement</u> you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.

***Exodus 19:10-11 & 13b** Then the Lord said to Moses, Go to the people and <u>consecrate</u> <u>them</u> today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes. And <u>let them be ready for the</u> <u>third day</u>. For <u>on the third day</u> the <u>Lord will come down</u> upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people..... When the trumpet sounds long, they shall come near the mountain.

*Hosea 6:1-3 Come, <u>let us return to the LORD</u>. For He has torn us to pieces, but He will heal us; He has wounded us, but He will bind up our wounds.

Joshua 6:5 It shall come to pass, when they make a long *blast* with the ram's horn מיּבָּל and when you hear the sound of the trumpet, that all the people shall shout with a great shout; then the wall of the city will fall down flat. And the people shall go up every man straight before him."

*Leviticus 27:24 In the Year of Jubilee <u>the field shall return to the one from whom it was</u> <u>bought—the original owner of the land</u>.

*Revelation 11:15 & 19 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world <u>are become the kingdoms of our Lord</u>, and of his Messiah; and He shall reign for ever and ever..... And the <u>temple of God was opened in</u> <u>heaven</u>, and there was seen in his temple <u>the ark of his covenant</u>: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.
