

Congregatíon Notes Torah Portíon BaMídbar - In the Wilderness -"The End Tíme Army" June 8, 2024 - Sívan 2 5784 Numbers 1:1-4:20; Hosea 2:1-2:20; Mathew 4;1-17

*Exodus 19:1 At the third new moon after the Israelites had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that very day, they came into the wilderness of Sinai.

***Ruth 2:23** So Ruth stayed close to the women of Boaz to glean until the barley and wheat harvests were finished. And she lived with her mother-in-law.

*Exodus 19:11 and prepare for the third day, because on the third day the Lord will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.

*Acts 2:1-4 When the <u>Day of Pentecost</u> had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

*Exodus 19:16&18 Then it came to pass <u>on the third day</u>, in the morning, that there were <u>thunderings and lightnings</u>, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the <u>trumpet was very loud</u>, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled. Now Mount Sinai was completely in smoke, because <u>the Lord descended upon it in fire</u>. Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain guaked greatly.

*Zechariah 8:3 Thus says the LORD: I will return to Zion, and dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, the Mountain of the LORD of hosts, the Holy Mountain.

*Genesis 46:27 And the sons of Joseph who were born to him in Egypt were two persons; thus all the persons of the house of Jacob who came into Egypt were seventy.

*Exodus 12:37-38 The Israelites journeyed from Rameses to Succoth with about <u>600,000</u> <u>men on foot</u>, <u>besides women and children</u>. And a mixed multitude also went up with them, along with great droves of livestock, both flocks and herds.... *Exodus 15:3 (they sing) The LORD is a man of war The LORD is His name....

*Numbers 1:1-4 Now the Lord spoke to Moses in the Wilderness of Sinai, in the tabernacle of meeting, on the first day of the second month, in the second year after they had come out of the land of Egypt, saying: Take a census of <u>all the congregation</u> of the children of Israel, by their families, by their fathers' houses, according to the number of names, every male individually, ³from twenty years old and above—<u>all who are able to go to war in Israel</u>. You and Aaron shall number them <u>by their armies</u>. ⁴And with you there shall be a man from every tribe, each one the head of <u>his father's house</u>.

*Numbers 1:2 Take a census of <u>all the congregation</u> of the children of Israel, by their families, by their fathers' houses, according to the number of names, every male individually,

*Daniel 8:9-12 And out of one of them came a little horn which grew exceedingly great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the Glorious Land. And it grew up to the host of heaven; and <u>it cast down some of the host and some of the stars to the ground</u>, and trampled them. He even <u>exalted himself</u> as high as the Prince of the host; and by him the <u>daily sacrifices were taken away</u>, and the place of His sanctuary was cast down. Because of transgression, an <u>army was given over to the horn to oppose the daily sacrifices</u>; and <u>he</u> <u>cast truth down to the ground. He did all this and prospered</u>.

*Joshua 5:15 Then the Commander of the Lord's <u>army size</u> said to Joshua, Take your sandal off your foot, for the place where you stand *is* holy. And Joshua did so.

***Psalm 125:2** As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds His people, from this time forth and forevermore. He surrounds His people.

*Ephesians 1:19-22 and what is the <u>exceeding greatness of His power toward us who</u> <u>believe</u>, according to the working of His mighty power which <u>He exerted in Messiah when He</u> <u>raised Him from the dead</u> and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms, far <u>above</u> <u>all rule and authority</u>, <u>power and dominion</u>, <u>and every name that is named</u>, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. And <u>God put everything under His feet and made</u> <u>Him head over everything for the church</u>, <u>which is His body</u>, the fullness of Him who fills all in all......

*Luke 10:19 I have given <u>you authority</u> to trample on snakes and scorpions and to <u>overcome all the power of the enemy</u>; nothing will harm you.

*Malachi 4:1 & 3-4 For behold, the day is coming, Burning like an oven, And all the proud, yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the day which is coming shall burn them up, Says the Lord of hosts, That will leave them neither root nor branch......You shall trample

the wicked, For they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day that I do this, Says the <u>Lord of hosts</u>. <u>Remember the Law of Moses</u>, My servant, Which I commanded him in Horeb. (Mt. Sinai) for all Israel, With the statutes and judgments.

***Psalm 24:8–10** The Lord strong and mighty, The Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates! Lift up, you everlasting doors! And the <u>King of glory</u> shall come in. <u>Who is this King of glory</u>? The <u>Lord of hosts</u>, He is the King <u>of glory</u>. Selah

***Romans 11:17-18** But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, although a wild olive shoot, were grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing root of the olive tree, do not be arrogant toward the branches.

***I Corinthians 9:23** I do all this for the sake of the gospel, so that I may share in its blessings.

*Philippians 3:13b-14 But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize of God's heavenly calling in Messiah Yeshua.

***II** Corinthians 6:3-10 We give <u>no offense in anything</u>, that our ministry may not be blamed. But in all *things* we commend ourselves as ministers of God: <u>in much patience</u>, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and yet true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and yet not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. *Acts 1:8a you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you;

*2 Timothy 2:4 No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

*Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

*Numbers 1:2 Take a census of all the congregation of the children of Israel, by their families, by heir father's houses, according to the number of names of every male individually.

*John 10:27-29 My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. <u>No one can snatch them out of My hand</u>. My Father who has given them to Me <u>is greater than all</u>. <u>No one can snatch them out of My Father's hand...</u>

*Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your

own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. *II Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Messiah, he is a <u>new creature</u>; old tings are passed away, behold all things are become new.

*Ephesians 2:3bwe were by nature children of wrath,

*Romans 6:19 I speak in human terms on account of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you yielded your members in bondage to impurity and to lawlessness unto lawlessness, <u>so now</u> yield your members in bondage to righteousness unto sanctification.

*2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Messiah, <u>he is a new creation</u>; old things have passed away; behold, <u>all things have become new</u>.

*I Corinthians 6:19 What? do you not know <u>that your body is the temple of the Holy</u> <u>Spirit who is in you</u>, whom you have of God, and <u>you are not your own</u>?

*Joel 3:9 Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare for war! Rouse the warriors! Let all the fighting men draw near and attack.
