

Congregatíon Notes Sukkot - Feast of Ingatheríng SUKKOT AND THE WAR OF GOG AND MAGOG October 19, 2024; Tíshríe 55785 Exodus 33:12-34:25; Ezekíel 38:18-39:16; Zecharíah 14;1-21; John 7:31-43

*Leviticus 23:34 Speak to the children of Israel, saying: The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days to the Lord.

*Leviticus 23:36 For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. <u>On the</u> <u>eighth day you shall have a holy convocation</u>, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it.

*Genesis 3:1a Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made.....

*Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed;

*Revelation 12:9 And the great <u>dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is</u> <u>called the devil and Satan</u>, the <u>deceiver of the whole world</u> — he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

*Ezekiel 28:12-16 Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, and say to him, Thus says the Lord God: You were the seal of perfection, Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty. <u>You were in Eden, the garden of God</u>; <u>Every precious stone was your covering</u>: The sardius, topaz, and diamond,

beryl, onyx, and jasper, Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes was prepared for you on the day you were created. <u>You were the</u> <u>anointed cherub who covers</u>; I established you; <u>you were on the holy mountain of God</u>; you walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, till iniquity was found in you. By the abundance of your trading <u>within</u>, and you sinned; therefore, I cast you as a profane thing out of the mountain of God; and I destroyed you, O covering cherub, from the midst of the fiery stones.

*Ezekiel 38:7 <u>Be ready</u>, prepare yourselves, you and all the battalions mustered about you, and <u>hold yourself in reserve for them</u>.

*Judges 16:21-27, 30a Then the Philistines took him (SAMSON) and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza. They bound him with bronze fetters, and he became a grinder in the

prison. However, the hair of his head began to grow again. Now the lords of the Philistines gathered together to offer a great sacrifice to <u>Dagon their god</u>, and to rejoice. And they said: Our god has delivered into our hands

Samson our enemy! When the people saw him, they praised their god; for they said:

Our god (DAGON) has delivered into our hands our enemy,

The destroyer of our land, and the one who multiplied our dead.

So it happened, when their hearts were merry, that they said, Call for Samson, that he may perform for us. So they called for Samson from the prison, and he performed for them. And they stationed him between the pillars. Then Samson said to the lad who held him by the hand, Let me feel the pillars which support the temple, so that I can lean on them. Now the temple was full of men and women. <u>All the lords of the Philistines were there—about three</u> thousand men and women on the roof watching while Samson performed......

Let me die with the Philistines! And he pushed with all his might, and the temple fell on the lords and all the people who were in it. So the dead that he killed at his death were more than he had killed in his life.

*Genesis 28:10-12 Now Jacob went out from Beersheba and went toward Haran. So he came to a certain place and stayed there all night, because the sun had set. And he took one of the stones of that place and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place to sleep. Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.

*Matthew 6:9b-10 Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

*Genesis 28:13-17 And behold, the LORD stood above it and said: I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants. Also, your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed. Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go and <u>will bring you back to this land</u>; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you. Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, <u>Surely the LORD is in this place</u>, <u>and I did not know it</u>. And he was afraid and said, How awesome is this place! <u>This is none</u> <u>other than the house of God</u>, <u>and this is the gate of heaven</u>!

***John 10:1-3** Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. But he who enters by the door is the sheepherd of the sheep.

***John 14:6** I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the father except through Me.

***Isaiah 53:4** Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken smitten by God, and afflicted .

*John 11:35 Jesus wept.

*Luke 19:41 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it,

*Hebrews 5:7-9 who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,

*Ezekiel 38:7-8 Prepare yourself and be ready, you and all your companies that are gathered about you; and <u>be a guard for them</u>. After many days you will be visited. <u>In the latter years</u> you will come into the land of those brought back from the sword and gathered from <u>many people on the mountains of Israel</u>, which had long been desolate; <u>they were brought</u> out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely.

*Ezekiel 38:1-4 Now the word of the Lord came to me, saying, "Son of man, <u>set your face</u> <u>against Gog</u>, <u>of the land of Magog</u>, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal, and prophesy against him, and say, Thus <u>says the Lord God</u>: Behold, I am against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal. <u>I will turn you around, put hooks into your jaws, and lead you</u> <u>out</u>, with all your army, horses, and horsemen, all splendidly clothed, a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords.

*Ezekiel 38:5-6 <u>Persia, Ethiopia and Libya</u> are with them, all of them with shield and helmet. Gomer and all its troops; the house of <u>Togarmah</u> from the far north and all its troops; many people are with you.

*Ezekiel 38:18-21 And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel, says the Lord God, that <u>My fury will show in My face</u>. For <u>in My jealousy and in</u> <u>the fire of My wrath I have spoken</u>: Surely <u>in that day there shall be a great earthquake</u> in the land of Israel, so that the fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and <u>all men who are on the face of the</u> <u>earth shall shake at My presence</u>. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground. <u>I will call for a sword against Gog</u> <u>throughout all My mountains, says the Lord God</u>. Every man's sword will be against his brother.

*Revelation 6:12 I looked when <u>He opened the sixth seal</u>, and behold, <u>there was a great</u> <u>earthquake</u>, and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood.

*Revelation 7:2-4 Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea, saying, Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads. And I heard <u>the number of those who were</u> <u>sealed</u>. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed:

*Revelation 7:9-10 After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, <u>with palm branches in their hands</u> and crying out with a loud voice, saying, Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!

*Job 8:21 He will yet fill your mouth with laughter, and your lips with teruah.

***Psalms 89:15** Blessed [is] the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance

*Isaiah 11:10-11,12a And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, Who shall stand as a banner to the people; for the Gentiles shall seek Him, and His resting place shall be glorious. It shall come to pass in that day that the Lord shall set His hand again the <u>second</u> time to recover the remnant of His people who are left,.........<u>He will set up a banner for</u> the nations, and will <u>assemble rest (HE WILL GATHER THEM IN)</u> the outcasts of Israel, and <u>gather together</u> the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

*Amos 1:10 But I will send a fire upon the wall of Tyre, which shall devour its palaces.

*Zechariah 14:1-4 Behold, the day of the Lord is coming, and your spoil will be divided in your midst. For I will gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem; the city shall be taken, the houses []]rifled, and the women ravished. Half of the city shall go into captivity, but the remnant of the people shall not be cut off from the city. Then the Lord will go forth and fight against those nations, as He fights in the day of battle. <u>And in that day His feet will stand on the</u> <u>Mount of Olives</u>, which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west, making a very large valley; half of the mountain shall move toward the north and half of it toward the south.

I Thessalonians 5:1-4 But concerning the <u>times and the seasons</u>, brethren, you have no need that I should write to you. For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. ³ For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.
