Ex. 35:1-40:18; Ezek. 45:16-46:18; Luke 22:1-13

**\*Exodus 34:29-33** Now it was so, when Moses came down from Mount Sinai (and the two tablets of the Testimony were in Moses' hand when he came down from the mountain), that **Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone while he talked with Him.**<sup>30</sup> So when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone, **and they were afraid to come near him.**

**\*Exodus 34:30-33** So when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone, **and they were afraid to come near him.**<sup>31</sup> Then Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the rulers of the congregation returned to him; and Moses talked with them.<sup>32</sup> **Afterward all the children of Israel came near, and he gave them as commandments all that the LORD had spoken with him on Mount Sinai.**

**\*Exodus 33:3** And when Moses had finished speaking with them, **he put a veil on his face.**

**\*Colossians 3:23-24** **Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,** knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. **You are serving the Lord Messiah.**

**\*Jeremiah 9:23-24** Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts **boast in this, that he understands and knows me,** that I am the LORD who **practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth.** For **in these things I delight, declares the LORD.**"

**\*Exodus 35:1** For a six day period, work may be done, but on the seventh day it shall be for you holy, a complete rest to HASHEM; anyone who does work on it shall be put to death.

**\*Exodus 35:4** Moses spoke to all the congregation of the sons of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD has commanded.

**\*Exodus 25:8** And they shall make me a sanctuary, and I will dwell in the midst of them:

**\*Genesis 6:22** Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did.

**\*Isaiah 30:18** Therefore the LORD waits to be gracious to you, and therefore he exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the LORD is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for him.

**\*II Peter 3:9** The LORD is not slow in keeping His promise as some understand slowness, but is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish but everyone to come to repentance.

**\*Psalm 33:5** He loves righteousness and justice; The earth is full of the lovingkindness of the LORD.

**\*Micah 6:8** He has shown you, O man, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you but to act justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?

**\*Genesis 3:1-6** The serpent was more clever than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. The serpent said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat fruit from any tree in the garden'?"

<sup>2</sup> The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden. <sup>3</sup> But God did say, 'You must not eat the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden. Do not even touch it. If you do, you will die.'"

**\*Genesis 6:11** Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence.

**\*Exodus 1:22** Then Pharaoh commanded all his people: "Every son born to the Hebrews you must throw into the Nile, but every daughter you may allow to live."

**\*Hosea 12:6** But you must return to your God; maintain love (mercy) and justice, and wait for your God always.

**\*Lamentations 3:22-23** Because of the loving devotion of the LORD we are not consumed, for His mercies never fail.

**\*Psalm 89:14** Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and truth go before you.

**\*Psalm 2:1-6** Why do the nations rage. And the people plot a vain thing? <sup>2</sup> The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying, <sup>3</sup> "Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us." <sup>4</sup> He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The LORD shall hold them in derision. <sup>5</sup> Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure: <sup>6</sup> "Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion."

**\*I Samuel 15:3** Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.

**\*Psalm 2:7-12** <sup>7</sup>"I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. <sup>8</sup> Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession. <sup>9</sup> You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.' "

<sup>10</sup> Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth. <sup>11</sup> Serve the LORD with fear and rejoice with trembling. <sup>12</sup> Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.

**\*Genesis 6:3a** And the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh;

**\*Revelation 6:16** They called to the mountains and the rocks, Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!

**\*Revelation 19:11-16** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. <sup>13</sup> He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. <sup>16</sup> And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

**\*II Peter 1:2-11** Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, <sup>3</sup> as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us (by glory and virtue, <sup>4</sup> by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

**\*Zechariah 11:1** Open your doors, O Lebanon, that the fire may devour your cedars!

**\*Isaiah 10:34** He will cut down the thickets of the forest with iron, and Lebanon will fall by the Mighty One.

**\*Ezekiel 17:8** It was planted in good soil by many waters, to bring forth branches, bear fruit, and become a majestic vine.

**\*Psalm 29:1-12** The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over many waters. The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty. The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon.

**\*Isaiah 11:1** Then a shoot will spring up from the stump of Jesse, and a Branch from his roots will bear fruit.
