Secrets in the Patterns of the Lord that Actually Hold You Up!

Leviticus 21:1-24:23; Eze. 44:15-31; Matt. 26:28:34

***Genesis 3:5-6** For God knows that in the day you eat of it, your eyes will be opened and you will be like God, knowing good and evil. When the woman saw that the tree was good for food and **pleasing to the eyes**, and that it was desirable for obtaining wisdom, she took fruit and ate it. She also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate it.

***Deuteronomy 32:8** When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of men, he fixed the boundaries of the peoples according to the number of the sons of Israel.

***Exodus 1:5** The descendants of Jacob numbered seventy in all, including Joseph, who was already in Egypt.

***Numbers 15:39** And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that you may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that you seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which you use to go astray.

***Leviticus 23:1-2** And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ² Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: The feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, **these are My feasts.** For six days work may be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of complete rest, a day of sacred assembly. You must not do any work; wherever you live, it is a Sabbath to the LORD.

***Leviticus 23:1-2** And the Lord spoke to ² Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: The feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, **these are My feasts.** For six days work may be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of complete rest, a day of sacred assembly. You must not do any work; wherever you live, it is a Sabbath to the LORD.

***Exodus 6:5-7** ⁵Furthermore, I have heard the groaning of the Israelites, whom the Egyptians are enslaving, and I have remembered My covenant. ⁶Therefore tell the Israelites: I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the yoke of the

Egyptians and **deliver you** from their bondage. I will **redeem you** with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment. **7I will take you as My own people**, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am the LORD your God, who brought you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians....

***I Corinthians 15:20** Christ is risen from the dead, and has become **the firstfruits** of those who have fallen asleep.

***Matthew 22:34-39** But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. ³⁵ Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷ Jesus said to him, "'You shall **love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.**' ³⁸ This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹ And the second is like it: 'You shall **love your neighbor as yourself.**' ⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

***Galatians 5:14** The entire law is fulfilled in a single decree: Love your neighbor as yourself.

***Deuteronomy 31:10-11** Then Moses commanded them, "At the end of every seven years, at the appointed time in the **year of remission of debt**, during the Feast of Tabernacles, / when all Israel comes before the LORD your God at the place He will choose, **you are to read this law in the hearing of all Israel.**

Leviticus 23:15-16** And you shall count for **yourselves** from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: **seven Sabbaths shall be completed.** **16*Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath;** then you shall offer a new grain offering to the Lord.

***Leviticus 23:10-11** Speak to the Israelites and say, 'When you enter the land that I am giving you and you reap its harvest, you are to bring to the priest a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest. **11**And he shall **wave the sheaf before the LORD so that it may be accepted on your behalf;**

***Micah 7:15** Just as the day you left Egypt, I will show you wonders in the future.

***2 Corinthians 3:18** But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

***Mark 2:27** **The Sabbath was made for man,** and not man for the Sabbath.

***James 1:25** But the one having looked intently into the perfect law, that of freedom, and having continued in it, not having been a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work—this one will be blessed in his doing.

***Colossians 1:16-17** For in Him all things were created, things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities. All things were created through Him and for Him. **17**He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

***Leviticus 14:10** And on the eighth day he shall take two male lambs, unblemished, and one ewe lamb, a daughter of a year, unblemished, and three tenths of an ephah of fine flour as a grain offering, mixed with the oil, and one log of oil.

***Leviticus 14:24** And the priest shall take the lamb of the trespass offering and the log of oil, and the priest shall wave them as a wave offering before the Lord.

***Deuteronomy 16:13-14** **13**You are to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days after you have gathered the produce of your threshing floor and your winepress. **14**And you shall rejoice in your feast - you, your sons and daughters, your men servants and maidservants, and the Levite, as well as the foreigner, the fatherless, and the widows among you.

***Zechariah 14:9,16-17** The LORD. will be king over the whole earth. On that day the LORD will be One, and His name the only name.....then the survivors from all the nations that have attacked Jerusalem will go up year after year to worship the King, the LORD Almighty, and to celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles. If any of the peoples of the earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD Almighty, they will have no rain. If the Egyptian people do not go up and take part, they will have no rain.

***Psalm 119:18** Open my eyes that I may see wondrous things from Your law.
