

## Congregation Notes Pekudei Prophecies Unfolding in the Tabernacle 29 March, 2025; 29 Adar 5785 Exodus 18:21-40:38; Ezekiel 45:16-46:18; Luke 22:1-13

- \*Romans 12:6-8 Having <u>gifts that differ</u> according to the grace given to us, <u>let us use</u> <u>them</u>: if <u>prophecy</u>, in proportion to our faith; if service, <u>in our serving</u>; the one who <u>teaches</u>, in his teaching; the one who <u>exhorts</u>, in his exhortation; the one who <u>contributes</u>, in generosity; the one who <u>leads</u>, with zeal; the one who does <u>acts of mercy</u>, with cheerfulness.
- \*I Peter 4:2 So as to live for the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for human passions but for the will of God.
- \*Exodus 25:8 Let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.
- \*Exodus 40:18 So <u>Moses raised up the tabernacle</u>, fastened its <u>sockets</u>, set up its <u>beams</u>, put in its bars, and raised up its <u>pillars</u>.
- \*Revelation 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, Behold, the <u>dwelling</u> <u>place of God is with man</u>. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and <u>God</u> <u>himself will be with them as their God</u>.
- \*Hebrews 11:1-3 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the <u>evidence of</u>
  <u>things not seen</u>. For by it the <u>elders obtained a good testimony</u>. By faith we understand
  that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the <u>things which are seen were</u>
  not made of things which are visible.
- \*Exodus 40:1 <u>HaShem spoke to Moses</u>, saying: On the day of the new moon of the first month on the first of the month, <u>you shall erect the Tabernacle</u>, the Tent of Meeting.
- \*Deuteronomy 18:18 I will raise up for them <u>a Prophet like you from among their</u> <u>brethren</u>, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him

- \*John 2:18-19 On account of this, the Jews demanded, What sign can You show us to prove Your authority to do these things? Yeshua answered and said to them, Destroy this temple, and in three days <u>I will raise it up</u>.
- \*Exodus 40:16 Moses did according to everything that HaShem commanded to him, so he did do.
- \*John 14:30-31 I will not speak with you much longer, for the prince of this world is coming, and he has no claim on Me. But I do exactly what the Father has commanded Me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. Get up! Let us go on from here.
- \*John 14:15 If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.
- \*Exodus 40:18 And Moses erected the tabernacle, and laid its sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up its pillars.
- \*Revelation 22:1-3 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve Him.
- \*Ephesians 6:10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might.
- \*2 Corinthians 11:23-28 Are they ministers of Messiah?—I speak as a fool—
  I am more: in <u>labors</u> more abundant, in <u>stripes</u> above measure, in <u>prisons</u> more frequently, in <u>deaths</u> often. <sup>24</sup> From the Jews <u>five times I received forty stripes minus one</u>. <sup>25</sup> Three times I was beaten with rods; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been <u>in the deep</u>; <sup>26</sup> in <u>journeys often</u>, in <u>perils of waters</u>, in <u>perils of robbers</u>, in <u>perils of my own countrymen</u>, in <u>perils of the Gentiles</u>, in <u>perils in the city</u>, in <u>perils in the wilderness</u>, in perils <u>in the sea</u>, in perils <u>among false brethren</u>; <sup>27</sup> in <u>weariness and toil</u>, in <u>sleeplessness</u> often, in <u>hunger and thirst</u>, in <u>fastings</u> often, <u>in cold and nakedness</u>— <sup>28</sup> <u>besides the other things</u>, what comes upon me daily: my deep concern for all the churches.
- \*I Peter 1:7 so that the proven character of your faith—more precious than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- \*Job 23:10 Yet He knows the way I have taken; when He has tested me, <u>I will come</u> forth as gold.

- \*I Kings 7:21 Thus he <u>set up the pillars</u> at the porch of the nave; and he set up the right pillar and named it **Jachin**, and he set up the left pillar and named it **Boaz**.
- \*Genesis 35:14-15 <u>Jacob set up a pillar in the place where He had spoken with Him, a pillar of stone</u>, and he poured out a drink offering on it; he also poured oil on it. So Jacob named the place where God had spoken with him, Bethel.
- \*Galatians 2:9 <u>James, Cephas and John, those esteemed as pillars</u>, gave me and Barnabas the right hand of fellowship when they recognized the grace given to me. They agreed that we should go to the Gentiles, and they to the circumcised.
- \*Isaiah 60:1 Arise, (IS THE WORD KUMI) shine; for your light has come, And the glory of the Lord has risen upon you.
- \*Mark 9:35 Sitting down, Yeshua called the Twelve and said, "If anyone wants to be first, he must be the last of all and the servant of all."
- \*Proverbs 4:18 "The path of the righteous is like the morning sun, shining ever brighter till the full light of day."
- \*John 8:12 Again Yeshua spoke to them, saying, <u>I am the light of the world</u> Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.
- \*Isaiah 49:6 He says: "It is too light a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back the preserved of Israel; I will make you as a light for the nations, that My salvation may reach to the end of the earth."
- \*Revelation 3:12a He who overcomes, <u>I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God</u>, and he shall go out no more.
- \*Exodus 40:33c.....and Moses completed the work:
- \*Exodus 40:34 Then the <u>cloud covered the tabernacle</u> of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.
- \*Exodus 14:19 And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them.
- \*Exodus 40:34-35 Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. <sup>35</sup> And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.

- \*Exodus 19:9a And the LORD said to Moses, Behold, I come to you in the thick cloud.....
- \*Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, <u>yet without sin</u>.
- \*Exodus 24:17 The sight of the glory of the Lord was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.
- \*Romans 8:11 If (meaning THOUGH) the <u>Spirit of him who raised Yeshua from the</u> <u>dead dwells in you</u>, He who raised Messiah Yeshua from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies <u>through His Spirit who dwells in you</u>.
- \*Mark 16:17-18 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; / they will pick up snakes with their hands, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not harm them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will be made well.
- \*Isaiah 53:4-6 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

\*I John 5:20 And we know that the <u>Son of God has come and has given us</u> <u>understanding, so that we may know Him who is true</u>; and <u>we are in Him who is true</u>, <u>in</u> His Son Yeshua the Messiah. He is the true God and eternal life.
