



*Congregation Notes Torah Portion Ki Tetze - When You Go
Endurance in Trials Will Lead to Triumph - Holy Spirit Pt. 2
Deuteronomy 21:10-25:19; Isaiah 54:1-10; Matthew 24:29-42
September 13, 2024; Elul - 5784*

***Deuteronomy 21:1-13** When you go out to war against your enemies, and the Lord your God delivers them into your hand, and you take them captive, and you see among the captives a beautiful woman, and desire her and would take her for your wife, then you shall bring her home to your house, and she shall shave her head and trim her nails. She shall put off the clothes of her captivity, remain in your house, and mourn her father and her mother a full month; after that you may go in to her and be her husband, and she shall be your wife.

***Deuteronomy 21:15-17** If a man has two wives, one loved and the other unloved, and they have borne him children, both the loved and the unloved, and if the firstborn son is of her who is unloved, then it shall be, on the day he bequeaths his possessions to his sons, that he must not bestow firstborn status on the son of the loved wife in preference to the son of the unloved, the true firstborn. But he shall acknowledge the son of the unloved wife as the firstborn by giving him a double portion of all that he has, for he is the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn is his.

***Genesis 29:20-30** So Jacob served seven years for Rachel, and they seemed only a few days to him because of the love he had for her. Then Jacob said to Laban, Give me my wife, for my days are fulfilled, that I may go in to her. And Laban gathered together all the men of the place and made a feast. Now it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter and brought her to Jacob; and he went into her. And Laban gave his maid Zilpah to his daughter Leah as a maid. So it came to pass in the morning, that behold, it was Leah. And he said to Laban, What is this you have done to me? Was it not for Rachel that I served you? Why then have you deceived me? And Laban said, It must not be done so in our country, to give the younger before the firstborn. Fulfill her week, and we will give you this one also for the service which you will serve with me still another seven years. Then Jacob did so and fulfilled her week. So he gave him his daughter Rachel as wife also. And Laban gave his maid Bilhah to his daughter Rachel as a maid. Then Jacob also went into Rachel, and he also loved Rachel more than Leah.

***Genesis 29:33** God has heard that I was unloved (senua), she said, and He also gave me this son.

***Genesis 49:3** Reuben, you are my firstborn, My might and the beginning of my strength, The excellency of dignity and the excellency of power.

***Genesis 48:5** And now your two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, who were born to you in the land of Egypt before I came to you in Egypt, are mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

***Genesis 48:18** And Joseph said to his father, No, my father, this one is the firstborn, put your right hand on his head.

***Genesis 48:19** But his father refused and said, I know, my son, I know. He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great; but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his descendants shall become a multitude of nations.

***Deuteronomy 25:17-18** Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt, how he met you on the way and attacked your rear ranks, all the stragglers at your rear, when you were tired and weary; and he did not fear God.

***Genesis 36:10-12** These are the names of Esau's sons: Eliphaz, the son of Esau's wife Adah, and Reuel, the son of Esau's wife Basemath. The sons of Eliphaz: Teman, Omar, Zepho, Gatam and Kenaz. Esau's son Eliphaz also had a concubine named Timna, who bore him Amalek.

***Genesis 25:21-23** Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife, because she was barren; and the Lord granted his plea, and Rebekah his wife conceived. But the children struggled together within her; and she said, If all is well, why am I like this? So she went to inquire of the Lord. And the Lord said to her: Two nations are in your womb, Two peoples shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger.

***Genesis 36:22** Additionally, Timna, a concubine of Esau's son Eliphaz, gave birth to Amalek. These are the grandsons of Esau's wife Adah.

***Genesis 36:2** Esau took his wives from the daughters of Canaan: Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite;

***Exodus 17:8-9** After this the Amalekites came and attacked the Israelites at Rephidim. So Moses said to Joshua, Choose some of our men and go out to fight the Amalekites. Tomorrow I will stand on the hilltop with the staff of God in my hand.

***Deuteronomy 25:17-18** Remember what Amalek did to you on the way as you were coming out of Egypt, how he met you on the way and attacked your rear ranks, all the stragglers at your rear, when you were tired and weary; and he did not fear God.

***Deuteronomy 25:19** Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from your enemies all around, in the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance, that you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. You shall not forget.

***Numbers 24:20** Then Balaam saw Amalek and lifted up an oracle, saying: Amalek was first among the nations, but his end is destruction.

***Deuteronomy 25:18c** (Amalek) did not fear God...

***Matthew 14:23** And when He had sent the multitudes away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray. Now when evening came, He was alone there.

***John 8:26** I have much to say about you and much to judge. But the One who sent Me is truthful, and what I have heard from Him, I tell the world.

***John 16:13-15** However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

***Philippians 1:19** For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Yeshua the Messiah.

***Psalm 46:1-2** God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.

***Matthew 9:25-38** Yeshua traveled through all the towns and villages of that area, teaching in the synagogues and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom. And he healed every kind of disease and illness.

***Psalm 27:1** The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

***Isaiah 54a:1-2** Sing, O barren, You who have not borne! Break forth into singing, and cry aloud, You who have not labored with child! For more are the children of the desolate Than the children of the married woman, says the Lord. Enlarge the place of your tent, And let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords, And strengthen your stakes.

***Isaiah 54:7-8** For a mere moment I have forsaken you, But with great mercies I will gather you. With a little wrath I hid My face from you for a moment; But with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you, Says the Lord, your Redeemer.

***Isaiah 54:9-10** For this is like the waters of Noah to Me; For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah would no longer cover the earth, So have I sworn That I would not be angry with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed, Says the Lord, who has mercy on you.

***Matthew 24:37-39** But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

***Matthew 24:32-34a** Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near--at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.

***Matthew 24:29-30** Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the heaven, and all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

***Isaiah 49:18-20** Lift up your eyes, look around and see; All these gather together and come to you. As I live, says the Lord, You shall surely clothe yourselves with them all as an ornament, And bind them on you as a bride does. For your waste and desolate places, And the land of your destruction, Will even now be too small for the inhabitants; And those who swallowed you up will be far away. The children you will have, after you have lost the others, Will say again in your ears, The place is too small for me; Give me a place where I may dwell.

***Isaiah 49:22-23a** Thus says the Lord God: Behold, I will lift My hand in an oath to the nations, and set up My standard for the peoples; They shall bring your sons in their arms, And your daughters shall be carried on their shoulders; Kings shall be your foster fathers, And their queens your nursing mothers;
