Do We Hear His Voice? In Our Day, The Lord is About the Rescue Israell

May 16,202; Iyyar 29, 5786

Nu. 1:1-4:20; 1 Sam. 20-42; Matt. 24:29-36

***Numbers 1:1** Then the LORD spoke **אָדַבֵּר** to Moses in the wilderness of Sinai.

***Numbers 1:1-5** The LORD spoke to Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the tent of meeting, on the first day of the second month, in the second year after they had come out of the land of Egypt, saying, **2 Take a census** of all the congregation of the people of Israel, by clans, by fathers' houses, according to the number of names, every male, head by head. **3** From twenty years old and upward, all in Israel who are able to go to war, you and Aaron shall list them, company by company. **4** And there shall be with you a man from each tribe, each man being the head of the house of his fathers. **5** And these are the names of the men who shall assist you.

***Numbers 1:17-19** Moses and Aaron took these men who had been named, **18** and on the first day of the second month, they assembled the whole congregation together, who registered themselves by clans, by fathers' houses, according to the number of names from twenty years old and upward, head by head, **19** as the LORD commanded Moses. **So he listed them in the wilderness of Sinai.**

***Revelation 7:5-8** twelve thousand from each tribe: Judah, Reuben, Gad, Asher, Naphtali, Manasseh, Simeon, Levi, Issachar, Zebulun, Joseph, and Benjamin.

***Revelation 21:12** Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west. and three gates on the west. Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

***Numbers 2:1&34** The LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying, **2** "The people of Israel shall camp each by his own standard, with the banners of their fathers' houses. They shall camp facing the tent of meeting on every side. **34** Thus the children of Israel did according to

all that the Lord commanded Moses; so they camped by their standards and so they broke camp, each one by his family, according to their fathers' houses.

***Revelation 21:13**... three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west.

***I Corinthians 12:4** There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them.⁵ There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord.⁶ There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

***Psalm 103:21-21** Praise the LORD, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word. Praise the LORD, all his heavenly hosts, you his servants who do his will.

***Hebrews 1:14** Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

***Psalm 91:11** For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

***Isaiah 41:8** But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, you descendants of Abraham my friend..

***Isaiah 49:3** He said to me, You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will display my splendor.

Isaiah 44:8-10 But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, you descendants of Abraham my friend,⁹ I took you from the ends of the earth, from its farthest corners I called you. I said, 'You are my servant'; I have chosen you and have not rejected you.¹⁰ So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

***Matthew 20:28** For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.

***Galatians 5:13** For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

***1 Peter 4:10** As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace.

***Matthew 25:40** The King will reply, Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for Me.

***Hebrews 6:10** God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them.

***Philippians 2:3** Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Messiah Yeshua, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

***Colossians 3:23-24** Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Messiah.

***John 16:7-9** But I tell you the truth, it is for your benefit that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

***Acts 1:8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses.

***John 14:26** But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

***I Corinthians 12:7-11** But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: ⁸ for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹ But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

***Song of Songs 2:4** He has brought me to the house of wine, and his banner over me is love.

***Ephesians 4:30-31** And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, outcry and slander, along with every form of malice....

***Isaiah 63:10** But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit. So He turned and became their enemy, and He Himself fought against them.

***Psalm 22:7** I am a worm and not a man - scorned by humans and despised by people.

***Isaiah 53:3-4** He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, acquainted with grief. Like one from whom men hide their faces, He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. ⁴ Surely He took on our infirmities and carried our sorrows; yet we considered Him stricken by God, struck down and afflicted....

***Psalm 22:1-10** A Psalm of David. My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning? ² O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent. ³ But You are holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel. ⁴ Our fathers trusted in You; They trusted, and You delivered them. ⁵ They cried to You, and were delivered; They trusted in You, and were not ashamed. ⁶ But I am a worm, and no man; A reproach of men, and despised by the people.

***Isaiah 66:3c-4** Just as they have chosen their own ways, And their soul delights in their abominations, ⁴ So will I choose their delusions, And bring their fears on them; Because, when I called, no one answered, When I spoke they did not hear; But they did evil before My eyes, And chose that in which I do not delight.

***Isaiah 66:7** Before she was in labor, she gave birth; before her pain came, she delivered a male child. Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things?

***Hosea 14:4-6** I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, For My anger has turned away from him. ⁵ I will be like the dew to Israel; He shall grow like the lily, And lengthen his roots like Lebanon. ⁶ His branches shall spread; His beauty shall be like an olive tree, And his fragrance like Lebanon. ⁷ Those who dwell under his shadow shall return; They shall be revived like grain, And grow like a vine. Their scent shall be like the wine of Lebanon

***Zechariah 9:14-16**(selections)

Then the LORD will be seen over them.....The Lord God will blow the trumpet....The LORD of Hosts will defend them...On that day the LORD their God will save them as the flock of His people; for like jewels in a crown they will sparkle over His land.
