Seeing Yeshua in Re'eh and The Role of the Gentiles in the Last Days  
August 23.25; Av 29, 5785  
Deut. 11:26-16:17; 54: Isaiah 11-55:5; John 6:35-51

**\*Deuteronomy 11:26-28** Behold, I set before you today הַיּוֹם (ha yom) a blessing and a curse: the blessing, if you listen the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you today; and the curse, if you do not listen to the commandments of the Lord your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today, to go after other gods which you have not known.

**\*Deuteronomy 12:1-3** These are the statutes and judgments which you shall be careful to observe in the land which the LORD God of your fathers is giving you to possess, all the days that you live on the earth.

2You shall utterly destroy all the places where the nations which you shall dispossess served their gods, on the high mountains and on the hills and under every green tree. 3And you shall destroy their altars, break their sacred pillars, and burn their wooden images with fire; you shall cut down the carved images of their gods and destroy their names from that place. 4You shall not worship the Lord your God with such things.

**\*Ephesians 5:1-6** Therefore, be imitators of God as dear children. And walk in love, as Messiah also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints; neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Messiah and God. <sup>6</sup> Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

**\*Deuteronomy 13:6-10** selections 6) If your brother, ... your son, your daughter, the wife of your bosom or your friend... secretly entices you, .... 7) you shall not consent to him or listen to him.... 9) but you shall surely kill him.... You shall stone him to death for trying to turn you away from the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. **11** Then all Israel will hear and be afraid, and will never again do such a wicked thing among you....

**\*Matthew 5:3** Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

**\*Matthew 5:11-12** Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

**\*Luke 17:20-22** When asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, Yeshua replied, The kingdom of God will not come with observable signs. Nor will people say, Look, here it is, or There it is, For you see the kingdom of G-d is in your midst. Then He said to the disciples, The time is coming when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, but you will not see it....

**\*John 1:29** John the Baptist declares, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

**Matthew 6:10** Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

**\*Matthew 12:28** But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

**\*Luke 10:9** And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you...

**\*John 18:36** Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world; if it were, My servants would fight to prevent My arrest by the Jews. But now My kingdom is not of this realm.

**\*Colossians 1:13** He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of His beloved Son,

**\*Luke 10:19** Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.

**\*Matthew 13:41-43** The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will weed out of His kingdom every cause of sin and all who practice lawlessness. / And they will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. / Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.

**\*Deuteronomy 12:8** You shall not at all do as we are doing here today HA YOM—every man doing whatever is right in his own eyes—<sup>9</sup>For you have not yet come to the resting place and the inheritance that the LORD your God is giving you....

**\*Hebrews 4:1** Therefore, since the promise to enter his rest remains, let us beware that none of you be found to have fallen short.

**\*Hebrews 6:11-12** We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, in order to make your hope sure. / Then you will not be sluggish, but will imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

**\*John 5:-45-47** But do not think I will accuse you before the Father. Your accuser is Moses, on whom your hopes are set. If you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for he wrote about Me. But since you do not believe what he wrote, how are you going to believe what I say?

**\*I Thessalonians 5:2-3** For you are fully aware that the Day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. / While people are saying, "Peace and security," destruction will come upon them suddenly, like labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

**\*Malachi 3:18** Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between those who serve God and those who do not serve Him.

**\*Isaiah 24:20-21** The earth staggers like a drunkard and sways like a shack. Earth's rebellion weighs it down, and it falls, never to rise again. In that day the LORD will punish the host of heaven above and the kings of the earth below.

**\*Revelation 12:7** Then a war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and the dragon and his angels fought back.

**\*Revelation 12:9** And the great dragon was hurled down—that ancient serpent called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him....

**\*Revelation 16:14-15** These are demonic spirits that perform signs and go out to all the kings of the earth, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God the Almighty. / "Behold, I am coming like a thief. Blessed is the one who remains awake and clothed, so that he will not go naked and let his shame be exposed."

**\*Deuteronomy 16:13** You shall observe the Feast of Tabernacles seven days, when you have gathered from your threshing floor and from your winepress

**\*Deuteronomy 16:15-16** Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the Lord your God in the place which the Lord chooses, because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you surely rejoice. Three times a year all your males shall appear before the Lord your God in the place which He chooses: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles; and they shall not appear before the Lord empty-handed.

**\*Deuteronomy 12:5** But you shall seek the place which the LORD your God will choose out of all your tribes to put his name and make his habitation there; thither you shall go.

**\*Amos 9:9** "For surely I will give the command, and I will shake the house of Israel among all the nations as grain is sifted in a sieve; but not a pebble will reach the ground.

**\*Jonah 1:5-6** Then the sailors were afraid; and every man cried out to his god and threw the cargo that was in the ship into the sea, to lighten the load. But Jonah had gone down into the lowest parts of the ship, had lain down, and was fast asleep. So the captain came to him, and said to him, "What do you mean, sleeper? Arise, call on your God; perhaps your God will consider us, so that we may not perish."

**\*Luke 13:35** Look, your house is left to you desolate. And I tell you that you will not see Me again until you say, Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.

**\*Obadiah 1:10-11a** For violence against your brother Jacob, Shame shall cover you, And you shall be cut off forever. In the day that you stood on the other side—In the day that strangers carried captive his forces,

**\*Obadiah 1:18** The house of Jacob shall be a fire, And the house of Joseph a flame; But the house of Esau shall be stubble; They shall kindle them and devour them, And no survivor shall remain of the house of Esau, for the LORD has spoken.

**\*Luke 13:35** Look, your house is left to you desolate. And I tell you that you will not see Me again until you say, Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.
