Signs of a World System Coming to an End  
August 10, 2024 - Av 6, 5784  
Deuteronomy 1:1-3::22; Isaiah 1:1-27; Matthew 24:1-22*

**\*John 5:46-47** For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me; for he wrote about Me. But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe My words?

**\*Deuteronomy 18:17-19** And the Lord said to me, 'They are right in what they have spoken. I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him.

**\*I Chronicles 23:14** As for Moses, the man of God, his sons were included with the tribe of Levi.

**\*Isaiah 11:10** And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, who shall stand as a banner to the people; for the Gentiles shall seek Him, and His resting place shall be glorious.

**Isaiah 11:1** A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit but with righteousness he will judge the needy, with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth. He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth; with the breath of his lips he will slay the wicked.

**\*Matthew 15:24** He answered, I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

**\*Matthew 2:13** Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you, for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him.

**\*Exodus 25:22** There I will meet with you, and I will speak to you—from above the *kapporet*, from between the two cherubim that are on top of the Ark of the Testimony—all that I will command you to [convey to] the Israelite people.

**\*Matthew 17:5** While he yet spoke, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear you him.

**\*John 7:5a** For even his own brothers did not believe in him.

**\*Mark 3:21** When His family heard about this, they went out to take custody of Him, saying, "He is out of His mind." ...

**\*Numbers 12:1** Miriam and Aaron began to talk against Moses because of his Cushite wife, for he had married a Cushite.

**\*Deuteronomy 6:5** You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

**\*Deuteronomy 28:47** Because you did not serve the Lord your God joyfully and gladly in the time of prosperity.

**\*Deuteronomy 1:1** These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel on this side of the Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain opposite Suph, between Paran, Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Dizahab.

**\*Deuteronomy 1:1 (NLT)** These are the words that Moses spoke to all the people of Israel while they were in the wilderness east of the Jordan River. They were camped in the Jordan Valley near Suph, between Paran on one side and Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Di-zahab on the other.

**\*Numbers 14:22**...because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and have not heeded My voice,.....

**\*Deuteronomy 1:1b** They were camped in the Jordan Valley near Suph, between Paran on one side and Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Di-zahab on the other.

**\*Deuteronomy 1:1b**.....between Paran on one side and Tophel, Laban,

**\*Numbers 21:5** The people spoke against God, and against Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no bread, and there is no water; and our soul loathes this light bread.

**\*Numbers 11:4-6** Now the mixed multitude who were among them yielded to intense craving; so the children of Israel also wept again and said: Who will give us meat to eat? We remember the fish which we ate freely in Egypt, the cucumbers, the melons, the leeks, the onions, and the garlic; but now our whole being is dried up; there is nothing at all except this manna before our eyes!

\*Deuteronomy 2:3 Then the Lord said to me, You have made your way around this hill country long enough; now turn north.

\*Ephesians 5:27 so that [in turn] He might present the ecclesia to Himself in glorious splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy [set apart for God] and blameless.

\*2 Corinthians 11:2 For I am jealous over you with a godly jealousy: for I espoused you to one husband, that I might present you as a pure virgin to Messiah. SO PETER SAYS:

\*2 Peter 3:12a as you anticipate and hasten the coming of the day of God, .....

\*Deuteronomy 1:6 HASHEM our God spoke to us at Horeb, saying: You have stayed long enough at this mountain.

\*I John 2:15-17 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father, but is from the world. And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.

\*I Peter 2:11 Dear friends, you are foreigners and strangers on this earth. So I beg you not to surrender to those desires that fight against you.

\*Deuteronomy 1:8 Behold, I have set the land before you: go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give to them and to their seed after them.

\*Ezekiel 37:3-5 He asked me, Son of man, can these bones live? I said, Sovereign Lord, you alone know. Then he said to me, Prophecy to these bones and say to them, Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! This is what the Sovereign Lord says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life.

\*Hosea 6:2 After two days He will revive us; on the third day He will raise us up, that we may live in His sight.

\*Isaiah 1:21-23 How the faithful city (SPEAKING OF JERUSALEM) has become a harlot! It was full of justice; Righteousness lodged in it, But now murderers. Your silver has become dross, Your wine mixed with water. Your princes are rebellious, And companions of thieves;

Everyone loves bribes, And follows after rewards. They do not defend the fatherless, Nor does the cause of the widow come before them.

**\*Isaiah 1:11-15** To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices to Me? Says the Lord. "I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams and the fat of fed cattle. I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs or goats. When you come to appear before Me, who has required this from your hand, to trample My courts? Bring no more futile sacrifices; incense is an abomination to Me. The New Moons, the Sabbaths, and the calling of assemblies-- I cannot endure iniquity and the sacred meeting. Your New Moons and your appointed feasts My soul hates; they are a trouble to Me; I am weary of bearing them. When you spread out your hands, I will hide My eyes from you; even though you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of blood.

**\*Matthew 24:3** Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?

**\*Matthew 24:4-5,11,24,26** And Yeshua answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. <sup>5</sup> For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Messiah,' and will deceive many. <sup>11</sup> Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. <sup>24</sup> For false messiahs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. <sup>26</sup> "Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; or 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe it.

**\*Matthew 24:9** Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake.

**\*Matthew 24:10** And then many will be **offended**, will betray one another, and will hate one another.

**\*Matthew 24:33** So also, when you see all these things, you will know that He is near, right at the door.
