

Congregation Notes VaYakel March 22, 2025; Adar 22, 2025 Exodus 35:1-38::20; Ezekiel 36:16-38; John 11:47-56

- *I Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,
- *Romans 12:1 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.
- *Hebrews 10:25 Not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
- *Exodus 31:1-2 Then <u>Moses assembled all the congregation</u> of the children of Israel together, and said to them, These are the words which the Lord has commanded you to do: <u>Work shall be done for six days</u>, but the seventh day shall be a holy day for you, a <u>Sabbath of rest to the LORD</u>. Whoever does any work on it shall be put to death.
- *Exodus 32:7-10 And the LORD said to Moses, "Go, get down! For your people whom you brought out of the land of Egypt have corrupted themselves. They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them. They have made themselves a molded calf, and worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, This is your god. O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt! And the Lord said to Moses, I have seen this people, and indeed it is a stiff-necked people! Now therefore, let Me alone, that My wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them. And I will make of you a great nation.
- *Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because <u>anyone who</u> <u>comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.</u>

- *Exodus 32:19 So it was, as soon as he came near the camp, that he saw the calf and the dancing. So <u>Moses' anger became hot</u>, and he cast the tablets out of his hands and <u>broke them at the foot of the mountain</u>.
- *Luke 22:19 then <u>He took bread</u>, and having given thanks, <u>He broke it</u>, and gave it to them, saying, <u>this represents my body</u> which is given for you: do this in remembrance of me.
- *Isaiah 53:5 <u>But He was pierced</u> for our transgressions, He was <u>crushed for our iniquities</u>; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and <u>by His stripes</u> we are healed.
- *Exodus 32:20 Then he took the calf which they had made, burned it in the fire, and ground it to powder; and he scattered it on the water and made the children of Israel drink it.
- *Exodus 32:21-24 And Moses said to Aaron, "What did this people do to you that <u>you</u> <u>have brought so great a sin upon them?</u> So Aaron said, Do not let the anger of my lord become hot. <u>You know the people</u>, that <u>they are set on evil</u>. For they said to me, Make us gods that shall go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him. And I said to them, Whoever has any gold, let them break it off. <u>So they gave it to me</u>, and I cast it into the fire, and this calf came out.
- *James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, I am being tempted by God, for <u>God</u> <u>cannot be tempted with evil, and He Himself tempts no one</u>.
- *Exodus 31:12-14 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak also to the children of Israel, saying: Surely My Sabbaths you shall keep, for it is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am the Lord who sanctifies you. You shall keep the Sabbath, therefore, for it is holy to you. Everyone who profanes it shall surely be put to death; for whoever does any work on it, that person shall be cut off from among his people.
- *Hebrews 4:9-10 There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. For whoever enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God did from His....
- *Isaiah 58:13 If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the Lord honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; Then you

- shall delight yourself in the LORD; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the LORD has spoken.
- *Exodus 35:1-2 Then Moses gathered all the congregation of the children of Israel together, and said to them, These are the words which the LORD has commanded you to do: Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh day shall be a holy day for you, a Sabbath of rest to the LORD.
- *Acts 7:6-7 But God spoke in this way: that his descendants would dwell in a foreign land, and that they would bring them into bondage and oppress them four hundred years. And the nation to whom they will be in bondage I will judge, said God, and after that they shall come out and serve Me in this place.
- *Luke 10:40-42 But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to Him (Yeshua) and asked, Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!" "Martha, Martha, the Lord answered, You are worried and upset about many things, But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her.
- *Ephesians 3:10 ... to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places,
- *Ephesians 3:6 ...that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body and partakers of His promise in Messiah through the gospel.
- *Isaiah 46:10 I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say, My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.
- *Jeremiah 49:7 Against Edom. Thus says the LORD of hosts; Is wisdom no more in Teman? Has counsel perished from the prudent? Has their wisdom vanished?
- *Jeremiah 49:10 But I have made Esau bare; <u>I have uncovered his secret places</u>, and he shall not be able to hide himself <u>His descendants are plundered</u>, <u>his brethren and his neighbors</u>, and <u>he is no more</u>.
- *Isaiah 63:1-2 Who is this who comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah, This One who is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength? I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

 Why is Your apparel red, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress?

- *Micah 2:12 I will surely assemble, O Jacob, all of thee; I will surely gather the remnant of Israel; I will put them together as the sheep of Bozrah, as the flock in the midst of their fold: they shall make great noise by reason of the multitude of men.
- *Revelation 12:6 Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days.
- *Jeremiah 49:20-23 Therefore, hear the counsel of the LORD that He has taken against Edom, and His purposes that he has proposed against the inhabitants of Teman: The earth shakes at the noise of their fall; At the cry its noise is heard at the Red Sea. Behold, He shall come up and fly like the eagle, and spread His wings over Bozrah; the heart of the mighty men of Edom in that day shall be like the heart of a woman in birth pangs.
- *Jeremiah 49:14-18 I have heard <u>a message from the LORD</u>, and an ambassador has been sent to the nations: Gather together, come against her, and rise up to battle! For indeed, <u>I will make you small among nations</u>.

Despised among men. Your fierceness has deceived you,

The pride of your heart, O you who dwell in the clefts of the rock, Who hold the height of the hill!

Though you make your nest as high as the eagle.

<u>I will bring you down from there</u>, <u>I will bring you down from there says the Lord.</u>
<u>Edom also shall be an astonishment</u>; Everyone who goes by it will be astonished and will hiss at all its plagues. As in the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah, and their neighbors, says the Lord, No one shall remain there, nor shall a son of man dwell in it.
