**\*Joshua 23:7**so that you will not associate with these nations, these which remain with you, or mention the name of their gods, or make *anyone* swear by *them*, or serve them, or bow down to them.

\*Judges 2:12-13 Thus they forsook the LORD, the God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt, and <u>they followed various gods of the peoples</u> <u>around them</u>. They bowed down to them and provoked the LORD to anger, /for <u>they</u> <u>forsook Him and served Baal and the Ashtoreths</u>.

\*Psalm 1:1a-3,4 <u>Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked</u>... But <u>his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and nigh</u>t. He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

\*Luke 9:35 And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "<u>This is My beloved Son. Hear</u> <u>Him</u>!"

\*Numbers 1:2 Take a head count of the entire assembly of the Children of Israel according to their families according to the household of their fathers by the number of the names of every male according to their head count.

\*Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Messiah. It is no longer I who live, but Messiah who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh <u>I live by faith in the Son of</u> <u>God, who loved me and gave Himself for me</u>.

\*Jeremiah 31:3 The LORD appeared to him from far away. I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore, I have continued my faithfulness to you.

\*John 14:15 If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

\*Colossians 3:14 And above all these <u>put on love</u>, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.

\*Jeremiah 2:1-2 Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Go and cry in the hearing of Jerusalem, saying, 'Thus says the LORD: I remember you, the kindness of your youth,

the love of your betrothal, <u>when you went after Me in the wilderness</u>, in a land not <u>sown</u>.

\*Exodus 24:7 Then [Moses] took the Book of the Covenant and read it to the people. <u>They</u> responded, We will do and hear [na'aseh ve-nishma] everything the Lord has said.

\*Numbers 2:1-2 And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: Everyone of the children of Israel <u>shall camp by his own standard</u>, beside <u>the emblems of his father's</u> <u>house</u>; they shall camp some distance from the tabernacle of meeting.

\*Exodus 19:2 For they had departed from Rephidim, had come to the Wilderness of Sinai, and camped in the wilderness. So <u>Israel camped</u> there before the mountain.

\*James 3:16 For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice.

\*Proverbs 27:4 Wrath is cruel, anger is overwhelming, but who can stand before jealousy?

\*Numbers 2:1-2 And the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: Everyone of the children of Israel shall camp <u>by his own standard, beside the emblems of his father's house</u>; they shall camp some distance from the tabernacle of meeting.

**\*I Corinthians 12:14-20** For the body does not consist of one part, but of many. If the foot should say, Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body, that would not make it any less a part of the body. And if the ear should say, Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body, that would not make it any less a part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be?

But in fact, God has arranged the members of the body, every one of them, according to His design. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body.

## \*Psalm 82:1-4,8 A PLEA FOR JUSTICE

God stands in the congregation of the mighty; He judges among the gods. How long will you judge unjustly, and show partiality to the wicked? Selah Defend the poor and fatherless; do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy; free *them* from the hand of the wicked....Arise, O God, judge the earth; for You shall inherit all nations.

\*Matthew 25:32 All the nations will be gathered in His presence, and <u>He will separate</u> the people as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.



\*Psalm 83:1-6a Do not keep silent, O God! Do not hold Your peace, And do not be still, O God! <sup>2</sup> For behold, Your enemies make a tumult; And those who hate You have lifted up their head. <sup>3</sup> They have <u>taken crafty counsel against Your people and consulted</u> together against Your sheltered ones. <sup>4</sup> They have said, <u>Come, and let us cut them off</u> from being a nation. That the name of Israel may be remembered no more. <sup>5</sup> For they have consulted together with one consent; <u>They form a confederacy against You</u>: <sup>6</sup> The

tents of Edom and the Ishmaelites; Moab and the Hagrites;  $\mathbb{Z}$  Gebal, Ammon, and Amalek; Philistia with the inhabitants of Tyre;  $\mathbb{E}$  Assyria also has joined with them;

\*Joel 3:1-3; 9-17a For behold, in those days and at that time, When I bring back the captives of Judah and Jerusalem, <sup>2</sup> I will also gather all nations, And bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; And <u>I will enter into judgment with them there On account</u> of My people, My heritage Israel, Whom they have scattered among the nations; They have also divided up My land.<sup>3</sup> They have cast lots for My people, Have given a boy as payment for a harlot, And sold a girl for wine, that they may drink..... 9) Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare for war!
