Get Ready! The Judge of All the Earth is Coming Soon!

Feb. 22, 2025; Shevat 24, 5785

Exodus 24:1-24:18; Jeremiah 34:8-22; 33:25-26; Matthew 26:20-30

***Matthew 25:40** And the King will answer them, Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to Me.

***Matthew 25:31-46** When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on his right, Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave Me food, I was thirsty and you gave Me drink, I was a stranger and you and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.

***I John 3:17** But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him?

***I John 4:8** Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

***Psalm 82** God stands up to open heaven's court. He pronounces judgment on the judges. How long will you judges refuse to listen to the evidence? How long will you shower special favors on the wicked? Give fair judgment to the poor man, the afflicted, the fatherless, the destitute. Rescue the poor and helpless from the grasp of evil men. But you are so foolish and so ignorant! Because you are in darkness, all the foundations of society are shaken to the core. I have called you all "gods" and "sons of the Most High." But in death you are mere men. You will fall as any prince—for all must die.

Stand up, O God, and judge the earth. For all of it belongs to you. All nations are in your hands.

***Psalm 96:12-13** Let the fields exult, and all that is in them. Then all the trees of the forest will sing for joy. Let all creation rejoice before the LORD, for He comes, He

comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world in righteousness and the peoples in his faithfulness.

***Revelation 19:11** Then I saw heaven standing open, and there before me was a white horse. And its rider is called Faithful and True, with righteousness He judges and wages war.

***Genesis 3:14-15** So the LORD God said to the serpent: Because you have done this, cursed are you above all livestock and every beast of the field! On your belly will you go, and dust you will eat, all the days of your life. And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed. He will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.

***Revelation 12:17** And the dragon was enraged at the woman –and went to make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Yeshua. And the dragon stood on the shore of the sea.

***Romans 12:2** Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

***Ephesians 2:10** For we are his workmanship, created in Messiah Yeshua for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

***Titus 2:14** Who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for Himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

***James 1:22** But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

***Matthew 4:23** Yeshua went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people.

***James 5:9** Do not complain, brethren, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.

***2 Timothy 4:8**in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.

***Luke 2:15-6** Then, as some spoke of the temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and donations, He said, "These things which you see—the days will come in which not one stone shall be left upon another that shall not be thrown down."

***Exodus 21:1-2** These are the rulings (Mishpatim) you are to present to them: If you purchase a Hebrew slave, he is to work six years; but in the seventh, he is to be given his freedom without having to pay anything.

***Exodus 21:3-6** If he (the slave) came single, he is to leave single; if he was married when he came, his wife is to go with him when he leaves. But if his master gave him a wife, and she bore him sons or daughters, then the wife and her children will belong to her master, and he will leave by himself. Nevertheless, if the slave declares, 'I love my master, my wife and my children, so I don't want to go free,' then his master is to bring him before God; and there at the door or doorpost, his master is to pierce his ear with an awl; and the man will be his slave for life.

***Luke 4:24** Then He added, Truly I tell you, no prophet is accepted in his hometown.

***Luke 9:58** And Jesus said to him, "The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air nests; but the Son of Man has nowhere He might lay the head."

***2 Corinthians 8:9** For you know the grace of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.

***Revelation 22:12** Look, I am coming soon! **My reward is with Me**, and I will give to each person according to what they have done.

***Matthew 25:14-30** For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property. To one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away. He who had received the five talents went at once and traded with them, and he made five talents more. So also, he who had the two talents made two talents more. But he who had received the one talent went and dug in the ground and hid his master's money. Now after a long time the master of those servants came and settled accounts with them. And he who had received the five talents came forward, bringing five talents more, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me five talents; here, **I have made five talents more.**' His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant, you have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.' And he also who had the two talents came forward, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me two talents; here, I have made two talents more.' His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.' He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you scattered no seed, so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here, you have what is yours.' But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed? Then you ought to have

invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should have received what was my own with interest. So take the talent from him and give it to him who has the ten talents. For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have an abundance. But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away. And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

***Jeremiah 34:8-10** The word came to Jeremiah from the Lord after King Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the people in Jerusalem to proclaim freedom for the slaves. Everyone was to free their Hebrew slaves, both male and female; no one was to hold a fellow Hebrew in bondage. So all the officials and people who entered into this covenant agreed that they would free their male and female slaves and no longer hold them in bondage. They agreed, and set them free.

***Jeremiah 38:11** But afterward they changed their minds and made the male and female slaves return, whom they had set free, and brought them into subjection as male and female slaves.

***Jeremiah 34:14** At the end of seven years every one of you is to set free his Hebrew brother who has been sold to you and has served you six years. You are to let him go free from you. But your ancestors did not listen to Me or pay any attention.

***Jeremiah 34:17** Therefore here is what *Adonai* says: "You did not heed Me and proclaim freedom, each to his brother and each to his neighbor; so now I proclaim for you a freedom," says *Adonai*, 'for sword, plague and famine. I will make you an object of horror to all the kingdoms on earth.

***Jeremiah 34:20** I will hand them over to their enemies, hand them over to those who seek their lives; and their corpses will become food for birds in the air and wild animals.

***Revelation 19:17-18** And I saw one angel standing in the sun, and he cried-out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds flying in mid-heaven, "Come, be gathered-together for the great banquet of God, in order that you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of commanders, and the flesh of powerful ones, and the flesh of horses and of the ones sitting on them, and the flesh of everyone— both free and slaves, both small and great".

***2 Peter 3:8** But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day.

***Romans 12:11** Do not lag in zeal (hitla'avut); be fervent in spirit. Keep serving the Lord.

***Matthew 24:34** Then the King will say to those on his right, Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.
