Exodus 13:17-17:16; Judges 4:4-5:31; Matt. 14:22-33

***John 5:46** For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me; for he wrote about Me.

***Exodus 12:13** On that night I will pass through the land of Egypt and strike down every firstborn male, both man and beast, and I will execute judgment against all the gods of Egypt. I am the LORD. 13The blood on the houses where you are staying will distinguish them; when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No plague will fall on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

***Exodus 12:5-6** Your lamb must be an unblemished year-old male,6You must keep it until the fourteenth day of the month, when the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel will slaughter the animals at twilight.

***Genesis 22:8** And Abraham said, "My son, God will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering.

***Leviticus 5:6** And, as a penalty for the sin they have committed, they must bring to the LORD a female lamb or goat from the flock as a sin offering; and the priest shall make atonement for them for their sin.

Isaiah 53:7a He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter,

John 1:29 The next day John saw Yeshua coming toward him and said, Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

***Revelation 7:9a** After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb.

***Revelation 12:11a** They triumphed over him (THE ANTICHRIST) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony;

***Revelation 21:22** I did not see a temple in the city, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.

***Revelation 13:8** All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast - all whose names have not been written in the Lamb's book of life, the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world.

***Exodus 12:23** For the LORD will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.

***Exodus 17:17** Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had sent the people out, that God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for God said, "Lest perhaps the people change their minds when they see war, and return to Egypt.

***James 4:7** Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

***Luke 10:19** Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you.

***Exodus 17:18a** So God led the people around by way of the wilderness of the Red Sea.

***Exodus 10:1-2** Now the Lord said to Moses, "Come in to Pharaoh; for I have hardened his heart and the hearts of his servants, that I may show these signs of Mine before him, ² and that you may tell in the hearing of your son and your son's son the mighty things I have done in Egypt, and My signs which I have done among them, that you may know that I am the LORD."

***John 14:13** You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father.

***John 15:16** You did not choose Me, but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit—fruit that will remain—so that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He will give you.

***Exodus 14:6-9a** "What is this we have done, that we have let Israel go from serving us?" ⁶ So he made ready his chariot and took his army with him, ⁷ six hundred chosen chariots and all the other chariots of Egypt with officers over all of them. ⁸ And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued the people of Israel while the people of Israel were going out defiantly. ⁹ The Egyptians pursued them, all Pharaoh's horses and chariots and his horsemen and his army, and overtook them encamped at the sea,.....

***Exodus 14:10** And when Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians marched after them. So they were very afraid, and the children of Israel cried out to the LORD.

***Exodus 14:13** But Moses told the people, Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the LORD's salvation, which He will accomplish for you today; for the Egyptians you see today, you will never see again.

***Exodus 14:15-18** The LORD said to Moses, Why do you cry to me? Tell the people of Israel to go forward. 16 Lift up your staff, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it, that the people of Israel may go through the sea on dry ground.

***Exodus 14:17-18a** And I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians so that they shall go in after them, and I will get glory over Pharaoh and all his host, his chariots, and his horsemen. 18 And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD,...

***Exodus 14:21-22** Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea into dry land, and the waters were divided. ²² So the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on the dry ground, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand and on their left.

***Exodus 14:26** Then the LORD said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand over the sea, that the waters may come back upon the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen."

***Exodus 14:30-31** Thus the LORD saved Israel that day from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore. 31 Israel saw the great power that the LORD used against the Egyptians, so the people feared the LORD, and they believed in the LORD and in his servant Moses.

***Revelation 20:1-3** Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven with the key to the bottomless pit and a heavy chain in his hand. 2He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years. 3 And he threw him into the Abyss, shut it, and sealed it over him, so that he could not deceive the nations until the thousand years were complete. After that, he must be released for a brief period of time....

***Revelation 20:9-10b** And they marched across the broad expanse of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. But fire came down from heaven and consumed them.....There they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

***Revelation 19:6-7** And I heard a sound like the roar of a great multitude, like the rushing of many waters, and like a mighty rumbling of thunder, crying out: "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give Him the glory. For the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready.

***Exodus 15:2-18 selections** - The LORD is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; He is my God, and I will praise Him; My father's God, and I will exalt Him. ³ The LORD is a man of war; The LORD is His name. AND WE SEE THE LORD -- THE MAN OF WAR -- IN REVELATION....

***Revelation 19:11** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

***Exodus 15:7a** And in the greatness of Your excellence You have overthrown those who rose against You; You sent forth Your wrath;

***Revelation 16:1** Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth."

***Exodus 15:13** You in Your mercy have led forth the people whom You have redeemed; You have guided them in Your strength to Your holy habitation.

***Revelation 21:2-3** Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³ And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them,

***Exodus 15:14** The people will hear and be afraid; Sorrow will take hold of the inhabitants of Philistia. ¹⁵ Then the chiefs of Edom will be dismayed; The mighty men of Moab, Trembling will take hold of them; All the inhabitants of Canaan will melt away. ¹⁶ Fear and dread will fall on them;

***Revelation 6:16-17** (THE GREAT RICH AND MIGHTY MEN) and said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!

***Exodus 15:20-21** Then Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took the timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances. And Miriam answered them: "Sing to the LORD, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea!

***Luke 1:33-35** and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever. His kingdom will never end! How can this be, Mary asked the angel, since I am a virgin? ³⁵ The angel replied, The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the Holy One to be born will be called the Son of God....

***Luke 1:46-52** ⁴⁶ And Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord.

⁴⁷ And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. ⁴⁸ For He has regarded the lowly state of His maidservant; For behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed.

⁴⁹ For He who is mighty has done great things for me, And holy is His name.

⁵⁰ And His mercy is on those who fear Him From generation to generation.

⁵¹ He has shown strength with His arm; He has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. ⁵² He has put down the mighty from their thrones. And exalted the lowly.

***Luke 1:53-55** He has filled the hungry with good things, And the rich He has sent away empty. ⁵⁴ He has helped His servant Israel. In remembrance of His mercy.

⁵⁵ As He spoke to our fathers, To Abraham and to his seed forever." You in Your mercy have led forth the people whom You have redeemed;

***Revelation 15:2b-3.** They were holding harps from God, 3and they sang the song of God's servant Moses and of the Lamb: Great and wonderful are Your works, O Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the nations!

***Psalm 98:1** A Psalm. Sing to the LORD a new song, for He has done wonders; His right hand and holy arm have gained Him the victory.

***John 6:16-21** Now when evening came, His disciples went down to the sea, ¹⁷ got into the boat, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was already dark, and Jesus had not come to them. ¹⁸ Then the sea arose because a great wind was blowing. ¹⁹ So when they had rowed about three or four miles, and they were afraid. ²⁰ But He said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." ²¹ Then they willingly received Him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land where they were going.

***Genesis 1:2** "The Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters."

***Exodus 12:23** And Hashem will pass through Mitzraim at the mid of night.
