Exodus 10:1-13:16; Jeremiah 41:13-28; John 19:31-37

**\*Matthew 6:9** Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

**\*Isaiah 45:5** I am the LORD, and there is no other, besides Me there is no God; I equip you, though you do not know Me,...

**\*2 Corinthians 5:17-18** Therefore if anyone is in Messiah, he is a new creation. The old has passed away. Behold, the new has come! **18** All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Messiah and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:...

**\*Jeremiah 36:3** It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the adversities which I purpose to bring upon them, that everyone may turn from his evil way, that I may forgive their iniquity and their sin.

**\*Isaiah 61:10** I greatly rejoice in GOD, My whole being exults in my God—Who has clothed me with garments of triumph, wrapped me in a robe of victory,  
Like a bridegroom adorned with a turban,  
Like a bride bedecked with her finery.

**\*Isaiah 62:5** As a youth espouses a maiden, Your sons shall espouse you; And as a bridegroom rejoices over his bride,  
So will your God rejoice over you.

**\*Jeremiah 2:32** Can a virgin forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? Yet my people have forgotten Me for days without number.

**\*Joel 2:16** Gather the people. Sanctify the assembly. Assemble the elders. Gather the children, and those who nurse from breasts. Let the bridegroom go forth from his room, and the bride out of her room.

**\*Revelation 21:9** One of the seven angels who had the seven bowls, who were loaded with the seven last plagues came, and he spoke with me, saying, "Come here. I will show you the wife, the Lamb's bride."

**\*Revelation 21:2** I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband.

**\*Revelation 22:17** The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" He who hears, let him say, "Come!" He who is thirsty, let him come. He who desires, let him take the water of life freely.

**\*Song of Solomon 5:1** I have come into my garden, my sister, my bride. I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk. Friends Eat, friends! Drink, yes, drink abundantly, beloved. Beloved.

**\*Isaiah 54:5** For your husband is your Maker—the LORD of Hosts is His name—the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer; He is called the God of all the earth.

**\*Daniel 12:3** At that time, He will give us everything, as it says, And those who ponder will shine as brilliance of the sky and those who bring many to righteousness as the stars, forever and ever.

**\*Exodus 13:8** For the sake of this (zeh) HaShem acted on my behalf when I went out of Egypt.

**\*Exodus 13:14** In days to come, when your son asks you, 'What does this mean?' say to him, 'With a mighty hand the LORD brought us out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

**\*Exodus 13:8** On that day tell your son, 'I do this because of what the LORD did for me when I came out of Egypt.

**\*Exodus 12:25-28** <sup>25</sup> It will come to pass when you come to the land which the LORD will give you, just as He promised, that you shall keep this service. <sup>26</sup> And it shall be, when your children say to you, 'What do you mean by this service?' <sup>27</sup> that you shall say, 'It is the Passover sacrifice of the LORD, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt when He struck the Egyptians and delivered our households.' " So the people bowed their

heads and worshiped. <sup>28</sup> Then the children of Israel went away and did so; just as the LORD had commanded Moses and Aaron, so they did.

**\*Deuteronomy 4:9** Only be careful, and watch yourselves closely so that you do not forget the things your eyes have seen or let them fade from your heart as long as you live.  
Teach them to your children and to their children after them.

**\*Exodus 4:22-23** Then you shall say to Pharaoh, Thus says the LORD: Israel is My son, My firstborn. I have told you to let My son go, that he may worship Me. If you refuse to let him go, I will kill your own first born son.

**\*Luke 18:16** But Yeshua called the children to Him and said, Let the little children come to Me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.

**\*Exodus/Shemot 10:1-2** And HaShem said to Moses come בא to Pharaoh, for I have hardened הַכִּבְדִּיתִי his heart and the heart of his servants in order that I can place these My signs in his midst and in order that you may relate in the ears of your son and the son of your son that which I made a mockery of Egypt, and My signs that I placed among them that you may know that I am HaShem.

**\*Matthew 7:12** In everything, then, do to others as you would have them do to you. For this is the essence of the Law and the Prophets.

**\*Exodus 14:4** And I will harden Pharaoh's heart so that he will pursue them. But I will gain honor by means of Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD." So this is what the Israelites did.

**\*Hebrews 3:15** As it has been said: Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden our hearts, as you did in the rebellion. For who were the ones who heard and rebelled? Were they not all those Moses led out of Egypt?...

**\*Exodus 10:21-23** Then the Lord said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand toward the sky so that darkness spreads over Egypt—darkness that can be felt." <sup>22</sup> So Moses stretched out his hand toward the sky, and total darkness covered all Egypt for three days. <sup>23</sup> No one could see anyone else or move about for three days. Yet all the Israelites had light in the places where they lived.

**\*Revelation 16:10-11** Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. **11** They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.

**\*Exodus 11:1-2** <sup>1</sup> And the Lord said to Moses, I will bring yet one more plague on Pharaoh and on Egypt. Afterward he will let you go from here. When he lets you go, he will surely drive

you out of here altogether.<sup>2</sup> Speak now in the hearing of the people, and let every man ask from his neighbor and every woman from her neighbor, articles of silver and articles of gold.

**\*Deuteronomy 15:12-15** If a fellow Hebrew, a man or a woman, is sold to you and serves you six years, then in the seventh year you must set him free. **13** And when you release him, do not send him away empty-handed....

**\*Deuteronomy 23:7** Do not hate an Edomite, for he is your brother. Do not hate an Egyptian, because you were a stranger in his land.

**\*Exodus 12:33-36** And the Egyptians urged the people, that they might send them out of the land in haste. For they said, "We shall all be dead."<sup>34</sup> So the people took their dough before it was leavened, having their kneading bowls bound up in their clothes on their shoulders.<sup>35</sup> Now the children of Israel had done according to the word of Moses, and they had asked from the Egyptians articles of silver, articles of gold, and clothing.<sup>36</sup> And the LORD had given the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they granted them what they requested. Thus they plundered the Egyptians.

**\*Genesis 50:20** You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.

**\*Matthew 5:43-45** You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy. But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your Father in heaven.
