

## Congregation Notes Beshalach Israel Left Egypt; We Need to Leave the System of the World! February 8, 2025; Shevat 10, 2025 Exodus 13:17-17:16; Judges 4:4 -5:31; Matthew 14:22-33

- \*Exodus 12:31 He summoned Moshe and Aharon by night and said, <u>Up and leave my people</u>, both you and the people of Isra'el; and <u>go</u>, <u>serve ADONAI</u> as you said.
- \*Exodus 13:17 Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that <u>God did not</u> <u>lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near</u>; for God said, Lest perhaps the people change their minds when they see war, and return to Egypt.
- \*Ephesians 4:22 You were taught, with regard to your <u>former way of life</u>, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires;
- \*Luke 9:62 Yeshua said to him, No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God.
- \*Romans 6:6 We know that our old self was put to death on the execution-stake with him, so that the entire body of our sinful propensities might be destroyed, and we might no longer be enslaved to sin.
- \*Jeremiah 6:16 Thus says the Lord: Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk in it.
- \*Exodus 13:17 Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that <u>God did not</u> <u>lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near</u>; for God said, Lest perhaps the <u>people change their minds when they see war, and return to Egypt</u>.
- \*I Chronicles 7:21-24 Zabad his son, Shuthelah his son, and <u>Ezer and Elead</u>. The men of Gath who were born in that land killed them because they came down to take away their cattle. Then Ephraim their father mourned many days, and his brethren came to comfort him. And when he went in to his wife, she conceived and bore a son; and he called his name <u>Beriah</u>, because tragedy had come upon his house. Now his daughter was Sheerah, who built Lower and Upper Beth Horon and Uzzen Sheerah;

- \*Exodus 13:18 So God let the people around by way of the wilderness of the Sea of Reeds and in orderly ranks;
- the sons of Israel went up out of the land of Egypt.
- \*Romans 8:7 The <u>carnal mind</u> (the <u>natural mind</u>) is enmity (meaning there is <u>hostility</u>) against God....
- \*Romans 12:2 We are transformed by the renewing of your mind.
- \*Colossians 1:21 (says before) prior to your salvation, you were alienated and enemies <u>in</u> your mind by wicked works.....
- \*Colossians 3:16 Let the Word of Messiah dwell in you richly...
- \*2 Corinthians 4:4 The god of this world has <u>blinded the minds</u> of them which do not believe.....
- \*1 Peter 1:13-14 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind....
- \*Ephesians 6:12 For our struggle is <u>not against flesh and blood</u>, but against the <u>rulers</u>, against the <u>powers of this world's darkness</u>, and against the <u>spiritual</u> forces of evil in the heavenly realms.
- \*Ephesians 6:14 Stand firm then, with the belt of <u>truth buckled around your waist</u>, with the breastplate of righteousness arrayed,...
- \*John 14:6 Yeshua answered, I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.
- \*Exodus 13:19 Moses took the bones of Joseph with him for he had excated a firm oath from the Children of Israel saying, God will surely remember you, and you shall bring up my bones from here with you.
- \*Proverbs 10:8 The wise in heart will receive commands, but a prating fool will fall.
- \*Exodus 4:22-23a Then you shall say to Pharaoh, Thus says the LORD: Israel is My son, My firstborn. So I say to you, let My son go that he may serve Me.
- \*Psalm 35:10 All my bones shall say, LORD, who is like You, Delivering the poor from him who is too strong for him, Yes, the poor and the needy from him who plunders him?
- \*Ezekiel 37:1-5 The hand of the LORD came upon me and brought me out in the <u>Spirit of</u> the <u>LORD</u>, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it was <u>full of bones</u>. Then He

- caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, there were very many in the open valley; and indeed they were very dry. And He said to me, Son of man, can these bones live?
- So I answered, O LORD God, You know. Again He said to me, <u>Prophesy to these bones</u>, and say to them, <u>O dry bones</u>, hear the word of the <u>LORD!</u> Thus says the LORD God to these bones: Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live.
- \*Exodus 13:20 So they took their journey from Succoth and camped in Etham at the edge of the wilderness.
- \*Exodus 13:17-18 Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for God said, Lest perhaps the people change their minds when they see war, and return to Egypt. So God led the people around by way of the wilderness of the Red Sea. And the children of Israel went up in orderly ranks out of the land of Egypt.
- \*Galatians 5:1 It is for freedom that Messiah has set us free. <u>Stand firm</u> and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery....
- \*John 8:36 So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.
- \*Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Messiah Yeshua from the law of sin and death..
- \*Galatians 5:13-14 You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."
- \*Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night.
- \*Isaiah 41:10 Fear not, for <u>I am with you</u>; Be not dismayed, for <u>I am your God</u>. <u>I will strengthen you</u>, Yes, <u>I will help you</u>, <u>I will uphold you</u> with My righteous right hand.
- \*1 Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own.
- \*Exodus 14:1-4 Now the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: Speak to the children of Israel, that they turn and camp before Pi Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, opposite Baal Zephon; you shall camp before it by the sea. For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, They are bewildered by the land; the wilderness has closed them in. Then I will harden Pharaoh's heart, so that he will pursue them; and I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army,

that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD. And they did so. Now it was told the king of Egypt that the people had fled, and the <u>heart of Pharaoh and his servants</u> was turned against the people; and they said, Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us?

- \*Exodus 14:6-7 So he made ready his chariot and took his people with him. Also, he took <u>six</u> <u>hundred choice chariots</u>, and <u>all the chariots of Egypt</u> with captains over every one of them.
- \*Exodus 14:9-12 So the <u>Egyptians pursued them</u>, all the <u>horses</u> and <u>chariots</u> of Pharaoh, his horsemen and his <u>army</u>, and <u>overtook them camping by the sea</u> beside <u>Pi Hahiroth</u>, before <u>Baal Zephon</u>. And when Pharaoh drew near, the <u>children of Israel lifted their eyes</u>, <u>and behold</u>, the <u>Egyptians marched after them</u>. So <u>they were very afraid</u>, and the children of Israel cried out to the Lord
- \*Proverbs 12:4a A woman of valour is her husband's crown.
- \*Ruth 3:11b (where Boaz says of Ruth, All the people of my town know that you are a <u>woman</u> of valour סלים
- \*Matthew 14:27 Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.
- \*Matthew 14:30 Lord, save me.
- \*Exodus 14:11b .....that you took us to die in the wilderness! What is this that you have done to us to take us out of Egypt?
- \*Exodus 14:12 Is this not the very thing we told you in Egypt, saying, Let us be, and we will serve the Egyptians, for it is better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness?
- \*Revelation 22:17a The Spirit and the Bride say, Come!
- \*Exodus 14:13a Do not fear! Stand firm and see the salvation of the LORD.....
- \*Exodus 14:15 The LORD said to Moses, Why do you cry out to Me? Speak to the Children of Israel and tell them go forward.
- \*Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- \*Exodus 14:16 But <u>lift up your rod</u>, <u>and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it</u>.

  And the children of Israel <u>shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea</u>.

- \*Exodus 14:19-20 And the <u>Angel of God</u>, who went before the camp of Israel, <u>moved and</u> <u>went behind them</u>; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. So <u>it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel. Thus it was a cloud and <u>darkness to the one</u>, and it gave light by night to the other, so that the one did not come near the other all that night.</u>
- \*John 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.
- \*Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. <u>Live as children</u> of light.
- \*I John 2:15 <u>Do not love the world or the things in the world</u>. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- \*2 Corinthians 11:2 <u>I am jealous for you</u> with a godly jealousy. I promised you to one husband, to Messiah, so that I might <u>present you as a pure virgin to him</u>.
